GL STUDENTS PERFORM 'TOGETHER, BUT APART'

Governor Livingston musicians continue to shine (and perform) in spite of any obstacles thrown at them by the pandemic. Since GL was unable to have a winter concert due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the first semester Jazz Improvisation class, under the direction of music teacher Josef Ellis, put together a virtual recording to culminate the semester and to share with the community. Throughout the course, students not only learn how to perform, they also learn how to speak the language of Jazz. For the recording, the students followed a 'click track' since they were unable to record it together as an ensemble.

The first semester of Jazz Improvisation, an elective course offered at GL, consisted of 14 students from across all the grade levels and all at different points in their musical journeys. Throughout the course students work on many different jazz standards and the theory/history

Music is what brings us together and our behind each tune. According to Mr. Ellis, "We chose "Blue Bossa" for our final performance since it seemed to be a class favorite. I sent the students a 'play-along track' that outlined the layout of the tune. The students then had a few days to make a solid recording for the project. Once they were satisfied with their recording, they sent it over to me. I then compiled the individual videos to make it into a virtual ensemble recording. The whole process from beginning to end took a few days to complete and resulted in the video that we have shared."

Mr. Ellis added, "Working with students during the ever changing pandemic can be difficult at times, but this group of kids was always up for a challenge. Whether we were in person or with each other via zoom, the students always put their best foot forward to create music together. Music is a universal language that binds us all together."

Thank you Mr. Ellis and all of your students for this wonderful and creative performance and for sharing it with all of us.

SAGE'S MEALS ON WHEELS PROGRAM DELIVERS RECORD NUMBER OF MEALS DURING COVID-19

As the pandemic forced businesses and services to close in 2020, the demand for SAGE's Meals on Wheels kept increasing. By the end of the year, the nonprofit delivered a record breaking 50,000 meals, an increase of 7,000 over the previous year. Family members who were unable to visit and offer support to their older adult relatives called on Meals on Wheels for help. The meal service became an increasingly important resource for food and a means for having someone check in on loved ones.

According to Marianne Kranz, Director of Meals on Wheels, she, her staff and many volunteers continued to go to the SAGE building at 290 Broad Street in Summit every day during the pandemic to pack and deliver meals. Community organizations and area residents pitched in by donating what was needed. Along with frozen meals and nonperishable food items, people dropped off toilet paper and paper towels,

masks, baked goods and made monetary donations. "Our goal was to provide our clients with extra food so they wouldn't have to worry about leaving the house to get to a grocery store," said Kranz. "There were also people coming home from the hospital alone, scared and food insecure."

Meals on Wheels was there to help and continues to be a vital support to those in the community who need it. The average age of someone receiving meals is 83. Half of these clients live alone and 65% rarely see anyone other than the volunteer who brings them their meal.















LOCAL GYM GETS CRUSHED BY PANDEMIC

In 2007, Gabriele Fitness founder, Vince Gabriele, started a Sports Performance training business out of the back of his pick-up truck. Over the past 13 years, the Berkeley Heights based gym has worked with thousands of youth athletes between the ages of 6-18.

WHEN SHOVELING REMEMBER THE MAILBOX

It takes more than a few flakes to deter letter carriers from making their appointed rounds. But, if they cannot reach your mailbox, they cannot deliver your mail.

The Postal Service treats safety and service with equal priority. That's why we remind you to include that mailbox in your snow removal routine.

Letter carriers are on the front line of severe weather conditions. Doorstep deliveries, painted porches and steps quickly grow hazardous. While

salting and rubber-backed mats help, we rely on you to clear the snow. If there's a warm spell, and the melting snow puddles, a quick freeze can make a sidewalk slick again.

Residents who receive delivery to roadside mailboxes also must keep the approach to, and exit from, the mailbox clear of snow or any other obstacles, like trash cans and other vehicles. The carrier needs to get in, and then out, without leaving the vehicle or backing up. The area near the mailbox should be cleared in a half-moon shape to give the carrier full visibility.

Please watch for slow-moving postal vehicles, carriers on foot, and children that play near mailboxes or snow banks. And don't zip by neighbors who are clearing mailboxes or collecting their mail. Let's all stay safe.


