COMMUNITY DAY - JUNE 5 - A SUMMER RAPTOR FESTIVAL

The Raptor Trust's annual Community Day will take place on Sunday, June 5, 2022 from 11 a.m. - 3 p.m.

We're excited to welcome friends, visitors, and supporters for a day that honors the important lives of our feathered friends. we'll have raptor demonstrations, tours, a scavenger hunt, a food truck, raffle, silent auction, and more! All proceeds will support our spring and summer efforts to help birds of New Jersey

In our 39+ years, TRT has admitted over 130,000 birds for care. Spring and summer are our busiest time of year, and we're preparing for the adorable invasion of tiny Robins, Great Horned Owl fluffballs, and baby Blue Jays with an attitude, among hundreds of other youngsters.

The average cost of one bird's total rehabilitation is currently \$237, and, because we admit an average of 5,000-6,000 birds per year, those costs quickly add up. All proceeds from the event provide resources for these busy monthsfrom purchasing food and medicine for injured birds of all ages and species, to maintaining the caging and grounds that visitors can now enjoy.

TRT is committed making a long-term impact. With your help, we will continue to play a major role in conserving local wild bird populations and reducing the suffering of wildlife in the tri-state

The Raptor Trust is located at 1390 White Bridge Road, Millington, NJ. Approximately 50 resident birds are on exhibit in large outdoor aviaries viewed by walking along the trails. Living on the campus of the Trust throughout the year is variety of raptors and birds of prey. Currently, the Trust is home to two Bald Eagles, Turkey Vultures, Barred Owls, Great Horned Owls, Ravens, Screech Owls, Red-Tailed Hawks, a Snowy Owl and many more!

The aviaries are open to the public seven days of week. Our visiting hours during the fall, winter and spring are 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. During the summer we are open to visitors from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. There is no cost to come by for a self-guided tour, however, we ask you to consider a small donation of \$2 per person.

The Raptor Trust is a 501(c)(3) not for profit organization which provides free medical care to thousands of orphaned or injured birds each year. Our infirmary staff is available seven days a week during daylight hours to admit injured birds, but we must rely on the people who find them to bring them to us for care. If you find a bird that needs help, please visit our website theraptortrust.org for instructions. We cannot do what we do without the kindness of many – including our visitors!

LOCAL YOUTH CAPTURES GOLD MEDAL FOR US SOCCER

The United States u17 women's soccer team participated in the Concacaf Tournament in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic April 23-May 8, 2022. Warren resident Melina Rebimbas was a member and standout of that team that captured the Gold. After defeating their first 5 opponents by the margin of 43-0, the United States was up to the task in the semifinal round defeating Canada 3-0 behind 2 goals from Melina Rebimbas and she scored the game winner in the championship game versus rival Mexico 2-1. Melina finished the tournament with 8 goals. "I was extremely excited to represent my country. Like every little kid growing up playing soccer their dream is to have the opportunity to wear the US crest and this was my dream too... but to be able to score 3 goals in the last two games was nothing that I could have imagined."

Melina began her soccer journey in town playing recreation soccer and soon thereafter she became a member of the travel team and eventually her desire for greater competition took her to the Player Development Academy (PDA). It was at PDA that she began to blossom into one of the elite players in the country. Rebimbas explained, "I was very fortunate to be given an opportunity early to play at PDA. Everyone at PDA is super motivated to be challenged, and they set the bar high for excellence. That expectation of excellence provided me with a

blueprint on what I had to do to be successful."

She is currently ranked 6th nationally in the 2023 graduation class by Top Drawer Soccer and has already committed to playing soccer at the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill. Where she will be mentored by Legendary and 23-time national championship coach Anson Dorrance.



PEER SUPPORT GROUP AVAILABLE FOR VETS

County of Morris

The Morris County Veterans Services Office and NewBridge Services have begun a bimonthly veteran peer support group, which meets the first and third Thursdays of each month from 7 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Sessions are free to all veterans no matter their length of service or discharge status. Veteran Tim Slavin is facilitating and guiding the conversations among veterans to aid in healing and recovery.

The veteran peer support group meets at the Morris County Veterans Service Office at 540 West Hanover Ave., in Morris Township. The entrance is at the rear of the Morris View Healthcare Center. Veterans who were in combat or separated from family for extended periods may experience added life stressors; peer support groups may help.

"A peer support group for veterans is a way to come together to share stories of the stressors of deployment and the impact this stress has had on their lives," NewBridge CEO Michelle Borden said. "It allows for an opportunity to forge connections of hope, recovery, and support and to know they are not alone."

The veteran peer support group is one of three initiatives approved by the Morris County Board of County Commissioners in September at the recommendation of Commissioner Deputy Director John Krickus, a U.S. Marine Corps veteran. The County launched a program to host veteran roundtables and social events last fall, and the County Department of Human Services is working to launch a veteran and family support counseling program soon.

Krickus said that he wants veterans, including those who served in Iraq and Afghanistan, "to know that we not only honor their service on Veterans Day and Memorial Day, but we are here to support you every day of the year."



Michael, 13 years old, competed in the youth Advanced Skill level for both Gi (Brazilian jiujitsu) and No-Gi (all submission grappling styles, such as wrestling and judo) divisions, as well as challenged himself in doing extra divisions. Michael also bumped up from the Advanced skill level to the Expert skill level in the No-Gi division (which is the highest skill level bracket). Mikey won 3 Gold medals for all 3 divisions that he competed in. He also won the NAGA Championship belt by winning first place in the Expert division. Michael won a tough match by defeating a competitor who is a 4-time International Brazilian Jiu Jitsu Federation Pan Am Champion and 3-time IBJJF American Kids Nationals Champ. Michael won the match by doing a triangle submission on his

Samantha, 11 years old, competed in 4 divisions and won 2 Golds and 2 Silvers. She competed in Gi and No-Gi divisions and challenged herself by bumping up to the Boy's bracket and higher weight class. Samantha competed in the Intermediate division and received a Katana Samurai sword for winning first place. She defeated the 2021 Pan Am IBJJF Champion in the No-Gi division.

Michael and Samantha will be training hard for potentially competing in the IBJJF Pan-American Championships in Florida this summer. The Pan Am Jiu Jitsu Championship is the largest Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu tournament held in North America and one of the most prestigious BJJ tournaments in the world. It has been held annually by the International Brazilian Jiu Jitsu Federation since 1995. Last year, nearly 2,000 kids from all over the world competed in the 2day event.

Michael and Samantha are trained and coached by 6 time-World Champion Vitor Shaolin Ribeiro and National Champion Andre Motta at the VSBJJA Academy in Scotch Plains. Recently, they have also supplemented their training with Judo under 2x Olympic Judoka Colton Brown in Warren.


HONORING OUR VETERANS


