


ABOUT SALEM ROADHOUSE CAFÉ

Aphasia is a communication disorder that impairs the expression and understanding of spoken language, reading, and writing. It occurs most often from a stroke or other brain injury. It

affects a person's ability to communicate, but not his or her intellect. This communication disorder affects 40% of all stroke and brain trauma survivors. 
