



STUDENTS BUILD BMX BIKES IN SUMMER STEM PROGRAM

Linden Public Schools

After Linden middle school students learned to build BMX bikes during a summer STEM program, a few lucky ones got to ride away on their class projects.

Each of eight classes at the Summer STEM Academy at Soehl Middle School was given a kit for a Mongoose BMX bike. The kit came with Science, Technology, Engineering and Math lessons for teachers to pass on to students, and participants also learned about the science of the sport of BMX.

Once the bikes were built, there was a raffle to choose one lucky winner per room to keep the bike they had constructed.

"This was a popular activity in our summer program, and we are looking forward to expanding it within the after-school program," said Director of Grants Isabella Scocozza, who oversees the federally funded 21st Century Community Learning Center program at Soehl.

The Summer STEM Academy was part of the 21st Century program and was open to students in Grades 5 through 8. In addition to the bike project, students in the summer program had an

opportunity to work for five weeks on various hours each day and participated in many STEMother hands-on projects and activities. Students collaborated with Liberty Science Center for two



VIRTUAL WELLNESS CENTER AVAILABLE AT NO-COST

The Mental Health Association in New Jersey is providing a new virtual wellness center that offers no-cost groups and workshops statewide to individuals interested in day-to-day wellness, support for substance use disorder and strategies for improving mental health.

Called United by Wellness, the center can be accessed online or by call-in. More than 45 groups and workshops are offered daily, including weekends. Among the variety of groups are Healthy Habits, Meditation, LGBTQ, Young Adult, Anxiety and Depression Support Groups, Grief and COVID, Too Much Stuff, Virtual Job Interviews, Peer Support Career Information, and Grief and Recovery.

are organized Groups into four "communities" for like-minded people with similar goals, but participants are not limited to a specific track. The communities are general well-being; coping skills; co-occurring mental

health and substance use; and a community for those with a disorder who are seeking employment. Staff providing services are culturally diverse certified peer specialists, including some who are bilingual and facilitating groups in Spanish.

The Mental Health Association in New Jersey had been offering in-person meetings at satellite offices around the state, but during the pandemic all meetings were transitioned to online. That enabled interested participants from every county to access meetings. During COVID, the number of people attending online groups more than doubled, according to leadership at the nonprofit, which they attribute to increased need, ease of access, and reduced barriers related to transportation and childcare.
