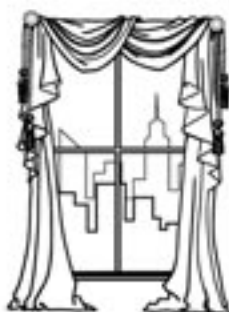

SAFER STREETS TO WALK, BIKE, ROLL

New Jersey Bike & Walk Coalition

The NJ Safe Passing Law (NJSPL) (A5570/S2208), recently put into effect, provides clear rules of the road for all motorists about when and how to pass people sharing the road on foot, on bicycles, on scooters, wheelchairs, or in other legally permitted ways to travel other than a motor vehicle.

The bipartisan bill, sponsored and cosponsored by 16 Senators and Assembly members, was approved 102-1 by the NJ Legislature and signed by Governor Phil Murphy.

The Safe Passing Law requires drivers to use “due caution” whenever they see vulnerable people on the road.

THE LAW STATES THAT:

1. Drivers must follow all current no-passing, no speeding laws and move over a lane if there's one to move into.
2. On a single-lane road, drivers must allow at least a 4-foot safety zone when they pass.
3. If 4 feet is not possible on a section of road, drivers must slow to 25mph and be prepared to stop until they can pass safely without endangering those sharing the road.

Last year was the deadliest in the past 14 years for drivers, and the deadliest in 30 years for the most vulnerable road users: people walking, cycling, and rolling.

The pandemic led to a surge of car and truck traffic on our roads along with increased

speeding. COVID also led to more people using the roads on foot or on wheels—by choice or necessity.

“Driver and passenger fatalities are up 18%, while pedestrian fatalities are up 24%, and cyclist fatalities are up 28%. The NJ Safe Passing Law is the strongest safe passing law in the country and with the increase in road fatalities and serious injuries across the state, it comes at a critical time,” said Debra Kagan, Executive Director of the New Jersey Bike & Walk Coalition.

“This legislation was long overdue. Last year alone 246 of our vulnerable road users—pedestrians and bicyclists—died on NJ roadways,” said Sangetta Badlani, Founder of Nikhil Badlani Foundation and Families for Safe Streets NJ. “This law prioritizes safety and is a step towards ending the heartbreak that so many families suffer from a loss of a loved one in a preventable crash.”

This law is aimed at protecting pedestrians and bicyclists from the most aggressive drivers,” said John Boyle Research Director for the Bicycle Coalition of Greater Philadelphia.

“New Jersey’s Safe Passing law, the most comprehensive in the nation, is the result of over a decade of hard work by advocates. We look forward to continuing to work with leaders in Trenton to make our streets safer for all road users in our state, especially those who are most vulnerable,” said Janna Chernetz, Deputy Director, Tri-State Transportation Campaign.

MILLBURN TOWNSHIP FOUNDING DAY CELEBRATION

A Day of Community Service, Historical Education, and Family Activities

The Millburn Township Founding Day Celebration is the first annual event celebrating the founding of the town in 1857. It will take place on Saturday, April 30, 2022 from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. with most activities centered around the Bauer Center in historic Taylor Park. Volunteers are welcome to help with the town wide litter cleanup and bring donations for the local food pantry. There will be activities for all ages, including native garden planting, distribution of seeds to plant at home to attract Monarch butterflies, learning how to write letters in the 19th century style, historical interpreters, guided historic tours and historic selfie backdrops.

There will be live music from the Victorian

Era by the Florian Shantz Jazz Combo, outdoor art gallery unveilings in the alleyway adjacent to Goldberg's Deli, and an exhibit of historical documents and artifacts from Millburn's history. Refreshments will be provided in 21st century style with the sweet addition of historic candy.

Explore Millburn-Short Hills is providing additional services including a power washing of Upper Millburn Avenue, the maintenance and repair of 50 tree pits throughout town and the installation of four large flowerpots. Explore encourages all participants to tour the town, shop local and make a day of it to celebrate the great history - and current success - of Millburn-Short Hills. MILLBURN STREET FAIR - SUNDAY, APRIL 24TH

The annual spring Millburn Street Fair will take place on Sunday, April 24th from a.m. to 5 p.m. on Millburn Avenue between Main Street and Spring Street. Admission and parking are free. The festival is sponsored by the Millburn-Short Hills Chamber of Commerce.

Since 1961, the SAGE Eldercare Workshop has offered the public fine-quality furniture repair. The volunteers will consider repairing any piece of furniture that can be carried into the workshop. The Workshop has a reputation throughout Union County and beyond for its fine reweaving of caned and rushed chairs. Our artisans are all highly trained volunteers. Proceeds from the Workshop benefit SAGE programming. Prices are reasonable and depend upon the condition of the chair or furniture item and the materials required in the restoration process.

The Workshop started out years ago as a place for older men who no longer had access to a home workbench. Since 2007, several women have joined the historically male enclave. Most of the volunteers are former professionals including investment bankers, college professors, physicians and scientists. Many have never worked with their hands and over the years, they've taught each other caning, rushing and a myriad of other techniques needed to fix the aging furniture brought to them for restoration.

Prim La Capra of Short Hills recently patronized the workshop. She had a table restored that had suffered from years of use and weathering. "I am so grateful to the volunteers who refinished my little table to its original beauty. My late husband bought this well-crafted table from Bloomingdales' NYC store decades ago and it became a special place to store important documents, memorabilia, pictures, and other things we wanted to keep in our library." Said Prim. "It got water damage on top and sun damage on the sides over the years. The volunteers at Sage Elder Care completely restored it at a reasonable cost. I love how the piece turned out and plan to keep it for many more years. Thank you to the volunteers who contributed their skills, time, and talent to this project. It was a pleasure to work with Bob, the shop manager and visit the workshop."

The Workshop is located in the basement of the SAGE building at 290 Broad Street, Summit and is easily assessable. Shop hours are Mondays through Fridays, 8:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.

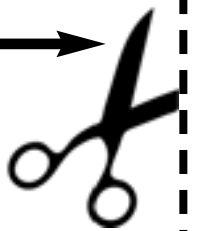

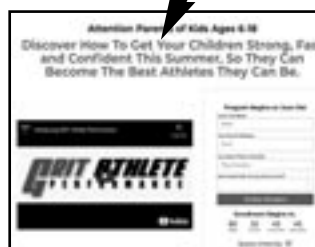

LOCAL AUTHOR PUBLISHES THE SCHOOLING OF A 21st CENTURY PRINCIPAL

Michael L. Cahill, of Florham Park, recently self-published a memoir entitled *The Schooling of a 21st Century Principal*. It conveys his various roles and experiences in education, primarily in the Millburn Township Public Schools district.

The Hoboken native and Seton Hall graduate always wanted to be a teacher. After serving at what was then the Summit Junior High for three

years, there was no longer a position available to him. Cahill then worked for a year in two corporate positions in Manhattan and was interviewed in the lobby of the New York Museum of Modern Art by a Millburn supervisor who was chaperoning a field trip. It was the inauguration of 30 years of service in Millburn as a teacher, team leader, coordinator, assistant principal, and principal.

In his memoir, Cahill tells his readers that

becoming a principal was never on his bucket list. The confluence of timing, mentors, and opportunity led him to his leadership post.

Cahill highlights the challenges he faced as principal, starting with the events of 9/11 on his fourth day on the job. His middle school enrollment was soaring from 513 to nearly 1200 students, making space - bond referendums and construction projects - a priority. New standards for learning, a more demanding standardized test, and teacher evaluations hitched to the performance of students generated stress for students, teachers, and parents.

He proudly recalls wonderful highlights of his tenure as well. Several events for Holocaust survivors, including the "Prom of Your Dreams," were sponsored by Millburn Middle School. The school's peer leadership programs involved hundreds of students in service to their school and various community, national and international projects. Unique guidance programs promoted career awareness, mental health initiatives, and intergenerational communication.

The writer chronicles the many reforms and mandates that swept schools everywhere during the second decade of the new millennium, and he also details the cultural shifts in schools due to stress, school shootings, aggressive parents, and rising mental illness among preadolescents and adolescents. *The Schooling of a 21st Century Principal* is a portrait of the changing landscape of schools and the principalship.

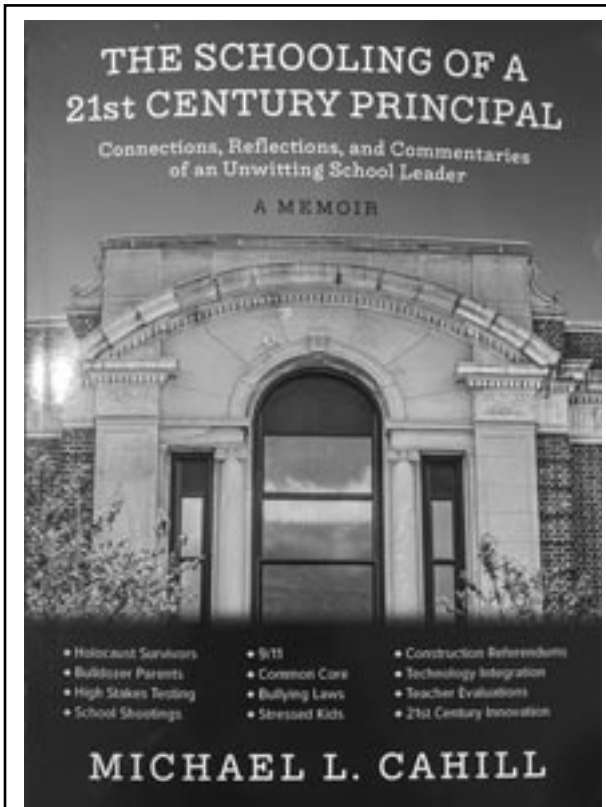

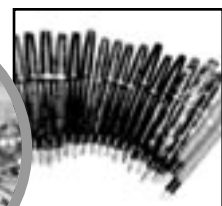

Save the date for the latest Chatham-Madison Town-Wide Yard Sale. It will be held rain or shine on Saturday, April 30 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in Chatham Borough, Chatham Township and Madison. Once again, this popular community event features a fundraiser for the Great Swamp Watershed Association (GSWA). Residents may list their sales on a digital map with a \$10 tax-deductible donation to GSWA.

The GSWA and the three towns will publicize the map extensively through their media outlets. Previous yard sales have attracted hundreds of shoppers from PA, NY and all over NJ. The spring 2021 event featured 110 household sales with hundreds of items changing hands, raising \$1,100 for the GSWA.

This event is open and free for all residents of the three towns. You don't need a permit or other official registration. You don't need to join the digital map to take part (although it is a good way to attract buyers, particularly if you list the available items). You don't need to pay to advertise your sale anywhere else, the marketing is extensive, but can if you want to. Put signs in your neighborhood to help buyers find your event on the morning of the sale.

"We are excited to once again be hosting the town-wide yard sale," said Claire Whitcomb, chair of the Madison Environmental Commission. "It's so much easier to de-clutter when you know that your items are going to a good cause, or to a new home," continued

Whitcomb.

Once again, neighbors in the Highland Avenue area of Chatham Borough will combine to host a "FreeCycle" event with all items free to shoppers. Organizer Susie Robertson says, "The Yard Sale is a great way to get items out of the bulk-pickup and into the hands of someone else who could use them. I encourage everyone to discuss hosting a multi-family sale on your block and enjoy a fun and profitable morning with your neighbors," continued Robertson.

Homeowners can arrange pickups of sale leftovers by contacting the following nonprofits: the Vietnam Veterans of America (vva.org), GreenDrop (gogreendrop.com), the Market Street Mission (marketstreet.org) and Habitat for Humanity's ReStore (morrisrestore.org/donate).

"Anything with a plug" can be placed in the collection bin at 8 Emery Ave, Randolph (M-F 9:00 A.M.-3:00 P.M.) for "E-cycling" by GreenVision, Inc.

Madison residents may also post items on Madison Swap and Share NJ, a Facebook group of with 2100 sharers and borrowers. Chatham Borough and Chatham Township residents may post items to the Buy Nothing Chatham, NJ Facebook group with 650 FreeCyclers. At any time of the year, these are great ways to keep items out of the landfill and to repurpose items you may not need, but someone else is happy to use.

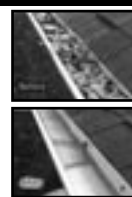
