MEMORIAL DAY PARADE - MONDAY, MAY 31, 9:30 AM

On Monday, May 31st, 2021, the Township of Clark will host its Annual Memorial Day Parade. At the end of the parade route at Arthur L. Johnson High School, a short service will be held to honor "Clark's Fallen Heroes."

Memorial Day commemorates the men and women who died while servicing their country, particularly those who died in battle or as a result of wounds sustained in battle. In other words, the purpose of Memorial Day is to memorialize the veterans who made the ultimate sacrifice for their country. We spend time remembering those who lost their lives and could not come home, reflecting on their service and why we have the luxury and freedom that we enjoy today. Remember to fly the American flag on this day.

As the new Co-Chair to the parade committee, I urge you to attend the parade route or even consider marching. With so much uncertainty and unrest on foreign ground today, with a nation so divided politically, we need to come together as a country and a township and honor our lost, support our troops, especially that so many young Clark residents are in the military.

There is much prior precedent in Clark's history to honor its war dead with a parade. During World War II the residents celebrated "I Am American Day" originating in 1942 and continuing through the 1950's.

At the conclusion of those parades, all the participants and observers circled the large wooden board listing the names of those Clark residents who went off to war, called the "Honor Roll". In 1947 the "Honor Roll" was replaced with our present war memorial monument located in front of Clark's high school, Arthur L. Johnson. The Parade Committee will continue this tradition of circling around the war memorial monuments at the conclusion of this year's parade.





ALJ PREMED STUDENTS COMPLETE CANCER RESEARCH PROJECT

Students in Mrs. Bernadette Jacobi's PreMedical Studies class at Arthur L. Johnson High School recently completed an Immunotherapy Patient Cancer Research Project. Students were asked to put their scrubs on and assume the role of a doctor who is meeting with a patient just diagnosed with cancer.

The students had to research the selected form of cancer the patient had, the options for cancer treatment, focusing on immunotherapy, and how to address the patient and answer any patient questions. Students also had to determine which immunotherapy treatment would be most effective and whether they wanted to combine it with traditional treatment. In class, student doctors met with their patients, role played by their peers. The students reviewed their patient's history, took their patient's vitals, diagnosed the patient, provided a treatment plan, addressed patient concerns, and gave a prognosis. Additionally, students had to present a reflection on what they took away from the experience and why they chose this type of cancer.

Ms. Jacobi stated, "This immunotherapy project is a very powerful tool that completely engages my students in their quest for knowledge and a better understanding of a person living with cancer. It is not your typical research project. The students created their fictitious patient and stood by their sides, holding their hands, through good news and bad, with each step along the way of their disease, from chief complaint through diagnosis, treatment and final prognosis."

Jacobi continued, "I am just so proud of the work my students did, in how they established a relationship with their patients and earned their trust. They learned a very valuable life lesson, in treating the whole patient as a valued person, and not just the disease they presented with. The personal statements my students made after their presentations were just so powerful, with many of them choosing a particular type of cancer that they wanted to know more about because of a personal experience. Words can't describe enough, how proud I am of their work, and how incredibly amazing my students are."



L'ORÉAL TO BUILD NEW RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT FACILITY ON TERMINAL AVENUE

Clark Township

Mayor Salvatore Bonaccorso recently announced the unanimous approval by the Clark Planning Board of L'Oréal's request to add an approximate 100K square foot building adjacent to their current site on Terminal Avenue.

Bonaccorso welcomed the April 1 approval and sees the project as a win for the entire township.

"We are happy to have L'Oréal continue to invest in their business and in this town," said Bonaccorso. "This ensures Terminal Avenue remains an area of industry in town instead of becoming a place to develop more shopping centers and apartments. L'Oréal's development brings jobs and people which is great as they spur the local economy."

The new building will include a Research and Development center complete with parking and a traffic light to help with the flow of vehicles. The site will be constructed so it envelops the current site located at the corner of Central and Terminal Avenues.

"This street has always been industry," said Bonaccorso. "The site they are developing was the site of a manufacturing firm for many years before, so rush hour commuters in and out of the workplace there is business as usual on the street and is still significantly less than shopping centers would bring in the same area."

L'Oréal has strived to make the site environmentally responsible including the addition of a solar farm above the parking facility and a pond that recycles and cleans storm water

runoff.

Bonaccorso said the L'Oréal project is something all residents should be happy about because it helps the town continue to provide the same services to the public without additional cost to taxpayers.

"Let's face it, New Jersey isn't built in a way that we can expect taxes to go down so having projects like this in town helps to stabilize the tax bill for residents, which is what my administration strives to do," said Bonaccorso.


