

Students who have graduated from high school but are still attending school will benefit from a new program design that has started at Westfield's Lamberts Mill Academy. According to Carrie Datillo, Superintendent of Westfield's Union County Educational Services Commission, the courses will provide a basis for transitional skills taking the students to the world of work. "Now that our students benefit from extended time in school, we are able to address the toolkit that will better prepare them for success in work and other necessary independence supports" she said.

Once fully engaged, the students will participate in morning classes and afternoon job placements. Resume building, job searching, personal budgeting, workplace attitudes, communication, attitudes for work, and organizational skills are among the many topics that will be reviewed in morning classes. These will be supplemented by jobsite visits, special

presentations, role play simulations and interviews with already working teens and their supervisors. The students have already begun to operate LMA's school store, like a local corner store, where students choose items based upon their success in school. After conducting an inventory the student compiled a shopping list and visited a local supermarket to purchase the needed items. They also provide administrative tasks, assembled fans that were placed in the classrooms, and a recycling initiative.

Sponsored by the Union County Educational Services Commission, Lamberts Mill Academy supports students aged 13-22 who would not find success in a typical school. The program blends academic rigor with comprehensive clinical and psychiatric services and social and daily living skills all tuned to the needs and skills of each student. LINDEN HIGH GRADUATE INDUCTED INTO PROFESSIONAL WOMEN'S BOWLING HALL OF FAME

Carolyn Dorin-Ballard, a 1982 graduate of Linden High School, was inducted into the Professional Women's Bowling Hall of Fame in Chicago on May 17, 2022. She was actually notified of her pending induction for the Class of

2020, but due to Covid issues, the induction ceremonies were held up for two years. This was "the dream of a lifetime" coming true for this athlete. When her Linden High School World History teacher asked her what she planned to do upon graduation, Carolyn replied "I want to be the best female bowler in the country."


Carolyn went on to attend West Texas State University in Canyon, TX, majoring in communications and marketing, both of which would help in her career years later. She was a three-time Collegiate All American, while leading WT5U to two national championships. Upon graduation from WTSU, she pursued a professional career in the bowling world. As a professional, Carolyn has 20 titles, was named "Bowler of the Decade" (2000's) by Bowler's Journal International, was named "Player of the Year" by the PWBA, is a member of the Linden Athletic Association Hall of Fame, Union County Bowling Hall of Fame, Texas State Bowling Hall of Fame and inducted into the United States Bowling Congress Hall of Fame in 2008.

In 2001, Carolyn had won seven major titles and made the most TV appearances that year than any other pro bowler. In the meantime, that history teacher had retired and joined a bowling league. She met Carolyn's mother, Maryann

Dorin, a member of the Linden Board of Education at the time, at a teacher's retirement dinner and remarked "I saw this large poster of Carolyn as the Player of the Year at the bowling center where I bowl; please tell her that she wasn't meant for past history but preferred to make history and that I am very proud of her."

Carolyn is married to Del Ballard Jr., also a professional bowler who is a member of both the PBA and the USBC Hall of Fame. For the last ten years, the Ballards have run a fundraising event for cancer research and development in Ft. Worth, TX where they reside. The proceeds are split between Baylor Hospital and Cancer Care. They were awarded the American Institute of Billiards and Bowling Service Award in Cancun, Mexico in May for their dedication to the bowling industry with their pro shop businesses and bowling clinics that they conduct throughout the country, and their off-the-lanes support to cancer research with their Ballard vs the Big C non-profit organization that has raised more than \$700,000 to date.

The Ballards have one daughter, Alyssa, who is currently attending Vanderbilt University in Tennessee and is part of the school's bowling team. She is also a member of the Jr. Team USA Bowling team, and so the beat goes on.

HANUKAH: A HOLIDAY OF LIGHTS AND MIRACLES

Hanukah is a 'major' Jewish holiday. You might be surprised by that. Most rabbis and Jewish educators would say just the opposite, that Hanukah is a 'minor' Jewish holiday. From the perspective of religious Jewish law, Hanukah does not have the same religious significance of Rosh Hashanah (the Jewish New Year), Yom Kippur (our Day of Atonement and forgiveness), Passover (our Festival of Freedom), Shavuot (the holiday where we celebrate the revelation of the Five Books of Moses), and Sukkot (our Fall festival celebrating the end of the summer harvest and our relationship with God).

Hanukah is a 'major' Jewish holiday culturally and ethnically. One of the ways we can understand any religion is not just what the religion 'teaches' but what its followers actually observe and practice. More Jews observe Hanukah than any other ritual, other than participating in a Passover Seder. Part of Hanukah's 'popularity' is that it falls in the Jewish calendar between Thanksgiving and Christmas.

Hanukah represents a powerful response to the feelings of exclusion and of being a minority in the larger Christian culture of America and allows members of the Jewish community to celebrate its own traditions and be proud of the Jewish heritage even as the airwaves, malls and

TV commercials are filled with the sounds and traditions of Christmas.

But regardless of where Hanukah falls in the calendar, I would suggest the following four reasons why Hanukah is a 'major' Jewish holiday and has lessons for both Jews and our non-Jewish neighbors to learn from share:

1. Hanukah represents the first victory in human history for religious freedom. Had the Jewish Maccabees not won their war with the Greek/Syrian kingdom, Judaism may have died out and Christianity and Islam, both of which have roots in Judaism, may never have developed. The Jewish people celebrate the value for all of us to celebrate our respective religious traditions.
2. Hanukah teaches us religious tolerance and to celebrate diversity and pluralism. As America becomes more diverse and welcomes citizens of many different religions from around the world, we learn from each other and how much we have in common.
3. Hanukah reinforces the ability and opportunity of each minority to teach, learn and celebrate its religious traditions and its principles and unique ethnic and religious identity while we all share and believe in the values of freedom and democracy.
4. Hanukah reminds us of the modern-day miracles that we have participated in: the redemption of over one million Jews from

the former Soviet Union who were not allowed to learn about their Jewish faith and practice Judaism while under Communist rule; the rescue and welcoming of over 100,000 Jews from Ethiopia and the rescue and of endangered Jews and other Jewish communities around the world. We must always be prepared to deliver the few from the many, the weak from the mighty and the righteous from the wicked.

Finally, I would like to share that the word "Hanukah" means 'dedication' and comes from the same Hebrew word as 'education.' Hanukah is about making sure that we maintain our Jewish identity, that we teach our children, the values, the history, the rich heritage which is ours to embrace and pass on to the next generation. May the lights of our Hanukah menorah symbolize our love for Judaism, our right to practice Judaism as a minority while at the same time, sharing symbols of light and the theme of miracles with those who celebrate Christmas even as all of us strive to make the world a better place. For our Jewish tradition has taught us this eternal message: "It is better to light one candle than to curse the darkness."

Happy Hanukah and Happy Holidays to all!

UCEDC AWARDED THE DEI TRAILBLAZER AWARD FOR ACCESS TO CAPITAL

On November 3rd, Union County Economic Development Corp., UCEDC, a non-profit economic development corporation, was honored with the DEI Trailblazer Award for Access to Capital, which recognizes New Jersey companies that are demonstrating tangible and measurable progress in the critical areas of diversity, equity, and inclusion (DE&I), by the African American Chamber of Commerce of New Jersey and the New Jersey Chamber of Commerce.

UCEDC is proud to share that over the last three years, 85 percent of UCEDC's over \$6 Million in lending has gone to either minority-owned businesses or businesses located in low-income census tracts or low-income borrowers. In 2021 UCEDC issued 162 loans, 62% of which were to minority-owned businesses and 42% to women-owned.

UCEDC also started two new programs centered on social justice, including the Virtual Incubator Program, which is focused on diverse businesses from underserved populations, and Entrepreneurship As a Second Chance which enables citizens reentering society to forge an alternate path toward employment free of the typical societal prejudices and obstacles they traditionally face. Both programs include live educational workshops, one-on-one mentorship, and access to capital in the form of forgivable loans.

Harmon Sr., founder, president & CEO of the African American Chamber of Commerce of New Jersey. "The inequities that exist in the marketplace were put in place with intentionality and it will take intentionality to reverse these generational impediments. If we are adamant about making an

impactful difference, then we must advocate for a reimagined corporate culture of inclusivity in New Jersey and across the nation. That is the pathway to our mutual success."

Tom Bracken, president and CEO of the N.J. Chamber, added, "We are recognizing and celebrating the champions who are meeting the challenge and challenging the status quo."

In response to the DEI Trailblazer Award, UCEDC President Adam Farah said, "I want to thank both chambers for this recognition. This is the first award we've received that has recognized UCEDC's diversity efforts. First and foremost I want to thank our staff. They were the driving force behind this. Also, our Diversity Advisory Committee, whose work helped us expand our reach in underserved communities."

Mr. Farrah also thanked UCEDC's Board of Directors, who encouraged him to invest UCEDC capital in diverse communities as a way to effect change. UCEDC's popular Virtual Incubator Program and its Entrepreneurship as a Second Chance program were born from that investment.




