LINDEN SELECTED AMONG BEST IN MUSIC EDUCATION

Even in a virtual world, Linden's music education program is the real thing.

Linden Public Schools have been named among the Best Communities for Music Education in America for the seventh year in a row. Linden is one of about 685 districts across the country to be chosen for the prestigious honor for 2021.

The NAMM Foundation (National Association of Music Merchants) has recognized the district for its outstanding commitment to music education. Linden is one of just 41 districts in New Jersey and four in Union County to be selected.

"This honor is a testament of how valuable the arts are in Linden," said Matthew Lorenzetti, supervisor of fine and performing arts. "As a district, we are very fortunate to have such strong support from all our upper administration as well as the Board of Education. We have a staff of music teachers that would do anything for their students.

"This has been extremely evident this past year as we have all dealt with the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic. In addition to maintaining a safe environment during this time, the focus has not only been on teaching music, but also the mental health of our students."

Lorenzetti explained that teachers spent countless hours learning how to incorporate social and emotional learning into the arts, in addition to using multiple new digital platforms to teach and record students in order to give them as close to a "normal" music education as

possible.

"Our students are doing extremely well despite the difficulties of being mostly virtual and not being able to perform or rehearse in-person in ensembles," he said.

Now in its 22nd year, Best Communities for Music Education highlights outstanding efforts by teachers, administrators, parents, students, and community leaders who work together to ensure access to music learning for all students as part of the school curriculum.

"We're very excited to have received this prestigious honor for the seventh year in row," said Superintendent Dr. Marnie Hazelton. "It is a testament to the dedication of our administrators, teachers, and students that we have been able to maintain this level of excellence year after year. Music is always a critical part of our curriculum in Linden, but it was especially vital in the year of the pandemic to give students a creative outlet as they dealt with the realities of COVID-19 and virtual learning."

The BCME survey was sent to nearly 14,000 school districts across the country asking detailed questions about funding, graduation requirements, music class participation, instruction time, facilities, support for the music program and community music-making programs. Responses were verified with school officials and reviewed by The Center for Public Partnerships and Research, an affiliate of the University of Kansas.

Lorenzetti said he has sat in on numerous classes throughout the year and was very impressed with the level of skills from students "despite the nontraditional methods of teaching."

"I could not be prouder to be part of such an extraordinary department," he said. "I am looking forward to the end of the year when we will be sharing numerous virtual performances of what our students have been working on this year."



CAU HELPS YOUTH OUT OF HOMELESSNESS

The COVID-19 pandemic is straining resources that assist runaway and homeless youth, who are often trying to escape problems at home such as neglect, poverty, abuse or mental health issues.

"It's usually something that triggers them to run and it's our job to try to find out why," said Rolando Zorrilla, Managing Assistant Executive Director of Youth Services at Community Access Unlimited (CAU) in Elizabeth. CAU runs the Union County Youth Shelter, Runaway and Homeless Youth Transitional Shelters, and a Basic Center program. The statewide nonprofit works to integrate people with disabilities and youth at risk into the general community through comprehensive supports.

"Outreach is harder since the pandemic," Zorrilla said. "We used to get referrals through libraries, police departments and schools, but we are getting fewer referrals so our street outreach has picked up to try to reach those that are in need."

Youth living on the streets are at high risk for victimization and assault, mental illness, substance misuse, juvenile justice system involvement, and human trafficking, all of which increases the likelihood of perpetuated homelessness in adult life.

Youth who enter the shelter go through a screening process to determine their needs, including whether reunification with family or guardians is a goal. They are then connected to the right resources, such a medical or mental health care, vocational training, or family counseling.

CAU offers a continuum of services and provides a second chance for young people to build healthy relationships and get started on a path to a self-sufficient adulthood. Youth programs include the Transitional Opportunities Program (TOP) which provides comprehensive residential services to youth ages 13 to 21, as well as the Union County Youth Shelter and federal Runaway and Homeless Youth Basic Center Program and federal Transitional Living Programs.

NEW JERSEY OUTDOORS: ARCHIVE NOW AVAILABLE ONLINE

New Jersey is far more than just a "garden" state. While well known for its vast network of fields and farms, fresh produce and fruit orchards, New Jersey boasts incredible ecological diversity. Even those who only know New Jersey from the Sopranos have heard of the Pine Barrens. The 1.1 million acre swath of forest and wetland that confounded Chris and Paulie in the episode "Pine Barrens," was actually the country's first National Reserve and designated by UNESCO as

a single-site biosphere reserve. It is the largest body of open space on the Mid-Atlantic seaboard and home to dozens of rare and endangered species.

Yet even though the Pine Barrens claim some 22% of the state's land, it is not the only highlight when it comes to New Jersey's environmental diversity. Our state hosts portions of the Appalachian Trail and the black bears who live along it, streams full of native brook trout, fields where wild turkey roam and song birds compete for blueberries, and homes for marine wildlife all along the Jersey Shore.

New Jersey Outdoors was created with the idea of highlighting and celebrating New Jersey's rich environmental heritage. First published in 1950 by the Department of Conservation and Economic Development – the precursor to the modern Department of Environmental Protection – New Jersey Outdoors featured articles on hunting, fishing, and conservation related topics. The combination of photography and illustration by local artists gave each issue a unique personality.

The New Jersey State Library is pleased to provide free online access to its entire collection of New Jersey Outdoors. Issues from 1961-2002 have been digitized in color and are available through the Library's Digital Collections.

Browsing the table of contents reveals the breadth of topics in each issue – from in-depth commentary on particular species, to fishing tips, and profiled conservation projects. The issues

a single-site biosphere reserve. It is the largest also provide a glimpse at how environmental body of open space on the Mid-Atlantic seaboard concerns changed over time.

For example, the January 1963 issue features commentary on what could happen to New Jersey's wildlife and food supply in the event of nuclear disaster. Tensions between sportsman and environmentalists were highlighted in the August 1971 issue – just a year after the first Earth Day and the rise of the new environmental movements. In July/August 1983, an article on urban waterfront restoration projects showed the culmination of years' worth of work. Peppered throughout the issues are articles on historical and archaeological topics, as researchers explored human interaction with their environment.

New Jersey Outdoors was published monthly from 1961-1973, bimonthly 1973-1991, and then seasonally from 1991-2003. Publication ended in 2003 after the publication of the Department of Environmental Protection's new magazine, Fish and Wildlife Digest. Fish and Wildlife Digest eventually split into three separate, annual magazines: Hunting and Trapping Digest, Freshwater Fishing Digest, and Marine Digest. These magazines are also available through the Library's Digital Collections.

Unfortunately, we are missing the earliest published issues (1950-1960) of New Jersey Outdoors from our collection. Anyone who would like to donate copies of these issues to the New Jersey State Library can contact Deborah Mercer or Caitlyn Cook in Reference Services at refdesk@njstatelib.org.



NJ Sharing Network

Celebrated in April each year, National Donate Life Month features local, regional and national activities that encourage Americans to register as organ and tissue donors and to celebrate those who have saved lives through the gift of donation.

Linden, NJ firefighter Mathew Pribish helped NJ Sharing Network kick off National Donate Life Month by sharing his personal heart transplant story to help raise awareness about the importance of organ and tissue donation. Inspired by Mathew's story, Linden Mayor Derek Armstead and the Linden Police and Fire Departments teamed up to educate the community through speaking engagements and a public service announcement on LindenTV, which can be viewed on youtube.com. Mathew's personal story is detailed below.

A PERSONAL STORY FROM MATHEW PRIBISH

My gift of life story started more than a decade ago when I went to the doctor for a regular cardiology checkup because heart disease runs in my family and I wanted to make sure that, as a firefighter, my heart was healthy. I was told during one of these regular checkups that I have Marfan Syndrome, a connective tissue disorder that affects the heart, joints and other parts of the

In 2013, after being monitored for a few years, my aortic root was enlarged to the point that I needed replacement surgery. Although my surgery went well, I had an adverse reaction and went into advanced heart failure. The doctors made the decision to implant a Centrimag BiVad, an external device to pump both sides of my heart. After a couple of weeks, my heart healed enough to remove the device and implant an LVAD-Left Ventricular Assist Device. That was my lifeline for four years and I was placed on the New York heart transplant list.

Life with an LVAD isn't easy and it was hard to adjust to at first - no swimming, limited showers, limited activities and lots of medication. Thankfully, with my family, my fire department family and my doctors, I was able to forge through into this new normal. I was able to return to work for the fire department as an Administrator and Fire Inspector. I started to walk/jog in local 5K events in a healthy condition so that I would be a perfect candidate for transplant.

In 2017, my cardiologist recommended that I also be put onto the New Jersey transplant list. In the time leading up to my approval on the New Jersey transplant list, the alarm of my LVAD

device started to sound, on and off. The team of doctors decided that it was a mechanical issue and that they would either need to either replace the LVAD or hold me in the hospital for

On June 22, 2017, I was informed by Newark Beth Israel Medical Center that I was officially listed on the New Jersey list. It was just four days later that my wife got the phone call early in the morning. They said, "Mrs. Pribish, we found a heart for your husband."

There were so many emotions that day. I felt happy and thankful that I now had hope that my health could be restored. I also felt a great deal of sadness for the family that lost their loved one. On June 27, 2017, I had a successful LVAD removal/Heart Transplant.

Since my transplant, I have been blessed to return to the life I had known before. In my donor's memory, I decided to become a transplant advocate through NJ Sharing Network.

In Fall 2018, I was released by the doctors to return to full firefighting duties. On January 3, 2019, I officially returned to the fire department for my first day back at the position I left almost six years before.

I never thought that the day would come where I could return back to active duty. But thanks to my donor, my doctors, and NJ Sharing Network, this dream became a reality. I hope that my story can give hope to others that may need a transplant to inspire them to keep the faith.
