### **GARWOOD GREEN TEAM AND LIQUID CHURCH JOIN FORCES**

On Saturday, October 15, the Garwood Green Team joined forces with volunteers from the Liquid Church on Center Street to install a new landscape at the entrance/exit of the JFK parking lot on North Avenue. As you will see in this reading, many, many people made this day a success, and kudos are extended to all for a great end result. Go out and take a look!

Church members Jaz Barredo, Isaiah, Keisha and Tiffany Kinyanjui, Trent Mattern, Robin and Gianna Miller, and Robert and Caleb Price, met with Pastor Zarida Brokenborough to commence the day with a prayer, and then met Green Team members Charles Lombardo and Bill Nierstedt at the site to place all of the plants and commence digging holes. The Garwood Department of Public Works had already picked up the plants

from Statile Nurseries in Springfield, leaf mulch from the Westfield Conservation Center (Thank you, Westfield), and wood chips from Fanwood (Thank you, Fanwood). After digging all 17 holes, the Garwood Fire Department (thank you!) arrived to water all of the plants. The group even transplanted three forsythia shrubs to a new location on the other side of the parking lot. Everyone backfilled the holes with the new leaf mulch and finished the plantings with the new wood chips. Then we stood back and admired our work.

While we were taking pictures, professional photographer Will Mallett of Mallett Photography happened to stop at Al's Deli for lunch and was gracious enough to come over and take a few professional photos of the group. Then AJ from Al's offered lunch for all of us. Madison,

from Statile Nurseries in Springfield, leaf mulch from the Westfield Conservation Center (Thank you, Westfield), and wood chips from Fanwood (Thank you, Fanwood). After digging all 17 holes, the Garwood Fire Department (thank you!)

Caitlyn, and Chelsea courteously and efficiently took our orders and served us the best sandwiches. As you can tell from all of these thank yous, this project was truly a group effort of many people and thanks are extended to all.

This new planting replaced the rose bushes and forsythia that had been there for years. The Green Team had weeded these planting areas for a number of years, and the bushes had been taken over by invasive oriental bittersweet and were in much need of replacement. This new planting is mostly evergreen and native material, with one shade tree, a formal framing of the memorial plaque, and lower-growing plants to provide better visibility for drivers. We hope that it is seen by all as an improvement to the Borough. Keep your eyes out for more Green Team plantings next year!



### RANKIN STREET TRIANGLE GETS BEAUTIFIED

### Garwood Green Team

Saturday, October 15 was a busy day for the Garwood Green Team as the group, with other community volunteers, completed a second planting – this one at the 'Rankin Street Triangle' formed where Rankin and Locust avenues and Oak Street come together. This site contains a memorial dedicated to the deceased members of the Garwood Police Reserves, Police Department, and Fire Department and the team believed it was in need of an overhaul.

There was a large oak tree on site, but it suffered from a previous topping, falling limbs, and tip dieback. While depressing, the tree had to be removed. After the tree removal, the Garwood Department of Public Works (thank you to Lenny Navarro and the whole staff) used a backhoe to dig out the oak tree roots and provide planting holes. Then team members Andrea Castro, Rich Faustino, and the entire Blumenstock family of Andy, Jen, Lena and Cece followed the directions of site manager Dori Dec to plant 3 winterberry hollies, 5 Eastern redbud trees and one American Holly. Garwood Fire Department members Alan Tweedle and Joe Pelusio brought the firetruck in to water all of the plants before the team backfilled with leaf mulch (thank you Westfield Conservation Center) and finished the plantings with wood chips supplied by Fanwood (thank you, Fanwood!).

With administrative support from Garwood Business Administrator Kyle Harris, and Kathleen Wierzbinski, Janice Farrell, and Sandy Bruns from Garwood Boro Hall, technical support from Harbor Consultants in Cranford, tremendous supply and distribution coordination from the Garwood Department of Public Works, and plants supplied by Dreyer's farms in Cranford, as well as all of those people mentioned previously, this was truly a community effort and is gratefully acknowledged and appreciated by the Green Team.

The planting design is based on the evergreen, native American Holly becoming a 25-40 specimen planting in the center of the island, with the deciduous and early flowering and purple fall color Redbuds forming a copse of trees surrounding it. The deciduous trees will drop their leaves in the fall, opening it up for the American Holly with its bright red berries taking center stage in the winter months. All of the plants are native to New Jersey. We hope that this landscape grows into a beautiful improvement for the Borough of Garwood.

# BE A HERO CAMPAIGN HELPS TEACH IMPORTANT LESSON


Clark Public Schools


