STUDENTS BUILD THEIR OWN POWERFUL COMPUTER

Under the Linden Public Schools One-to-One technology policy, every student is given an Apple device for schoolwork. But a group of McManus Middle School students went a big step further and built their own computer.

The students worked with the help and guidance of technology teacher Howard Schulz, but much of the work came from their own ambition and ingenuity – and on their own time before and after school.

The students are involved in McManus' "Tiger News: Live," a weekly news show they livestream to highlight school news. They first discussed building a PC to give them more processing power for livestreaming, graphics, gaming, and camera switching. Their creation has a 32 MHz Ryzen 7 5800 Processor and 32 GB of RAM.

The students explained that the process started with them watching online, step-by-step tutorials on how to build a PC. They then used an app called PC Building Simulator that allows a user to virtually build a computer. The simulator shows how different parts – such as a mother board, a CPU, and cooling unit – fit and work together, right down to the last screw.

They then use a website called PC Part Picker to get prices and choose parts.

Schulz, who worked with the support of Supervisor of Instructional Technology Joseph Scaldino, then made sure the parts they needed

are available through school vendors. The PC starts as an empty black case, but students add parts to it piece by piece according to their design. He emphasized that he made sure everybody got a chance to be involved since the students started out at different skill levels.

The students who took part are Mohamed Gueye, Gabriella Vazquez, Christopher Joyner, Jacob Gonczowski, Max Rodriguez, Jakai Koonce-Motley, Mathew Kozak, Jeriah Watson, and Maksymilian Jadczuk.

They were all enthusiastic about the project, as well as producing the weekly news show, and spent their own time doing the work.



LINDEN HIGH ATHLETICS EARNS NATIONAL HONOR

Linden High School has been awarded national honor roll status for its commitment to continual development of its athletics coaches to help them better lead and protect student athletes.

LHS is one of just 95 schools across the country to meet the requirements for Level 1 of the Honor Roll Program of the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS). Only five schools in New Jersey have been honored.

"This is an achievement that your school and community should celebrate," said Dan Schuster, NFHS director of educational services. "The NFHS School Honor Roll program provides a pathway for coaches within schools to be honored for their involvement in professional development."

To reach Level 1 of the Honor Roll, more than 90 percent of LHS coaches must complete four



required professional development courses, which are "Concussion in Sports," "Sudden Cardiac Arrest," "Protecting Students from Abuse," and "Fundamentals of Coaching."

"Our coaches demonstrate their total dedication to their student-athletes on a daily basis, and this honor is a product of that commitment," said Athletic Director Steven Viana. "We couldn't be prouder that our coaches seek out these professional development opportunities to ensure that Linden athletes always get the best."

This prestigious honor comes on the heels of LHS receiving the Safe Sports School Award

from the National Athletic Trainers Association in 2019. This honor recognizes secondary schools around the country that take the crucial steps necessary to put their athletes in the safest possible environment.

To achieve Safe Sports School status, LHS had to demonstrate a positive athletics health care administration system, including appropriate physical exams for each sport, safe facilities, appropriate treatment areas, emergency action plans for each venue, athlete education, and more.

"These two honors together demonstrate the total commitment of our administration, coaches, and athletic trainers to make sure student-athletes are protected and cared for on and off the field," Viana said. "Our staff is committed to allowing them to concentrate on pursuing excellence and having fun on the field without undue concerns for their health and safety."


GRAND OPENING OF NEW THRIFT SHOP

VOLUNTEERS SWORN IN AS ADVOCATES FOR LOCAL FOSTER YOUTH

CASA of Union County

The latest classes of community members to step up and train as advocates for Union County foster youth have officially taken their oath before Union County Superior Court Judge Lara DiFabrizio and become the newest volunteers with Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of Union County.

Since 2005, the nonprofit has recruited, trained, supported and supervised nearly 600 community volunteers to advocate for more than 950 such youth, protecting best interests and ensuring needs are met in the courtroom, classroom and community. As caseworkers, foster placements and schools can change frequently, CASA volunteers often are the only consistent, caring adult in a youth's corner, helping ensure already experienced trauma is not exacerbated as youth await permanency in a safe and loving home.

Judge DiFabrizio presided over two swearingin ceremonies via Zoom and, prior to asking each to repeat their oath "to protect, respect, and report," she shared appreciation and gratitude for the new advocates' desire to make a lasting positive impact on youth in the community. "I like to thank CASA volunteers who take on this very important role. You do this because you want to make a difference in a child's life and make the world a better place. The court is grateful and thankful. You have a special opportunity to seriously help a child and family live and succeed. You're part of the village now."

The 14 new CASA volunteers are Jackie Parker and Lynda Sun Lee of Berkeley Heights; Loretta Masterson and Katherine (Katie) Rabiecki of Cranford; Dina Ghazi of Kearny; Ana Gutierrez of Basking Ridge; Janae Bunn of Linden; Julia Dranishnikov and Tamiah Chester of Scotch Plains; Philip Ross of Summit; Lila Monroe and Mark Papa of Roselle; and Robert Mallard and Roya Enayati Basu of Union. Next, each advocate will be matched to a youth or sibling set, and begin putting their 30-hour training into practice.

Anyone passionate about making a difference

in a child's life can apply to volunteer; there is no prior experience or special background needed to serve as an advocate. Each undergoes a thorough training process and is supported by CASA staff throughout their work. Successful advocates have varied life experiences and these classes are no exception, as professional backgrounds include education, business, social work, law, and health management.

Upon being court-ordered to a case, CASA volunteers have access to the youth's foster parents, doctors, caseworkers, therapists, and teachers and, through regular child visits, identify and report to the judge any concerns and needs. CASA of Union County is the only nonprofit serving as extra eyes and ears for local judges hearing cases of youth from birth to age 21 in the child welfare system.

And then the pandemic hit, leading to a spike in client demand, exacerbating all these problems.

"Dignity has been a core value of the agency since our founding in 1983," noted Bernadette Murphy, Executive Director. "Our goal is to help people acquire the material items they need to live with dignity. We believe that it is vital for our clients to receive food, clothing, supplies and support services in an environment that fosters dignity, where the homeless and poor are truly welcomed as brothers and sisters. In order to achieve this goal and expand and improve the services we offer, we have developed a vision for





a remodeled campus. Our vision is to construct a been extraordinary." Six days a week a dedicated new building on our property where it will be possible to create a client choice food pantry with hours by appointment; to construct a second new building for the donation and distribution of clothing and home goods; to reconfigure and pave our lot to make it easier to pick up and drop off items and to reduce traffic on the surrounding streets; and to renovate space in our former church building, parish hall and house on site to improve the ability of St. Joseph's and The Elizabeth Coalition House the Homeless, our sister agency, to provide support services."

"St. Joe's has been open six days a week throughout the pandemic" stated Harold Kessler, President of the Board of Trustees. "We have never missed a day. Our staff and volunteers have placed the needs of the community in Elizabeth ahead of their own health and well-being. It's team of volunteers, numbering in the thousands, makes sandwiches for the hungry in their kitchens in Westfield, Cranford, Basking Ridge and dozens of other communities, bring food, clothing and home goods, serve meals at the soup kitchen and help with the operations of the agency. St. Joseph's provides over 250,000 meals per year. In addition, the organization provides area residents with clothing, household items, prescription assistance, health screenings, mental health counseling, job training and case management.

Or clients can bring a plant, lawn, or insect samples to the office. Specimens are the surest way to guarantee a proper identification.

Hours are Monday to Thursday, 10 a.m. until 2 p.m., and Friday 10 a.m. until noon.

The Garden Helpline volunteers are well trained to identify tick* species including 'deer ticks' which transmit Lymes disease to humans and pets.

This is an extremely valuable service as the deer and tick populations continue to grow in New Jersey.

The Asian Lantern-fly invaded Union County last spring and has already damaged many fruit trees and vines. The Helpline will keep you updated on the latest information how to control this colorful but destructive leaf hopper.

In addition to garden critters the Helpline will identify house infesting insects such as carpenter ants, termites and food infesting pest.
