



ROSELLE PARK YOUTH BASEBALL LEAGUE RECEIVES AED

Roselle Park PBA, Local 27 recently held a 50-50 raffle to raise money for an automated external defibrillator (AED) for the Roselle Park Youth Baseball League. The AED is a medical device designed to analyze the heart rhythm and deliver an electric shock to victims of ventricular fibrillation to restore the heart rhythm to normal. Ventricular fibrillation is the uncoordinated heart rhythm most often responsible for sudden cardiac arrest.

NOW ACCEPTING SHADE TREE REQUESTS

The Borough of Roselle Park has announced the roll-out of a program to spur shade tree planting throughout the community. In an effort to bolster its leaf canopy, and revitalize its stock of shade trees, the Borough has set aside over \$50,000 for tree planting. The Borough continues to work with the County of Union, New Jersey to acquire grants which offset local forestry costs.

The Borough has developed an online form (link: https://forms.gle/F7kbq85SHKkB5DFD9) which is designed to provide local residents with an easy way to request the planting of a shade tree within the public right-of-way in front of, or adjacent to their home.

On Tuesday, March 21st from 7:00–8:30 p.m., Imagine will offer a webinar on Supporting Children Coping with Loss for anyone who wants to learn how to support a child who is grieving. While loss due to death will be the primary focus of this webinar, the concepts that will be presented are applicable to all types of loss. It is important for parents especially grandparents, guardians, teachers, members of community organizations, coaches, therapists, counselors, and social workers to attend this program. The webinar will be offered in both English and Spanish.

- 1. Define the terms "loss," "grief," and "mourning"
- 2. Understand the different types of loss and the impact of those losses
- 3. Identify similarities and differences on how children, teens, and adults experience their grief

FREE COURSE ON MENTAL ILLNESS


The NAMI Family-to-Family Education Course will be offered by the Union County Chapter of NAMI (National Alliance on Mental Illness). The course will start on Thursday evening, March 9, 2023 and meet each Thursday over a consecutive 9-week period. It is free-of-charge, with all necessary materials furnished.

The course is offered specifically to the parents, siblings, spouses, teen-age and adult children, and significant others of individuals with severe and persistent mental illness. The program is not appropriate for individuals who, themselves, suffer from one of the major mental disorders. This course is taught by NAMI members who have completed intensive training.

Curriculum topics include: schizophrenia, bipolar disorder (manic depression), clinical depression, panic disorder, obsessive-compulsive disorder, etc., the clinical treatment of these illnesses, and how caregivers can learn to cope more effectively. Attendees will learn about new research, medications, skills needed to successfully communicate with a relative, and how to deal with critical periods.

ORGAN DONATION IN NJ REACHED NEW ALL-TIME HIGH IN 2022

NJ Sharing Network

Carolyn M. Welsh, President and CEO of NJ Sharing Network, the federally-designated nonprofit organization responsible for the recovery of donated organs and tissue in the state, announced the number of organ donors (283) and organs transplanted in a single year (670) reached all-time highs in 2022.

These unprecedented totals mark significant increases over the previous records of 233 organ donors and 613 organs transplanted. This also marked the fourth consecutive year NJ Sharing Network has reported new records in the number of organ donors, underscoring the clear trend of increased support for organ donation in the Garden State.

"Thanks to the generosity of New Jersey organ donors and their families, more lives were saved last year than ever before - ensuring

others now have more time to share special moments with their loved ones," said Welsh.

In 2022, the 670 organs transplanted included 350 kidneys (all-time high), 170 livers (all-time high), 71 hearts, 58 lungs, 20 pancreata and one intestine. In addition, 40,000 eye and tissue gifts enhanced the quality of life for those in need. Tissue donations include corneas, heart valves, skin grafts, bone grafts, saphenous veins, ligaments, and tendons.

According to United Network for Organ Sharing (UNOS), nearly 4,000 people in New Jersey are on the organ transplant waiting list. One organ donor can save eight lives, and one tissue donor can enhance the lives of over 75 people.
