GRANT RECIPIENTS & SUCCESSFUL FOOD DRIVE

Fanwood Community Foundation

The Fanwood Community Foundation (FCF)—marking 23 years of service to the community—is proud to announce the six local nonprofits that were awarded grants totaling \$7,300 in 2021. “We’re honored to help support these worthy organizations. We are especially proud to come from a community that comes together to support their own during these last two difficult years,” said FCF President Peter Chemidlin.

THE GRANT RECIPIENTS INCLUDE:

Caring Contact, an award-winning volunteer-staffed caring and crisis hotline and listening community.

CASA of Union County, an organization that trains, supervises, and supports community volunteers to advocate for abused, neglected, and abandoned children placed in foster homes or residential facilities.

Jam Kancer in the Kan Foundation, a Scotch Plains organization that hosts games and events to raise money for organizations fighting cancer and families affected by

cancer; grant monies provided holiday gifts for local families struggling with cancer.

Fanwood Fire Department, protecting homes in Fanwood since 1890; the grant is slated to fund new equipment.

Fanwood Rescue Squad, serving Fanwood and surrounding communities since 1948; the grant monies will fund turnout coats.

Wolves Basketball Academy, an organization which provides a friendly and fun environment for special needs children to learn the fundamentals of basketball and play on a team.

OTHER FCF INITIATIVES:

FCF held a virtual food drive, raising a total of \$2,940 for the Community Food Bank of New Jersey (CFBNJ). FCF matched an additional \$2021, which was delivered directly to the IHM Food Pantry in Scotch Plains—just in time for the holidays. Since the pandemic began, FCF has raised more than \$15,564 for local families.

The Historical Society of Scotch Plains and Fanwood is sponsoring a fundraising campaign to help the Osborn Cannonball House Museum, located in downtown Scotch Plains, which is celebrating its 50th Anniversary this year. The "Cannonball House," named by locals after a cannon misfired and hit the building during The Battle of The Short Hills in Scotch Plains in June 1777, has been open to the public as a teaching museum since 1972.

The building, an 18th century Georgian style home, was built c. 1760, and was home to many noteworthy Scotch Plains families. Jonathan Osborn, who is credited with building the house and who raised 13 children there, was a prominent Scotch Plains citizen who was an innkeeper, tailor and farmer. His Son, David, was a Captain in the NJ Militia and the area's first Clerk and Postmaster. It is also documented that two of Jonathan's sons fought in the Revolutionary War. The Museum is one of the oldest and a unique structure in downtown Scotch Plains.

The Historical Society of Scotch Plains and Fanwood is pursuing the listing of the museum on the NJ State and National Registries of Historic Places. Inclusion on the Registry of Historic Places, while an honor for a property in itself, also provides opportunities for grants to procure funds which are necessary for the continued maintenance of the building to protect it for future generations. A successful nomination to the Registry of Historic Places signifies that a property is an important part of America's cultural heritage and worthy of preservation.

The Cannonball House Museum is open to the public on the first Sunday of every month (except Jan. & Feb.) from 2-4 p.m. with tours by costumed historical interpreters. It is also open for special events, school tours and group tours by appointment.

DEPARTED FANWOOD RESCUE SQUAD MEMBER'S SON CONTINUES A LEGACY OF SERVICE

Borough of Fanwood

Eric Hoyer saw how committed his dad was to the Fanwood Rescue Squad. Indeed, Bob Hoyer, a member from 2006 to 2014, was a top responder for several consecutive years as a driver and first responder. He received Responder of the Year honors at the annual Overlook EMS awards dinner in 2007. His widow Bernadette, who remains active around Fanwood, proudly watched Eric become an EMT in Bridgewater and now as he begins work as a paramedic for Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital.

Members of the rescue squad presented Eric with a letter acknowledging his achievement and the memory of his dad during a surprise visit at Mrs. Hoyer's home in Fanwood on Saturday, Feb. 5, 2022.

"We want to congratulate you on the achievement of your paramedic certification," reads the letter signed by Captain Ian Lewis and President Jamie Pedinoff. "We understand this was a dream and aspiration and we appreciate being able to share this momentous occasion with you and your family."

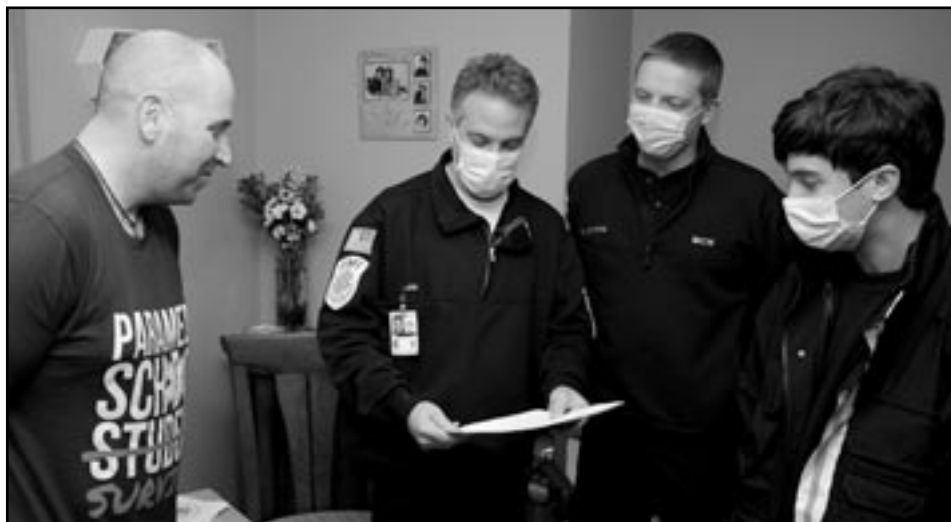
Hoyer, who lives in Raritan, will initially respond with medic units assigned to central New Jersey. Paramedics typically come from the ranks of EMTs and go through a rigorous training program of at least two years. In New Jersey, paramedics are dispatched from hospitals to team with local EMTs on calls that may be life-threatening.

Capt. Lewis and squad members Wes Lewis, Brian Downing and Ed Winsor took part in the drop-in visit.

FLINTLOCKS CELEBRATE 100TH BIRTHDAY OF MEMBER

Not many centenarians get to celebrate their 100th birthday surrounded by friends. On Thursday, February 17, the Flintlocks celebrated Fanwood resident Joe Schott's 100th birthday. Joe has been active in this volunteer group for 33 years since retiring from Bells Labs. He recruited many of his friends to join, and even a few relatives. Joe has a wry sense of humor, so they presented him with a parking plaque which reads: "Reserved Parking Only for Flintlocks Over 100 Years Old."

The Flintlocks are a group of retired scouts who devote every Thursday all year round to helping the Scout Camps. They build cabins,

make picnic tables, paint the dining hall, do maintenance and build craft kits for the Scout shops. The Flintlocks represent a wide range of skills, including: two electricians, a millwright, carpenters, plumbers, diesel mechanics, police officers, heavy equipment operators, but also many professionals such as a dentist, two college professors, computer experts, financial advisors, salesmen, etc.

The most popular craft kits sold at the Cedar Knolls and Mountainside Scout Shops are the bird houses, bird feeders, benches and handy boxes. The men also volunteer at many of the Patriot Path Council activities for the scouts. Since they are a 501c3, they do not need to pay

sales tax, and they provide skilled labor for free. The Council has 3 camps and the volunteers are important to keep things running smoothly. Many of the scouts had children or have grandchildren in the scouts. More than half of the volunteers have been awarded the Silver Beaver Award, which is the highest National Honor offered by the Boy Scouts of America. They are an outstanding group of volunteers.

The Flintlocks meet every Thursday from 8 am to 2 pm at Camp Winnebago in Rockaway. Guests are always welcome. For information, contact Secretary Dr. D. Michael Hart by email drmhart@yahoo.com.

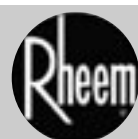

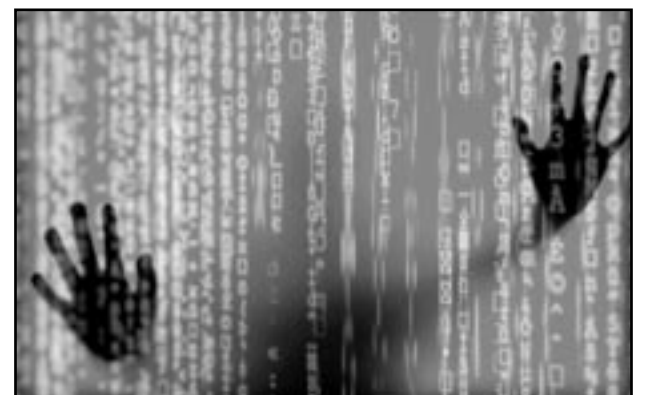

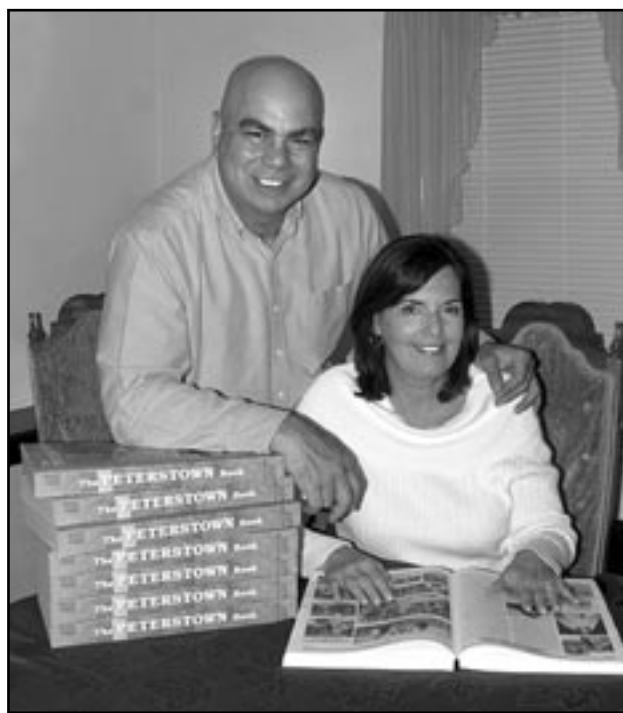
