# **NEW JERSEY VETERANS NETWORK MEMORIAL DAY MESSAGE**

A few years ago, I was approached by a friend and veteran of mine who expressed how extremely depressed he was and that he wanted to take his own life. Initially, I was completely shocked because this guy seemed to be upbeat and happy all the time. Immediately, I asked him to come with me to a private office so we could talk about his awful situation. This was the first time in my life that I had a friend talk to me about suicide, and I knew I had to really do my best to help him get through this horrible ordeal. We spoke for a few hours and I listened closely to everything he said. I was able to convince him to immediately get some help and we went to the hospital. I stayed with him at the hospital and met with him when he was released. I did everything to show my friend that I had his back, and because of this he is alive today. This awful situation inspired me to do whatever I possibly can to help others in need, and shortly after the New Jersey Veteran's Network created our mobile outreach program.

In today's day and age, most of you have known a veteran or first responder who has taken their own life. We lose nearly 22 veterans and approximately 300 first responders every year to suicide. Even with all the awareness and new anti-suicide programs available, this number has not changed, and in some cases has increased.

The VA hospitals with PTSD and mental health programs are packed with patients and unfortunately, the numbers continue to increase. More of our first responders are also seeking help and are utilizing some of the state pro-grams being offered. So many people want to help and put an end to this crisis, but sadly there isn't a foolproof program available that will stop this ever-growing crisis from destroying our uniformed heroes and their family's lives.

For the last two years, our team has been working tirelessly with other charities to come up with a better solution to help prevent this epidemic from continuing. Personally, we believe our Mobile Outreach Team is really making a

difference and everyday it helps our uniformed heroes live a better way of life.

The first thing we learned as a team is that we must lose our ego and seek out other groups and organizations that are looking to save lives. Then we find the right volunteers who are committed and dedicated to being a men-tor to a person in crisis. Volunteers are ex- tremely valuable because they want to be there, and they usually care more than the people who get paid for their services.

To date, we have been able to change and save countless lives because of the in- credible commitment from the volunteers and other supporting groups. In the next few months we are excited to be launching the "Uniformed Heroes Project," which is a statewide peer support/mentorship program for veterans, first responders, and active duty military. This project is a collaboration between the NJ VFW, NJ American Legion, NJ FMBA, PFANJ, NJSPBA, NJ FOP, NJ MAVA, NJ legistrators, other military/first responder organizations. The Uniformed Heroes Project will provide peer support training throughout the state for volunteers and host numerous recreational therapy events for our heroes in need.

## **PROTECT YOURSELF - KNOW THE SCAMS**

Sometimes impostors contact PSE&G customers demanding immediate payment and threatening service shut off. Don't be a victim...be prepared.

#### **PHONE SCAMS**

Residential and small business customers have reported receiving phone calls from individuals claiming to be PSE&G employees. Payment is demanded within hours using a pre-paid debit card. Things to know:

- PSE&G offers a variety of payment options and would never require a specific type of payment.
- Customers scheduled for disconnection due to nonpayment receive written notice on their bill at least 15 days in advance.
- PSE&G will never ask for personal information over the phone unless you initiated the contact.
- If you ever doubt the legitimacy of a call from PSE&G, especially if payment is demanded, hang up and call us directly.

#### **EMAIL SCAMS**

PSE&G customers have reported receiving convincing-looking emails that are actually fraudulent. Emails sent by PSE&G would never:

• Threaten to close your account if you do not

take immediate action

- Ask customers to provide personal information online without first logging into My Account
- Should you receive a suspicious email DO NOT reply, click any links, or download any attachments.
- If you're unsure of the legitimacy of the email, feel free to call PSE&G Customer Service.

#### **IMPOSTORS AT YOUR DOOR**

If anyone comes to your door looking like, or claiming to be, a PSE&G employee, ask for ID. All PSE&G employees must carry ID and present it when requested. If you are not convinced, do not let the person in your house. Call us at 1-800-436-PSEG (7734). A Customer Service Representative will gladly verify if a technician has been dispatched to your location.

#### THINGS TO KNOW:

- If the person at your door gives you a different phone number to verify his/her presence, do not call it. Only call 1-800-436-PSEG (7734).
- PSE&G will never send employees to your home or small business offering cash refunds on deposits or utility charges. We will only either credit your account or mail a check to your service address.



## ARRIVE TOGETHER PROGRAM PROVIDES COMPASSIONATE 911 RESPONSE

Union County Prosecutor's Office

The Union County Prosecutor's Office is pleased to announce that New Jersey's highly regarded ARRIVE Together program, aimed at providing compassionate response during 9-1-1 calls involving a mental health crisis, has been expanded to additional police departments in Union County.

The focus of the ARRIVE Together program is to provide individuals in crisis with whatever help they need as quickly and effectively as possible, by teaming up a police officer specifically trained in crisis intervention — with a civilian certified mental health screener in order to respond to 9-1-1 calls relating to a mental health crisis. The officer and crisis worker literally arrive together. Both are in plain clothes, and arrive at the call in an unmarked police vehicle. During the encounter, the mental health screener takes the lead.

This focused approach both supports the individual facing a mental health crisis, and protects the responding officers. The intention is to get the person in crisis the proper help they need as quickly as possible, while also preventing escalation and facilitating any necessary deescalation.

The ARRIVE Together team also follows-up on these specific calls to ensure that the individual is doing well and does not need additional mental health support.

"Heart is a core value of the program, as this program humanely gets to the heart of many of the difficulties of responding to calls involving a mental health crisis for both law enforcement and those in crisis" said Union County Prosecutor William A. Daniel.

"This partnership approach enables a quicker response time to get the individual the help they need, rather than having to wait for the later arrival of a mental health screener," Director of the Pre-Indictment Division Tiffany Wilson, who is also the UCPO Liaison for the ARRIVE Together Program, states. "It also helps to avoid having this person come in contact with the criminal justice system."

The Prosecutor said that, since its inception, it is extremely promising that there have been no injuries or escalations associated with any Union County ARRIVE Together calls, specifically because nationally, half of the "Use of Force" reports arise from police responding to these types of calls.

Elizabeth and Linden Police Departments were quick to pilot the program in June of 2022, following its creation and the Office of the Attorney General's pilot launch in November

partnership between the Cumberland County Prosecutor's Office and the New Jersey State Police, who provide local police services in that part of the state.

Elizabeth Police Chief Sacca is optimistic about the benefits of the ARRIVE Together program. "Since the inception of ARRIVE together program in Elizabeth, in addition to the lack of force and injuries, the department has had great successes in aiding those experiencing homelessness. This success is not only a benefit for the individuals impacted, but a benefit for the relationship between the police department and the community as a whole."

The Roselle Park Police Department launched this program in December of 2022, followed by the current launch by the police departments in Clark, Cranford, Plainfield, Scotch Plains, and

2021 in Cumberland County involving a Westfield, along with the Union County Police Department and the Union County Sheriff's Office.

> "Union County has led the way for the past two decades in sensitizing our law enforcement officers to the struggles of individuals dealing with the wide spectrum of mental illness," Prosecutor Daniel said. "We continue to offer law enforcement sensitivity training, including our intensive Crisis Intervention Team Training (CIT) and Autism Spectrum Awareness training, and de-escalation training, such as Integrated Communications, Assessment, and Tactics (ICAT)," he said.

> "We are committed to partnering with the County community to tackle these tough issues, and to engage in honest dialogue with our citizens, with our eye on equality and social justice for all," he added.

#### Inroads to Opportunities

Michele Ford, President & CEO, Inroads To Opportunities, was recently interviewed on 106.7 Lite FM, "Get Connected," with Host Nina Del Rio. Inroads to Opportunities is a Union County, NJ based non-profit human services agency, that provides programs and services to individuals with disabilities.

Ford covered what drew her to advocacy, her experiences and vast responsibilities at Inroads. Ford is dedicated to the success of each participant and noted that Inroads is one of the most diverse workplaces to be employed.

During National Autism Awareness Month, Inroads expands their already robust outreach to increase awareness for individuals with autism who are seeking employment. Ford mentions 45% of Inroads participants that transition from their school to work program are on the autism spectrum, but yet in the employment world 85%

of people with autism and other disabilities are unemployed. This is a huge statistic and obstacle that Inroads seeks to turn around.

According to Ford, "Our participants bring such an enrichment to our setting...we really need employers to open their doors just for practice, just to let someone come in and try." Exposure is necessary for these prospective employees to have a better understanding of their work environment and the expectations of their potential job.




### **AIMEE PULUSO NAMED PUBLIC HEALTH HERO**





## FREE EYE SCREENING CLINIC - JUNE 22

The Linden Public Library is proud to continue its partnership with the New Jersey state Commission on the Blind and Visually Impaired (CBVI) to offer free vision screenings at the library to local residents. The next clinic will be held on Thursday, June 22nd at 9:30 a.m. While there is no charge to patients for this clinic, advance registration is required.

Project B.E.S.T. (Better Eye-health Services and Treatment) is a state-run and funded program. It is administered by the CBVI and specifically designed for New Jersey residents who are uninsured or under-insured to receive eye screenings and who have not received a recent eye examination. Professional opticians and ophthalmologists will provide these screenings. They are able to write prescriptions for eyeglasses; to check for different vision health issues; and to give referrals for eye specialists, if needed. New Jersey residents aged four years and above are eligible for this free program. The Linden Public Library is the first public library in the state to host these clinics.

Because of the limited availability of doctors, advanced registration is required for this program. Walk-ins will not be permitted. Once the maximum number of patients is reached, a waiting list will be started. 




