TROOPS CELEBRATE SCOUT SUNDAY WITH CAMPFIRE

Madison BSA Troop 7 and Madison Cub Scout Pack 7 celebrated Scout Sunday at Summerhill Park on Saturday, February 6 with a campfire prayer service organized by its chartered organization, St. Vincent Martyr Church. Over the course of the afternoon, nearly forty Scouts and their parents built campfires, cooked their meals, enjoyed the park, and prayed together.

The campfires were the center of lots of activities. Scouts played in the snow, hiked the trails, and enjoyed the cold sunny day. The Boy Scouts set up an "ax yard," a roped-off area where experienced Scouts supervised younger Scouts in how to safely use an ax to chop firewood.

Everyone gathered around the fire for the prayer service. Father George Hundt, Pastor of St. Vincent Martyr Church, led the group in the Lord's Prayer, and reflections on the Scout Oath and the Scout Law. The Scout Oath is:

"On my honor, I will do my best

to do my duty to God and my country and to obey the Scout Law;

to help other people at all times;

to keep myself physically strong, mentally awake, and morally straight."

The Scout Law is: "A Scout is trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean, and reverent."

Troop 7 Boy Scout Greg Brown and Pack 7 Cub Scout Jeffrey Brown also performed a skit which explained what each part of the Lord's Prayer means.

With supervision from adult leaders, Cub Scouts started the campfires and Cub Scouts and their family members cooked their lunches. Later, Boy Scouts took responsibility for maintaining the fires, cooked dinner, and put out the fires, making sure the area was safe and clean when they were done.

Scout Sunday is an annual event to celebrate the birthday of Scouting which dates back to 1908 and where Scouts reaffirm the Scout Oath.

Pack 7 and Troop 7 hold weekly meetings on Mondays on the grounds of St. Vincent Martyr Catholic Church in Madison. Information about Troop 7 is available online at troopwebhost.org/Troop7Madison, and young men ages 11-18 are welcome to observe a meeting or join at any time. 

PILOTS TO THE RESCUE

Home for Good Dog Rescue

On Saturday, February 20, a very special delivery was made from Aiken, South Carolina by volunteer pilots from "Pilots to the Rescue." Home for Good Dog Rescue (HFGDR), a 100% foster-based non-profit organization located in Berkeley Heights, NJ, accepted an offer from PTTR to transport 15 dogs from high kill shelters in the South. The precious cargo arrived at Caldwell Airport at 5:30 p.m. The dogs were then placed into loving foster families, where they await adoption into their forever homes.

Prior to their departure from the South, the dogs were filmed for a special "Meet-the-Pawsengers." Broadcasted on the live-streaming Internet service Twitch, viewers tuned in live to interact virtually and get to know the pups. They also met the crew: pilot and PTTR founder Michael Schneider, co-pilot Daniel Baumel, and social media influencer Savannah Vinson.

Toni Ann Turco, co-founder of Home for Good Dog Rescue, said of the mission, "This is a partnership a long time in the making. We are extremely grateful to Pilots to the Rescue for coordinating and executing this maiden voyage."

Pilots to the Rescue is a non-profit 501c3 aviation organization, whose mission is to transport animals at high risk of euthanasia. They rely on their trusted network of volunteer pilots, who fund their own rescue flights.



Michael Clancy and Nelson Jimenez from the Madison Police Department have been recognized as Employees of the Month for March.

On February 8, the officers were dispatched to the Madison High School tennis courts for a patient suffering a possible seizure. Patrolman Clancy was patrolling near the high school and arrived within seconds. He assessed the patient and determined he was in cardiac arrest. Patrolman Clancy immediately notified Madison Dispatch and began performing lifesaving measures. Patrolman Jimenez arrived shortly thereafter with Madison Ambulance Corps personnel and began assisting with CPR. After the officers used the automated external defibrillator (AED) several times, the patient regained a pulse and began breathing on his own. The patient was transported to Morristown Medical Center where he continued his recovery.

Troop 25 has two 12-person crews that will be going to Philmont, which is the Boy Scouts of America's largest National High Adventure Base.


COLLIN FLANAGAN RECEIVES NATIONAL YOUNGARTS FOUNDATION AWARD




