THE SPOTTED LANTERNFLY IS HATCHING

Invasive Insect Is a Danger to Trees, Decorative Plantings, and Agriculture

Residents are reminded to keep an eye out for the invasive spotted lanternfly that has caused damage to residential and agricultural plants and trees throughout the area. Residents are asked to check trees, fences, and other flat surfaces around their homes and neighborhoods for egg masses, as well as grown lanternflies and Stomp Them Out!

The spotted lanternfly is native to China, India, and Vietnam. It was first sighted in the United States in Pennsylvania, and has since spread to surrounding states, including New Jersey. The spotted lanternfly was first discovered in Somerset County in 2019. While not harmful to humans or animals, this invasive insect feeds on the sap of many different hardwood trees, scrubs, ornamental plants, and has the potential to impact agricultural crops of economic importance such as grape vines, hops, and apple orchards. Feeding damage caused by the spotted lanternfly significantly stresses the affected plants which can lead to decreased health and potential crop loss.

Residents and visitors are advised to keep an eye out for spotted lanternflies and their egg masses and kill them on sight. Destroying spotted lanternfly egg masses before they hatch is the best way to limit their spread. Eggs can be laid on any flat hard surface including metal, wood, and plastic. Egg masses are commonly found on

Residents are reminded to keep an eye out for e invasive spotted lanternfly that has caused mage to residential and agricultural plants and ees throughout the area. Residents are asked to make the underside of tree branches. Egg laying begins in September and continues through November or until the first freeze.

While adult spotted lanternflies do not survive the cold winters, their egg masses do. Beginning in May through June, the eggs will start to hatch and mature through their life stages into adulthood. Join the battle to beat the bug and help us Stomp Them Out!

IF YOU FIND SPOTTED LANTERNFLY EGG MASSES:

- Scrape egg masses using scraper cards, or anything else that is hard, tapered and/or flat
- Kill eggs by putting them into doubled bags, using alcohol/hand sanitizer, or by smashing

ARRIVE TOGETHER PROGRAM

Union County Prosecutor's Office

The Union County Prosecutor's Office is pleased to announce that New Jersey's highly regarded ARRIVE Together program, aimed at providing compassionate response during 9-1-1 calls involving a mental health crisis, has been expanded to additional police departments in Union County.

The focus of the ARRIVE Together program is to provide individuals in crisis with whatever help they need as quickly and effectively as possible, by teaming up a police officer – specifically trained in crisis intervention — with a civilian certified mental health screener in order to respond to 9-1-1 calls relating to a mental health crisis. The officer and crisis worker literally arrive together. Both are in plain clothes, and arrive at the call in an unmarked police vehicle. During the encounter, the mental health screener takes the lead.

This focused approach both supports the individual facing a mental health crisis, and protects the responding officers. The intention is to get the person in crisis the proper help they need as quickly as possible, while also preventing escalation and facilitating any necessary deescalation.

The ARRIVE Together team also follows-up on these specific calls to ensure that the individual is doing well and does not need additional mental health support.

"Heart is a core value of the program, as this program humanely gets to the heart of many of the difficulties of responding to calls involving a mental health crisis for both law enforcement and those in crisis" said Union County Prosecutor William A. Daniel.

"This partnership approach enables a quicker response time to get the individual the help they need, rather than having to wait for the later arrival of a mental health screener," Director of the Pre-Indictment Division Tiffany Wilson, who is also the UCPO Liaison for the ARRIVE Together Program, states. "It also helps to avoid having this person come in contact with the criminal justice system."

The Prosecutor said that, since its inception, it is extremely promising that there have been no injuries or escalations associated with any Union County ARRIVE Together calls, specifically because nationally, half of the "Use of Force" reports arise from police responding to these types of calls.

Elizabeth and Linden Police Departments were quick to pilot the program in June of 2022, following its creation and the Office of the Attorney General's pilot launch in November 2021 in Cumberland County involving a partnership between the Cumberland County Prosecutor's Office and the New Jersey State Police, who provide local police services in that part of the state.

Elizabeth Police Chief Sacca is optimistic about the benefits of the ARRIVE Together program. "Since the inception of ARRIVE together program in Elizabeth, in addition to the lack of force and injuries, the department has had great successes in aiding those experiencing homelessness. This success is not only a benefit for the individuals impacted, but a benefit for the relationship between the police department and the community as a whole."

The Roselle Park Police Department launched this program in December of 2022, followed by the current launch by the police departments in Clark, Cranford, Plainfield, Scotch Plains, and Westfield, along with the Union County Police Department and the Union County Sheriff's Office.

"Union County has led the way for the past two decades in sensitizing our law enforcement officers to the struggles of individuals dealing with the wide spectrum of mental illness,' Prosecutor Daniel said. "We continue to offer law enforcement sensitivity training, including our intensive Crisis Intervention Team Training (CIT) and Autism Spectrum Awareness training, and de-escalation training, such as Integrated Communications, Assessment, and Tactics (ICAT)," he said.

"We are committed to partnering with the County community to tackle these tough issues, and to engage in honest dialogue with our citizens, with our eye on equality and social justice for all," he added.
