Repair services available at this event will include sewing/textiles, lamps, computers, clocks, woodworking, knife sharpening and bicycles. To allow all patrons to have the opportunity for repair, repairs are limited to 2 total items per person.

Replacement parts for lamps and clocks will be available for an at-cost fee. Please only bring items that you can carry into our event unaided. No appointment is necessary!

SAGE PREPS FOR CHAMPIONS WEEK DURING MARCH FOR MEALS

City officials and members of community organizations are invited to join SAGE Eldercare during Community Champions Week (March 20-24) as it participates in the 20th annual March for Meals – a month-long, nationwide coming together of local community organizations, businesses, government officials and caring individuals to ensure that homebound and vulnerable older adults are not forgotten.

Past participants have included Summit Mayor, Nora Radest, Police Chiefs from Summit, New Providence, Berkeley Heights, Springfield and Mountainside and local government officials and volunteers.

Established in 1966, SAGE's Meals on Wheels is the oldest continuously run home delivery meal program in New Jersey. In 2022, approximately 100 volunteers delivered more than 28,875 meals to 250 people in Union County (Berkeley Heights, Mountainside, New Providence, Springfield, and Summit), Essex County (Millburn and Short Hills), and Morris County (Chatham and Madison). The average age of the clients SAGE delivers meals to is 83. Of those, 65% say they rarely have visitors other than their 'Meals on Wheels' volunteer.

"The services that we provide older adults in our area are critical; it's not just a warm meal, but also a friendly visit, sometimes the only human contact a person gets the whole day," said Terry Kaniuk, Volunteer Manager for Meals on Wheels. "Together, we can keep older adults living independently, healthier at home and feeling more connected to their community as they age."

Being an all volunteer organization, it is no small task to keep the rigs staffed, training ongoing, budget in order, and quality assurance continually assessed — yet each of these tasks are fulfilled on a daily basis. I have long admired first responders with the BHVRs being no exception. I never realized the amount of effort, planning and organization necessary to maintain such a vital town entity.

WHAT ADVICE DO YOU HAVE FOR OTHER PEOPLE WHO ARE THINKING OF JOINING?

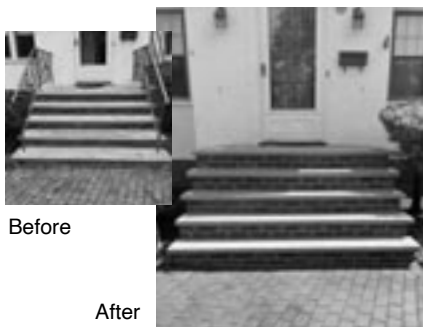

MARC BAILEY ATTAINS EAGLE SCOUT RANK

Boy Scout Troop 177

Marc Bailey of Mountainside Boy Scout Troop 177 achieved the rank of Eagle Scout on September 13, 2022. His Eagle Scout Court of Honor ceremony was held in January. Marc is the son of Vance and Martha Bailey.

Marc has been a scout for 10 years, including his time as a Cub Scout in pack 177. During his years in scouting, Marc has earned 31 merit badges. He served actively in leadership positions as the Quartermaster and Assistant Senior Patrol Leader for the troop. He also was active in community service at the rescue center and the Thanksgiving food drives.

For his eagle scout project, Marc added musical instruments and some obstacles to the Community Presbyterian Church's playground

to give the daycare students more activities to play on and engage their minds. During the project, Marc recruited, worked with, and managed a team of volunteers, with a total of 75 man hours. Marc also raised over \$2,500 to complete the project.

Eagle Scout is the highest achievement or rank attainable in the Scouts BSA program of the Boy Scouts of America. Since its inception in 1911, only four percent of Scouts have earned this rank after a lengthy review process. The Eagle Scout rank has been earned by over 2.5 million youth.

CONTINENTAL MATH LEAGUE A GREAT SUCCESS

Berkeley Heights Public Schools

At Hughes and Mountain Park Schools, a new club is being offered to students in grades 3-5: the Continental Math League. Over 120 students are participating between the two schools. Students meet twice a month at each school and

participate in different activities/challenges that activate their problem solving and critical thinking skills. For example, at a meeting in the fall, the students created different logic puzzles using pictures to represent numbers. In another example, the students were challenged to create a tower using only construction paper. There are also 'competition' days where students compete with other schools around the nation virtually.

The program is led by Math Specialist Joseph Reel who splits his time between Thomas P. Hughes and Mountain Park Schools. He told us, "I am so thrilled with the turnout and the feedback that we have gotten from the Continental Math League. Aside from the problem solving/critical thinking skills that the students are being exposed to, I think the biggest benefit of the program has been the opportunity to teach perseverance when faced with a difficult word problem. I look forward to continuing this club each year!"

Mr. Reel has been with the BHPS for 13 years. Prior to his current role as Math Interventionist at Hughes and Mountain Park Schools he was a special education teacher at William Woodruff School.
