GIFT GIVEAWAY TO AID HAITIAN IMMIGRANTS

Linden Public Schools

A Linden teacher spearheaded a gift giveaway on December 21, 2021 as part of a greater effort to help recent Haitian immigrants who are facing difficult circumstances and were in need of extra holiday joy.

Danie Orelien-Armstead, an English as a Second Language teacher at Linden's School No. 9, organized the grab-and-go event at the Linden Multipurpose Center on John Street. Children and their families were able to select from a wide selection of age-appropriate toys and gifts, donated by the Linden Mayor's Youth Commission.

Orelien-Armstead was assisted by Superintendent of Schools Dr. Marnie Hazelton, Mayor Derek Armstead, and Dr. Pamela Jones, Head of Communities in Cooperation (CIC), a human-services organization serving Union and Essex counties. In addition to distributing gifts, the event aimed to give the children and families a connection to Linden Public Schools.

The event was part of a larger effort to help members of the Haitian immigrant community who face significant hurdles in their new country, including a language barrier; anti-immigrant discrimination; food, shelter and clothing needs; and the COVID-19 pandemic.

"These families are proud and good people, who do not want handouts," said Orelien-Armstead, who teaches English as a Second Language. "Rather, they only seek to earn through education and hard work, what we already have: an incredible life in an amazing country filled with unprecedented opportunities. Like us, they too are self-starters. One 10-year-old girl is not only learning English at record speeds, but she is also teaching her entire family English through YouTube instructional videos."

Orelien-Armstead and CIC established a fundraiser to financially support these families.

Funds raised will be used to pay for legal assistance to obtain Temporary Protected Status with work authorization; find training, and employment opportunities to work and sustain their families; assist with housing needs once employment is secured; connect immigrants with federally funded health care facilities; connect children to appropriate educational institutions; and teach English as a Second Language.

Tax-deductible donations can be made online at cic-nj.org/donate, or checks can be made payable to "Communities in Cooperation Inc. — Humanitarian Haitian Relief Fund" and mailed to 201 Lincoln Street, Linden, NJ 07036.

COVID-19 TESTING FOR LINDEN RESIDENTS

City of Linden

Mayor Derek Armstead and Ammon Labs have teamed up to continue COVID-19 testing for Linden residents and residents in neighboring towns. The testing site is held at the JTG Recreation Center in Linden, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursdays from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. No appointment is necessary. Mayor Armstead said, "I'm so glad that the City of Linden will continue to provide uninterrupted COVID-19 testing."

Vault Health Medical Services of NJ had been providing COVID-19 testing in partnership with the City of Linden since the beginning of January 2022. However, Union County informed Vault that they would be moved to the Performing Arts Center in Plainfield, where they already run a testing site at the Gerald Green Plaza managed by Union County. Mayor Armstead stated "It's unfortunate. We had extremely high-traffic operational logistics already streamlined. While

Vault was in Linden over 5,000 tests were administered. And then Vault was notified by Union County that they had to move."

Mayor Armstead then contacted Ammon Labs to keep the test site operational. "For over twenty years, Ammon Labs has provided high-quality diagnostic lab services to the healthcare industry. As a Linden-based business, we're always especially excited when we have an opportunity to work with the City of Linden." said Evan Haupt, President of Ammon Labs.

BLOOD DONATIONS ARE CRITICALLY NEEDED

The American Red Cross is facing a national blood crisis – its worst blood shortage in more than a decade. Dangerously low blood supply levels are posing a concerning risk to patient care and forcing doctors to make difficult decisions about who receives blood transfusions and who will need to wait until more products become available.

Blood and platelet donations are critically needed to help prevent further delays in vital medical treatments, and donors of all blood types – especially type O – are urged to donate.

In recent weeks, the Red Cross had less than a one-day supply of critical blood types and has had to limit blood product distributions to hospitals. At times, as much as one-quarter of hospital blood needs are not being met.

The Red Cross continues to confront relentless challenges due to COVID-19, including about a 10% overall decline in the number of people donating blood as well as ongoing blood drive cancellations and staffing limitations. Additionally, the pandemic has contributed to a 62% drop in blood drives at schools and colleges.

"Winter weather across the country and the recent surge of COVID-19 cases are compounding the already-dire situation facing the blood supply," said Dr. Baia Lasky, medical director for the Red Cross. "Please, if you are eligible, make an appointment to give blood or platelets in the days and weeks ahead to ensure no patient is forced to wait for critical care."

The Red Cross urges donors to support patient care by making an appointment to give blood or platelets now for the weeks ahead. To schedule an appointment, use the Red Cross Blood Donor App, visit RedCrossBlood.org or call 1-800-RED CROSS (1-800-733-2767).

Each Red Cross blood drive and donation center follows the highest standards of safety and infection control, and additional precautions – including face masks for donors and staff, regardless of vaccination status – have been implemented to help protect the health of all those in attendance. Donors are asked to schedule an appointment prior to arriving at the drive.

To donate blood, individuals need to bring a blood donor card or driver's license or two other forms of identification that are required at checkin. Individuals who are 17 years of age in most states (16 with parental consent where allowed by state law), weigh at least 110 pounds and are in generally good health may be eligible to donate blood. High school students and other donors 18 years of age and younger also must meet certain height and weight requirements.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

In addition to blood donors, the Red Cross also needs the help of volunteers to support critical blood collections. Blood drive volunteers play an important role by greeting, registering, answering questions and providing information to blood donors throughout the donation process. SCHOOL NO. 5 NAMED DISTINGUISHED SCHOOL

"I am completely in awe of the recognition and remain humbled by the tireless work my entire staff continues to do each and every day for our students," she said.


Since 1996, ESEA has recognized schools that display a wide array of strengths, including team approaches to teaching and learning; focused professional development opportunities for staff; individualized programs for student success; and strong partnerships among the school, families,

"Dr. Scamardella and her staff work tirelessly to ensure that all students are given the opportunity to learn and grow in an innovative environment nurtured by a positive school culture."

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) was passed in 1965 and provides additional resources for vulnerable students and federal grants to state educational agencies to improve the quality of public education.

School No. 5 will be among the National ESEA Distinguished Schools publicly recognized in February 2022 at the National ESEA Conference in New Orleans.

School No. 5, which is home to nearly 300 students in grades Pre-K through 5, was also honored last year as a National Blue Ribbon School by the U.S. Department of Education, which celebrates excellent schools and effective educators. It was one of 367 schools in the nation and one of just nine schools from New Jersey selected for 2020.



Currently, there are over 110,000 Americans – nearly 4,000 of whom live in New Jersey waiting for a life-saving transplant. In New Jersey, one person dies every three days waiting for an organ transplant.

However, the generosity of those in the Garden State is providing hope for the future. New Jersey's organ and tissue donor registrations continue to rise thanks to strong community education and outreach efforts as well as simplified ways to register as an organ and tissue donor are also helping to save more lives. It is easy for New Jerseyans to register in any of the following options:

Observed every year on February 14, National Organ Donor Day is dedicated to spreading awareness and education about organ and tissue donation. It is also a day to recognize loved ones who have given the gift of life, have received a transplant, are currently waiting or did not receive an organ in time. National Organ Donor Day was started in 1998 by the Saturn Corporation and its United Auto Workers partner with the support of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and many non-profit health organizations.

CASA of Union County aims to raise awareness about Union County youth in the child welfare system as well as the need for community volunteers to train as advocates to protect their best interests. Funds raised not only provide foster youth a surprise sweet treat when their advocate next visits, but also support the recruitment and training efforts involved in maintaining a corps of trained volunteer advocates serving as extra eyes and ears for local judges and a voice for their assigned youth.

With the ambitious goal of being able to provide an advocate for every youth that needs one, the organization remains steadfast in efforts to ensure its work continues, even amid the pandemic. Last year, CASA volunteers donated more than 7,000 hours to serve 339 child-victims and 99.7 percent of all court recommendations were accepted by judges.

Imagine, A Center For Coping With Loss

Recent studies have found that more than 140,000 children nationwide lost a primary caregiver due to COVID-19, driving a 15% increase in orphaned children. However, these numbers don't include children who lost a parent or primary caregiver due to other causes. The need for grief support programs for children has never been greater.

Imagine offers free peer support groups for children ages 3–18 who have experienced the death of a parent, sibling, or close family member. Groups are also available for young adults ages 18–30, as well as for the parents and guardians of the children in the program. Groups for Spanish speaking bereaved adults are also available. Currently, all groups are being held virtually, though we hope to transition some groups to in-person as soon as it feels safe to do so

Imagine's support groups are only possible



because of our amazing team of volunteers who facilitate the groups. Imagine currently has families waiting to join our support groups. We're unable to offer them support at this time because we don't have enough volunteers to begin another Night of Support. We need your help!

Imagine's volunteer facilitators come from all walks of life and no special background is required other than a willingness to listen, a heart inclined to serve, and the ability to be with children and adults in grief without trying to fix, solve, or give advice. No prior experience is necessary. Volunteers must be 18 years or older.

Bilingual (Spanish speaking) volunteers are needed as well. Volunteers serve as companions and loving listeners for those who are grieving and help create a space where participants can share tears and embrace the joys of life.



HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS USE CREATIVITY TO EXPLORE SOCIAL JUSTICE

Linden Public Schools

A class of students at Linden High School recently used their creativity to explore how racism, bias, and inequity affect their school and the world outside.

The assignment was part of the Introduction

to Education class, where students who may want to become teachers take the first step in learning what it takes to prepare lessons, run a classroom, and shape young minds.

Teacher Anthony Fischetti asked his students to create a piece of art exploring the area of social justice and to record a video discussing the meaning behind the piece. When the projects were done, the class held a gallery walk where the students examined and critiqued one another's work.

Fischetti said he was very pleased with how the project turned out.

"It was great to see they took initiative with their work," he said. "I looked at their reflection videos and they opened up about the message that they had. They put a lot of effort into their work. And the fact that it was going to be displayed was more of an impetus for them to do it well. They wanted it to be their best possible effort."

"I couldn't be prouder of what they did."

During the gallery walk, students and special visitors took time to walk the classroom examining the artwork, which included messages such as "Life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness, but make it for everyone" and "Only humility will lead us to unity, and unity will lead

us to peace." Students jotted down their thoughts for each piece, then shared them with the class after each artist spoke.

The project grew out of the class's exploration of educational diversity, in which students learned about the laws and classroom practices surrounding special education. Fischetti said he wanted to continue that discussion with a discussion of cultural diversity.

"When we started looking at inequity in education, we were talking about a lot of heavy topics with privilege, bias, and systemic racism," Fischetti said. "I didn't want to necessarily lighten the topic, but I wanted to do something that was proactive in getting that message out. I decided on the artwork aspect. From there, we built out the oral presentations."

Fischetti, who gave the students all the art supplies they need to create their projects, said it's rewarding to show Intro to Education students that teachers are responsible for so much more than just teaching the classroom topic.

"They really do build character into their students," he said. "Even if they don't become teachers, the fact that they got to experience this and see it from so many different angles will make them ultimately just better people. For me that is the biggest part."




