ORDER OF OPERATIONS AT KUMPF SCHOOL

Sixth-grade students in Mrs. Lauren Cesare’s class at Carl H. Kumpf Middle School solved order of operation questions using “operating rooms”. Students were given a “patient chart” which was a response recording sheet. Patients were at their own tables and students needed to correctly solve each expression (using PEMDAS) to perform their surgery successfully. Each doctor was assigned an “Operating Room” where they worked on their patient. Once their surgery was completed, they moved to a different table to work on the next patient and solve the next problem. Students each had their own doctor's badge with their school pictures on them from Cesare Medical Center.

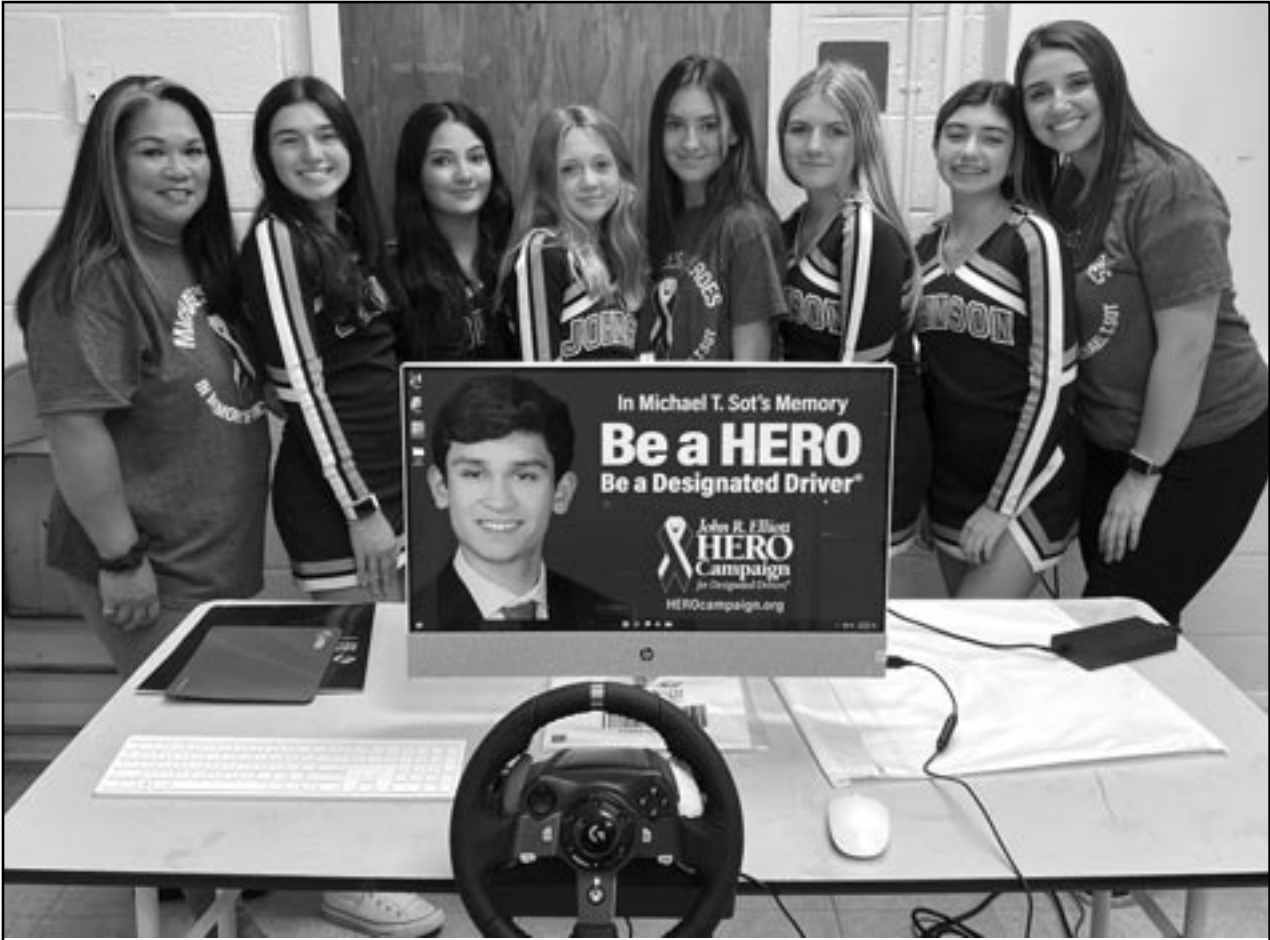
