The Scottish Coalition USA has announced the Award will be awarded to Currie at a ceremony students in the US, Canada, and Scotland. in Alexandria, VA on April 5, 2022.

Currie, raised in Scotch Plains and a current resident of Summit, NJ, is a respected leader in the Scottish American community and has been involved in ethnic affairs and historic preservation for the last 30 years.

Currie, along with the support and guidance of the Scots Gaelic community, reestablished the once famed literary dynasty by forming a family society in 1992. Now a "Learned Kindred" as opposed to a Highland Clan, the far-flung Curries have grown from strength to strength, now counting thousands in their membership rolls and multiple social media outlets on Facebook, YouTube, and Twitter among others.

The Society's signature events include "Tartan Day on Ellis Island" (founded in 2002) and the award-winning "Pipes of Christmas" concerts now in its 24th year. The Society has distributed thousands of dollars in scholarships to deserving

The Society is also the Title Sponsor of the US National Scottish Harp Championship and was at the forefront of developing cultural heritage tents specifically for harp, fiddle and Gaelic singing at Scottish games in the United States.

In recognition of his years of service to the Scottish American community, Bob received the Ellis Island Medal of Honor in 2017. He has also received an Honorary Doctorate from Edinburgh Napier University in Scotland and was also the recipient of the Saltire Award from St. Andrew's University in Laurinburg, North Carolina.

In November of 2017, Bob received the International Gaelic Leader Award from Scotland's Bòrd na Gàidhlig – the departmental public body of the Scottish Government with responsibility for Gaelic. #### ROTARY SUPPORTS UKRAINE – YOU CAN HELP

In response to the humanitarian crisis in Ukraine, the Fanwood-Scotch Plains Rotary Club set up a collection to support Ukrainian refugees who have fled to surrounding countries as well as those who remain in the country. According to the United Nations, the senseless war has forced over 2 million people to flee to surrounding countries, while over a million have been displaced within Ukraine.

The club kicked off a humanitarian relief effort on March 8th. The primary area of focus is sending donations to Shelterbox, a disaster response organization who will provide temporary transitional housing and other essential supplies. They will also send funds to organizations within Ukraine and Poland to help the people remaining within Ukraine and those who have left the country. The list of organizations who will receive money include: Rotary Clubs in Ukraine, the Rotary Club of Warsaw in Poland and Rotary International Disaster Fund.

The FSP Rotary Club sent a \$1,000 donation to Shelterbox, \$1,000 to the Disaster Fund and \$1000 to Rotary Clubs. As of March 16th, Rotarians and members of the community have already donated an additional \$2,500.

The club is also sending supplies to Ukraine and are working with the Greater Westfield Chapter of Unico National. They are collecting aspirin, bandages, band-aids, tourniquet gauze, gauze pads, medical tape and medical gloves. These can be dropped off at Apple Blossom in Scotch Plains through April 15th.

## **EARTH DAY RAHWAY RIVER CLEAN-UP - APRIL 23**

All volunteers are invited to celebrate Earth Day 2022 with Boy Scout Troop 330, Cub Scout Pack 30 and members of the Rahway River Watershed Association in a clean-up of the Rahway River on Saturday, April 23rd (with a rain date of Sunday, April 24th). The clean-up will focus on areas upstream and downstream of the dam at Winfield Park, New Jersey throughout Rahway River Park. Please plan to stop by the parking area adjacent to the waterfall of the Rahway River by the dam at Winfield Park at 8:45 a.m. to register, pick up bags, gloves, bottled water and snacks, and receive safety information.

Teams will be encouraged to travel to any part of the river within the park where they would like to perform cleanup activities but we specifically will ask folks to always work in small groups for safety purposes with folks socially distanced.

Cleaning up a river and park area is a great suggestions on areas with large volumes of way to celebrate Earth Day and if you haven't participated in an event like this before, you will find it invigorating, and you will feel good about what you have accomplished. It is also fun and educational, especially for scouts and young adults as they always find something interesting. Over the 20+ years this cleanup has occurred thousands of folks have participated, including girl scouts, cub scouts, boy scouts, fishermen, local activists and citizens, and we pulled some amazing things from the river.

As caseworkers, foster placements, and schools can change frequently, CASA volunteers often are the only consistent, caring adult in a youth's corner, helping ensure already experienced trauma is not exacerbated as youth await permanency in a safe and loving home.

Scotch Plains' Julia Dranishnikov has worked in education and volunteered for AmeriCorp. Her

journey in advocacy continues now as a CASA volunteer to positively impact kids in the community.

Judge DiFabrizio presided over the Zoom swearing-in ceremony of Dranishnikov and her classmates Lynda Sun Lee of Berkeley Heights, Katherine (Katie) Rabiecki of Cranford, Dina Gharaibeh of Kearny, Lila Monroe of Roselle, and Robert Mallard of Union. In commemoration with gratitude, Judge DiFabrizio noted, "Thank you all for your commitment, passion, hard work, and loyalty to these families that desperately need it. It takes a village and now you're a part of it." Each volunteer will now be matched to a foster youth or foster sibling set, and begin putting their 30-hour training into practice, ensuring their needs are met and best interests are protected while they await permanency.

Anyone passionate about making a difference in a child's life can apply to volunteer; there is no prior experience or background needed to serve as an advocate. Each undergoes a thorough training process and is supported by CASA staff throughout their work. Successful advocates have varied life experiences and this class is no exception, as professional backgrounds include social work, education, judicial clerkship, health management, and business.

Upon being court-ordered to a case, the CASA volunteer has access to the youth's foster parents, doctors, caseworkers, therapists, and teachers and, through their regular child visits, identify and report to the judge any concerns and needs in order to protect the child's best interests.

As the only nonprofit serving as extra eyes and ears for Union County judges hearing cases of youth in the child welfare system, the organization regularly recruits community volunteers to serve these local child-victims from birth to age 21.

#### **BEWARE OF FRAUDS AND SCAMS**

Frauds and scams have become an easy crime an attorney right now. of choice in the 21st century.

In 2021, consumers lost more than \$5.8 billion to fraud, up 70% over 2020! Almost 2.8 million people filed a fraud complaint, an annual record. Imposter scams were most prevalent, but investment scams cost the typical victim the most money, CNBC reports

Many of the victims in our community are elderly. But don't be mistaken, criminals are not picky; they will victimize anyone willing to fall for a common scam.

Last year, several Scotch Plains residents were targeted with the commonly-known 'Grandparent' or 'Imposter' scam. A suspect reviews the social media accounts of an elderly individual for personal information, such as family members. Then, the suspect pretends to be the person's grandchild, claiming they need bail, or have been in a serious accident or need to pay

Many start the conversation with, 'Hi Grandpa or Grandma, do you know who this is?' (They want victims to say the name of their grandchild so that they can claim to be that person.) Scammers will then instruct the victim to purchase a gift card or wire money to help out in this "emergency." They don't want the victim to think, just act.

The Scotch Plains police are also aware of online shopping fraud as well as investment scams, resulting in large amounts of stolen money.

#### HERE ARE FOUR SIGNS TO BE AWARE OF:

- 1. Scammers pretend to be from an organization you know.
- 2. Scammers say there's a problem or a prize.
- 3. Scammers pressure you to act immediately.
- 4. Scammers tell you to pay in a specific way; gift card, wire the money, etc.

We are asking residents to protect themselves and loved ones by blocking unwanted calls and text messages, by not giving out personal or financial information and to use a smartphone app that detects spam and fraud calls.

Please remember that no reputable company, police department, lawyer, etc. will ask for payment with a gift card or a wire transfer.

If someone calls you seeking money, ask for their name and call-back number. If you receive a text or email with links, even if it appears real, don't click the links. And, most importantly, resist the urge to respond immediately.

If you receive a call, text or email that appears fraudulent, please contact the Scotch Plains Police Department at 908-322-7100. We will stop by your house to take a look at the suspicious message. We would rather take a few minutes to help out a resident, rather than having any more victims to scams.
