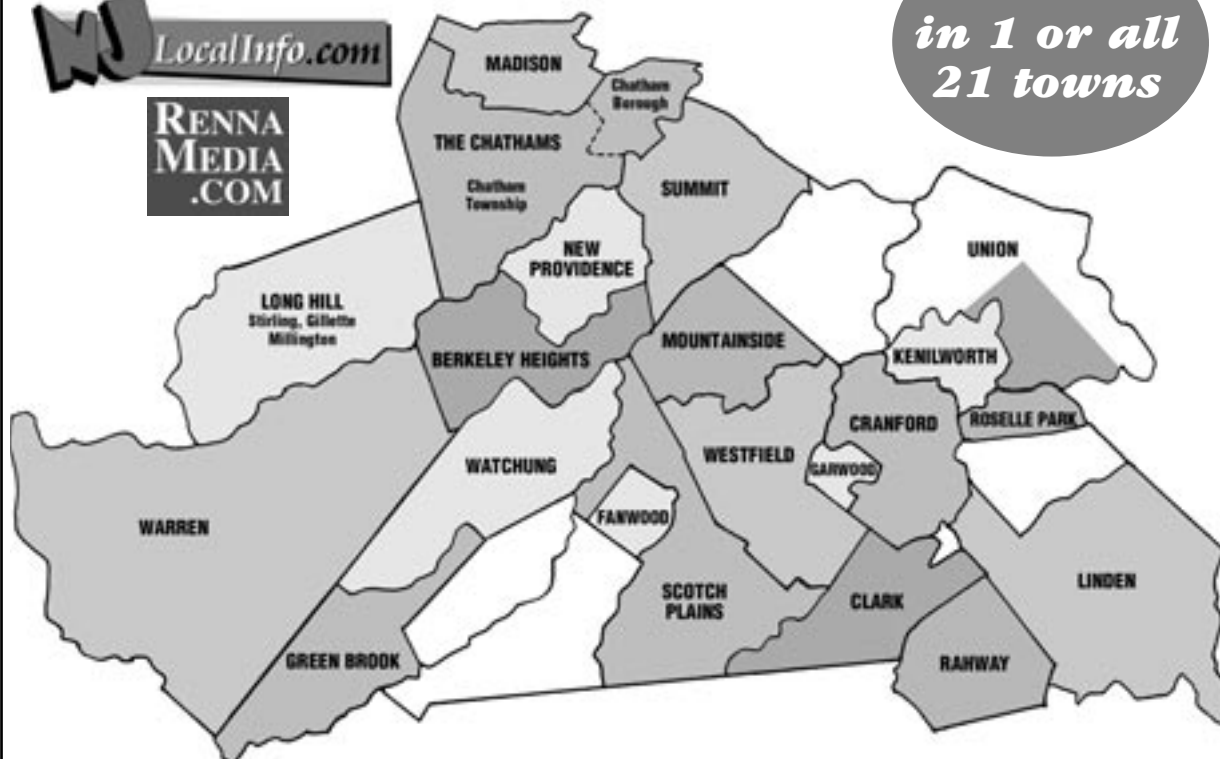

VIRTUAL MINICOURSES IN WINTER 2022

Friends of the Madison Public Library

The nonprofit Friends of the Madison Public Library will conduct two virtual minicourses via Zoom for the Winter 2022 semester, "New Exhibition Strategies in Art Museums: The Frick Collection, MoMA and British Museum" by Dr. Barbara Tomlinson and Professor Emerita at Kean University and "Presidential Elections Past and Their Importance for American Government" by Dr. Ian Drake, Associate Professor of Political Science and Law at Montclair State University.

"New Exhibition Strategies in Art Museums: The Frick Collection, MoMA and British Museum"

Monday afternoons from 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on January 24, 31, 2022 as well as February 7, 14, and 21, 2022

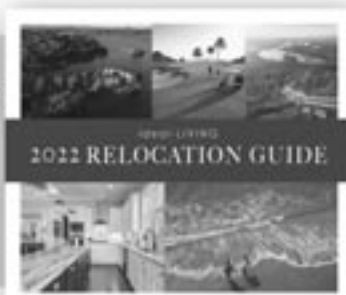
