Memorial Day weekend is one of the most challenging for the New Jersey Veterans Network and its team of volunteers and mentors. This is a difficult time for many veterans because they reflect on their brothers and sisters that didn't make it home. Every day our nation loses 22 veterans to suicide, and it seems that number isn't coming down. If you are a veteran, or a family member, who is feeling alone, or are in need of assistance, we are here for you. Please reach out to us.

Our team focuses on helping our veterans and first responders have a better way of life through our volunteer mobile outreach mentoring program. We believe by aggressively seeking out veterans in need and contacting them before they are in crisis, we can really have some positive results. Contacting a person in need first is a great way to build trust and make it easier to begin a friendship. People will do better when they have human contact in their lives, too many programs are automated and lack the empathy and compassion needed to help someone in crisis.

We are not afraid to tell our veterans and first responders that they are loved and we strive to give them purpose. The team immediately empowers and gives its members a new family unit to be part of again. Nearly everyone that joins the team wants to help others and make a difference in someone else's life. Helping others definitely is a medicine that will make you become a better person, and you'll feel really good about it.

New Jersey Veterans Network is constantly keeping active thru our Operation Rebound Racing Team which hosts numerous hikes, runs, bike rides and all other types of physically challenging events. However, we also focus on non athletic events like hosting a BBQ, comedy show, tailgate, camping trip, and several other fun outings throughout the year. But it doesn't stop there, the team works well with other charities and hosts numerous food drives and clothing events which normally take place at our veteran hospitals and shelters. If you would like to help, there is something for you to contribute.

Most recently, in April, our outreach director Frank "Doc" Schupp spearheaded our "Helping Heroes" program, and "Hero Day". These two programs were responsible for providing over 3,000 veterans and National Guardsmen throughout the state with food, PPE, and personal items.

In the last few years New Jersey Veterans Network has grown and has been able to save lives, provide cars, employment, housing, clothing, food, toiletries, and so much

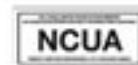

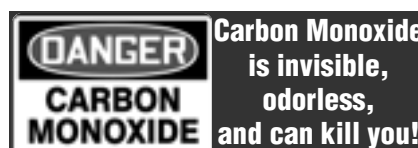

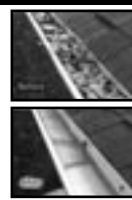

HARDING ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PRINCIPAL APPOINTED

Mr. Ron Bubnowski was unanimously appointed to lead Kenilworth School District's Harding Elementary School as principal commencing with the 2021-2022 school year at the Kenilworth Board of Education Meeting held on April 12, 2021. Mr. Bubnowski has been serving as the interim principal for the 2019-2020 school year after the retirement of Ms. Kathleen Murphy.

The selection of Mr. Bubnowski came after his years of experience as the Assistant Principal at both Harding Elementary and David Brearley Middle-High Schools. Mr. Bubnowski began his career teaching middle school science with the Township of Union School District, and became Assistant Principal for Kenilworth Public Schools at the David Brearley Middle-High School in 2009 before accepting the leadership role in 2012 at the Harding Elementary School. Mr. Bubnowski holds Master's Degrees in both Administration and Supervision and Teaching and Learning.

Mr. Bubnowski has carved out his own identity this year as the interim principal. As the Superintendent of Kenilworth Public Schools,

Mr. Kyle C. Arlington, wrote in his letter to the Kenilworth School Community to announce the principalship and said: "Mr. Bubnowski has expertly balanced a focus on instructional goals with the realities of running a school during a pandemic. He has kept staff and students safe through careful management of health and wellness procedures. He has ensured teachers have support to expand their use of technology tools, and looking ahead, he is eager to enhance digital practices. He has his eyes-on, and a vision for, academic achievement."

Both Harding School's teachers and parents have reached out to express their appreciation for Mr. Bubnowski. "I have never felt more supported, encouraged and inspired than I do now," one teacher wrote. A parent recently wrote and noted that "Mr. Bubnowski constantly makes himself available and takes the time out of his busy schedule to communicate with parents as often as needed. He is extremely dedicated and always goes above-and-beyond to ensure that Harding School is a community where everyone works together to ensure the success of all the students."

WHAT, WHERE, AND WHEN IN OLD KENILWORTH: PROHIBITION DAYS – THE BIG FARMHOUSE RAID – PART 3 OF 3

Bootlegging, smuggling, speakeasies, moonshine, and bath tub gin continued to be part of the resistance to Prohibition. Kenilworth had its share of such activities.

The old Demiecke farmhouse stood off the west side of Faitoute Ave., somewhat to the rear of one and three Red Maple Ln. The farmhouse was near the Cranford border at the time.

On the afternoon of Wednesday, September 17, 1930, Kenilworth police officers George Conklin, Andrew Ruscansky, special officer Toth, and Cranford police sergeant Lawrence Bonnell, raided the farmhouse which they found deserted. It was announced that “a record haul of alleged liquor and equipment” was discovered during the raid. Among items seized were two stills – one at 250-gallons and the other 500 gallons. Authorities found a ton of sugar, 600 gallons of alcohol, and some 4,000 gallons of fermenting mash. They must have been stunned when they came across six huge vats, each with a 1,000-gallon capacity.

During the raid an argument broke out between the Kenilworth and Cranford forces as to whether the farmhouse was in Kenilworth or Cranford and therefore which town would commandeer the spoils. As the towns debated, federal agents from Newark swooped in and claimed it all. They dismantled the equipment, packed up the liquor, and transported everything to Newark.

While the feds were here, they hitched up with

Kenilworth police and conducted a second raid of a speakeasy that was described as a “flourishing” oasis. The keeper of the establishment was arrested and charged with the illegal sale of intoxicating beverages. Embarrassingly, the speakeasy was located “just in back of the police station” noted the local newspaper.

Even after the Prohibition Amendment was repealed in 1933 with the passage of the 21st

Amendment, it still was illegal to privately make liquor to avoid the federal liquor tax. Stills were still popping up around the country, including in town. One instance was a raid on Monday, March 28, 1938 back at the Kayden Chemical Co. at the end of Monroe Ave. – location of today’s Flexvan Co. Raiders found vats, copper tubing, a steam boiler, a cooking pot, and coke fuel. But federal agents and Chief

George Conklin and Patrolman Edward Stupak were unable to find an actual still. The watchman was arrested.

Old timers Josephine Jones, 1918-2012, and John Caforio, 1913-2007, noted in 2005 that on occasion federal agents raided the Downtown woods in Kenilworth seeking moonshiners. Jones and Caforio laughed heartily recalling the time when federal agents got lost in the woods. Neighborhood residents had to go in to the woods, rescue the agents, and lead them out.



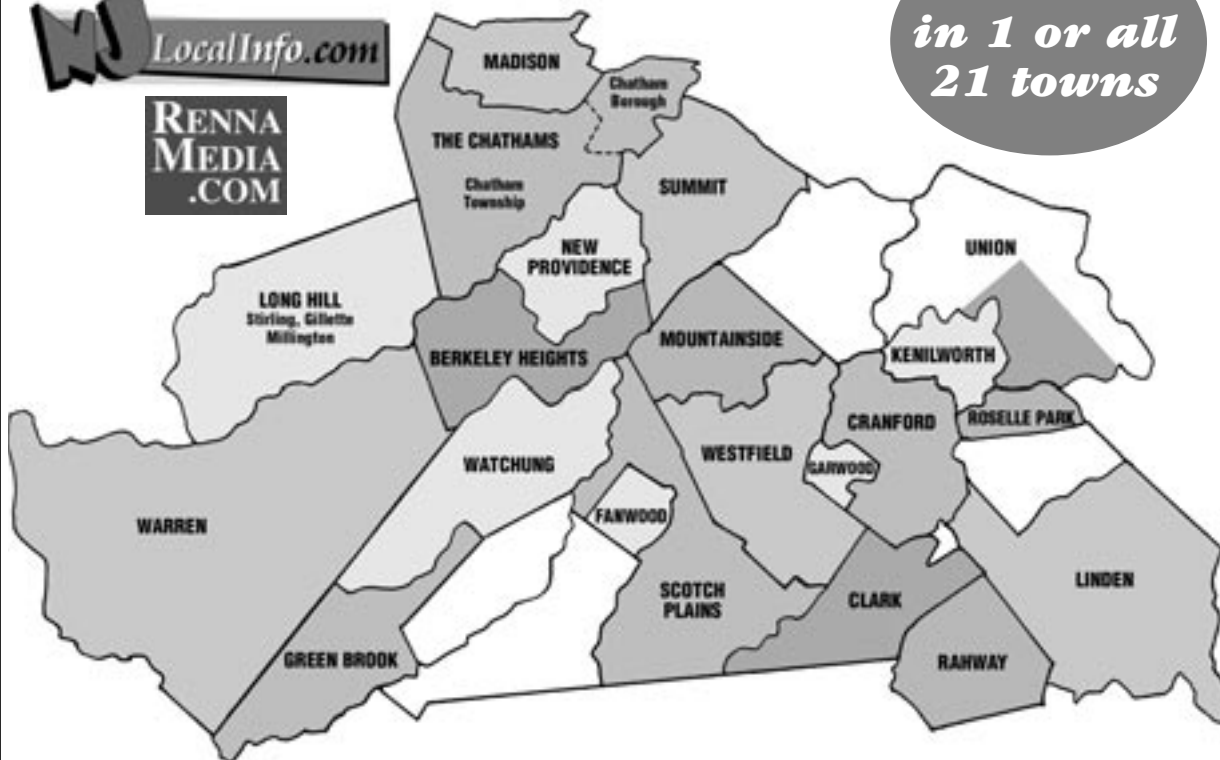
