

## LOREN HARMS NOMINATED GRAND MARSHAL FOR MEMORIAL DAY PARADE

American Legion Post 60 has nominated Loren Harms as Grand Marshal for the Borough of Roselle Park's Annual Memorial Day Parade scheduled for Monday, May 31, 2021.

Harms was raised in Kenilworth before enlisting in the United States Air Force in 1968. He was later stationed at Seymour Johnson AFB in Goldsboro, N.C. where he was attached to the Fourth Combat Support Group.

In 1973, Loren moved to Roselle Park where he continues to be very active in the community.

In 1995, he received a Certificate of Recognition from the Roselle Park Board of Education for his years of service and dedication to the youth of Roselle Park. He also served as Fourth Ward Councilman from 2001 to 2007, and is currently serving his fourth term on the Board of Education. Loren is also Chairman of the Roselle Park Municipal Land Use Board and the Chairman of the Rahway Valley Sewerage

Authority Commission.

In addition to his many involvements, Loren still finds time to enjoy his three children and eight grandchildren with his childhood sweetheart, Chris.

"American Legion Post 60 could not have picked a better Grand Marshall for this year's Memorial Day Parade. There's never been a more important time to honor our fallen heroes and all they gave – when we take time to learn about those who sacrificed before us, we give power to their stories and learn more about ourselves," said

Mayor Joe Signorello. "We hope everyone will come out and join us as we pay our respects."

The Parade assembly will begin at 9 a.m. at Sherman Elementary School on East Grant Avenue. Marching will begin at 10 a.m. from the school on Grant Ave, making right on Chestnut Street, pass reviewing stand in the front of the Casano Community Center, and end the parade at the Library, a service will follow.

Residents can view the parade from the parade route, Gazebo, Post Office, Museum, or the Community Center.
