FURNITURE WORKSHOP BENEFITS SAGE ELDERCARE

Since 1961, the SAGE Eldercare Workshop has offered the public fine-quality furniture repair. The volunteers will consider repairing any piece of furniture that can be carried into the workshop. The Workshop has a reputation throughout Union County and beyond for it's fine reweaving of caned and rushed chairs. Our artisans are all highly trained volunteers. Proceeds from the Workshop benefit SAGE programming. Prices are reasonable and depend upon the condition of the chair or furniture item and the materials required in the restoration

The Workshop started out years ago as a place for older men who no longer had access to a home workbench. Since 2007, several women have joined the historically male enclave. Most of the volunteers are former professionals including investment bankers, college professors, physicians and scientists. Many have never worked with their hands and over the years, they've taught each other caning, rushing and a myriad of other techniques needed to fix the aging furniture brought to them for restoration.

The goal is for all New Jersey Students to receive explicit and sustained instruction in Civics, which has been missing on New Jersey schools for several decades! The law S-854 was named after Laura Wooten who was the longest continuously serving election board worker in the United States. It is anticipated that the students will gain an understanding of the role of a citizen in a democratic society.

Each summer for over seventy years, The American Legion and its Auxiliaries have been providing a weeklong experience in Government at Boys State and Girls State programs throughout the country. Each group experiences how elections are handled on the local and county levels and how a campaign is run by campaigning for various positions. They also experience how local and county governments work by setting up a local government. As the week progresses a Governor for Girls State is elected after a vigorous campaign for votes. Two Senators are elected at the end of the week to represent New Jersey at Girls Nation, which is a weeklong experience in Washington, D.C. involving the Senators in government at the National level.





CASA CREATES AWARENESS OF CHILD ABUSE

The month of April highlighted child abuse awareness. Court Appointed Special Advocates for Children of Essex County (CASA of Essex) celebrated their volunteers during Volunteer Appreciation Week for their effort to change foster children's lives. Additionally, in honor of CASA Child Advocate Month, CASA of Essex partnered with over twenty-five local businesses to help raise awareness by planting blue pinwheel gardens throughout the county, as a reminder that every child deserves a safe childhood.

To shed much needed light on the severity of child abuse—every ten seconds, an allegation of child abuse is reported nationwide, and over 4.3 million children are impacted yearly. Nearly fifty percent of those children are under the age of five. In New Jersey, it is estimated that there are 2.2 million residents of New Jersey, aged 18 and under; and among that total, nearly 6,300

children each year are living in homes that are not their own, having been removed, for even just one night, because of abuse or neglect and placed in foster care.

With these staggering numbers in tow, CASA of Essex focuses on recruiting and training volunteers to uplift the voices of abused and neglected children. CASA volunteers represent all walks of life with diverse backgrounds, professions, and skill sets. They undergo an extensive and intensive specialized training that provide them with the knowledge needed to be the court's eyes and ears for children in and out of court, thereby improving the quality of information presented to the court. By advocating on a child's behalf, a CASA volunteer works to ensure that each child has access to the services they need and the opportunity to thrive.




