#### THREE FAMILIES MADE OFFICIAL ON ADOPTION DAY

Multi-town parade includes superheroes, gift baskets and more

CASA of Union County

The frosty morning of Nov. 19 may have been any other Friday for many, but for three Union County foster youth in Rahway, Roselle and Roselle Park, all under age three, their lives changed forever, as Union County Superior Court Judge Lara DiFabrizio granted each the consistency and stability deserved by all children, finalizing their adoptions and ending their time in the child welfare system. Each family had their own CASA volunteer working the case.

The annual event is held the Saturday before Thanksgiving and courts nationwide often celebrate National Adoption Day the business day before, or even open on Saturday, to hold adoption hearings. Here in Union County, all hearings were performed via Zoom due to Covid-19, and Judge DiFabrizio made official what each child likely already felt: they were finally home.

Despite the virtual component, those involved ensured the excitement was palpable. Upon completion of each adoption, the homes were visited by a caravan of fire trucks, police cars, court staff, law guardians and other case stakeholders, CASA of Union County staff and two of its interns suited up as Captain America and Mr. Incredible, and the bear mascot from Kenilworth's David Brearley Middle and High School. All cheered for the family, where each took their first official photo together, and the children spent time with the superheroes and school mascot.

Families received a hot breakfast donated by Urban Griddle in Elizabeth; a flower bouquet provided by Jane Phillips who, until her recent retirement, headed the Adoption Day Committee for the judiciary; and a gift basket from CASA of Union County made possible by collections of board and card games, puzzles and movie night fixings from the Kenilworth school and Summit's Oak Knoll School of the Holy Child. The latter collection was spearheaded by Desiree Mitchell, daughter of CASA volunteer Hope Mitchell, and included fleece blankets made with classmates. In addition, each child and all siblings received their own superhero dress-up costume and books

hand selected by the Phi Eta Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha. Each family received a WalMart gift card funded by the Union County Bar Association. Costumes for CASA's interns were loaned by generous members of the Facebook Buy Nothing Group in Cranford and Garwood.

Today, more than 120,000 youth nationwide need a permanent home, with an average wait in foster care of four years. Each year, 23,000 youth age out of the system without a family or safety net in place. 




#### MIKE D'ECCLESSIS HONORED FOR 46 YRS

#### **SUMMIT EMS RESPONSES — NOVEMBER 2021**

For the third time in four months, members of the Summit Volunteer First Aid Squad answered over 200 emergency calls, logging 208 emergency responses in November, 2021. These calls included 116 medical emergencies: 19 falls; 33 motor vehicle accidents, including six on a highway and four patients involved in two overturned vehicle accidents; 14 traumatic injuries, including one assault; four cases of overdose or poisoning; four allergic reactions; three responses to a medical alarm, one pedestrian struck by a vehicle, one response for a burned patient, one response for cold exposure, and one response to a fire scene. Squad volunteers also provided 10 "lift assists" to patients who did not require transport to a hospital and two non-emergency ambulance transports of Summit residents.

During November, 2021, there were six occasions where all three of the squad's ambulances were answering simultaneous calls. Squad volunteers also provided coverage at Summit's "Miracle on Elm Street" and menorah lighting ceremonies, as well as, manpower for the Summit Frozen Turkey Drive.

In October, 2021, 28 emergency calls were answered by an off-duty "back-up crew" of volunteers responding from home or work when the on-duty crew was busy, and 24 emergency calls were to provide mutual aid assistance to neighboring towns. Further, 16 patients were transported to a hospital by squad members and received advanced life support care from hospital-based paramedics who accompanied the squad's ambulance.

The squad answers calls for help 24 hours a day and at a variety of locations. In November, 2021, responses included 97 to a patient's

home or apartment; 41 for accidents or medical emergencies on roads or highways; five in public buildings; one in a public park; nine at a local business; one to a daycare center; two at a religious institution; three to a recreational facility; and four to a health care professional's office. There were also seven medical incidents on sidewalks; four in parking lots; eight at Summit's Train Station; nine at a local behavioral health facility; eight at an assisted living facility; and eight on the grounds of Overlook Medical Center.

The all-volunteer First Aid Squad, who respond to emergency calls 24/7, is entirely funded through private donations and does not bill for service. The squad is always looking for new volunteers to join its ranks. All needed training, uniforms, and equipment is provided.

#### PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM LOTTERY

The application to enter the lottery for the 2022-2023 Pre-Kindergarten Program is available on the Registration page of the District's website, summit.k12.nj.us/resources/registration, and may also be obtained in person at the Primary Centers and at the Office of Special Services during school hours.

Prospective students must be residents of Summit, be toilet trained and be at least three years old by October 1, 2022.

Students will be selected for this program by lottery.

All applications must be received by the Primary Centers no later than 4 p.m. on January 19, 2022.

#### UNDERSTANDING THE PLASTIC & FOAM BAN

A statewide ban on single-use carryout bags and polystyrene foam food service products will go into effect on May 4, 2022.

The law prohibits all New Jersey stores, food service businesses, and grocery stores from selling single-use plastic carryout bags. In addition, grocery stores larger than 2,500 square feet may not provide or sell single-use paper carryout bags, and instead must provide or sell only reusable carryout bags.

The new law also prohibits all persons and food service businesses from selling any polystyrene foam food service product or selling any food served in a polystyrene foam food service product.

Certain products are exempt until May 4, 2024, such as meat and fish trays for raw or butchered meat. There are no exemptions for 501 (c)(3) organizations in the statewide ban.

Though similar ordinances have existed in Summit since January 1, 2021, the statewide law will supersede local ordinances. For more information, please visit the city of Summit's website at cityofsummit.org.



#### FIFTEENTH ANNIVERSARY OF MENORAH LIGHTING

On the evening of Tuesday, November 30th, the third of the eight days of Hanukkah, Faith Lutheran Church in New Providence and the three synagogues of Summit; Congregation Ohr Shalom-Summit Jewish Community Center, Temple Sinai, and Congregation Beth Hatikvah, lit the third candle of the Menorah on the lawn of Faith. This was the fifteenth consecutive year that Faith and the synagogues have partnered in the lighting of the Hanukkah Menorah at Faith, which is located at 524 South Street, New Providence, NJ. Accompanying the Menorah during each of the years has been a sign, "In Celebration with our Jewish Brothers and Sisters."

The lighting ceremony began with a welcome from Rev. Jane McCready, Pastor of Faith. She expressed her gratitude to the people from the four congregations in attendance and particularly greeted Rabbi Avi Friedman of Congregation Ohr Shalom-Summit Jewish Temple Sinai. A pamphlet of Hanukkah songs was distributed to all. The cantors of the three




