## SGT. OSHANDA ERB MEMORIAL PARADE GRAND MARSHALL

### *Borough of Fanwood*

Mayor Colleen Mahr welcomed citizens, veterans, first responders and other dignitaries to Fanwood's official observance of Memorial Day held this year at the historic train station on North Avenue.

Bright sun shone on the gathering of about 150 people who came to remember those lost in war and pay tribute to those serving today.

The keynote speaker was Air Force First Sgt. Oshanda Erb of Fanwood, the Grand Marshall of the Memorial Day parade. Her speech paid tribute to service men and women, living and deceased, whose sacrifices have made freedom possible for Americans. Sgt. Erb is active in local veteran affairs and is a frequent volunteer at American Legion Post 209 in Scotch Plains.

Among those present were about a dozen active duty or retired servicemen including Joe Schott of Fanwood, a World War II veteran, who celebrated his 101st birthday this year.

Memorial wreaths were laid in a grassy area opposite the train station by VFW Post 10122, American Legion Post 209, the Fanwood Police Department, Fanwood Fire Department and Fanwood Rescue Squad, all of whom were represented in numbers.

Immaculate Heart of Mary Church

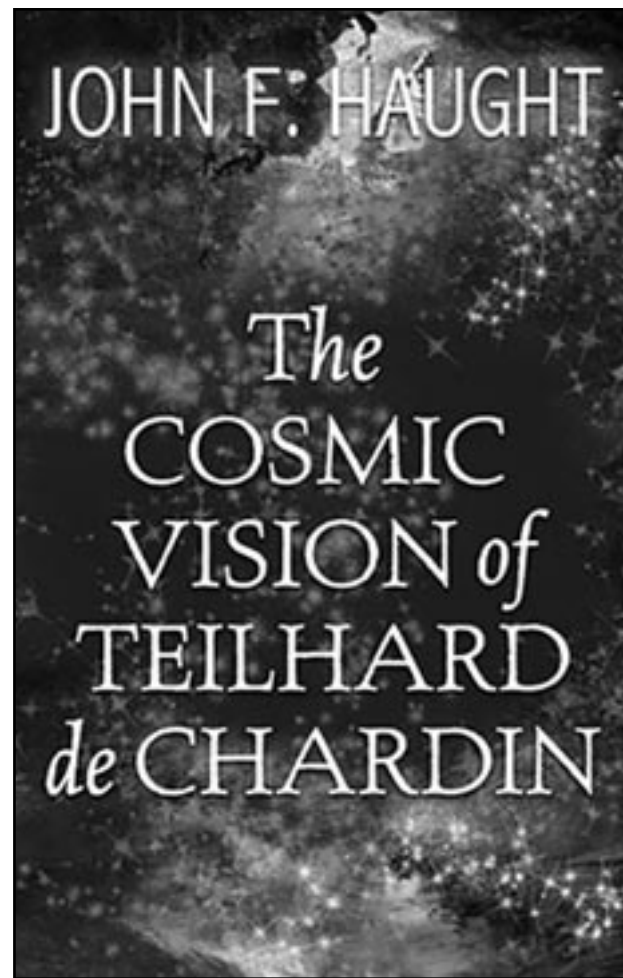

# \$24,000 IN STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED

The Fanwood-Scotch Plains Service League awarded a total of \$24,000 in student scholarships to nine deserving high school seniors at the Scotch Plains-Fanwood High School Scholarship Awards Night on May 31, 2023.

Students were selected for the scholarship awards based on a combination of their academic records and service to the community. Recipients and the schools they will be attending in the fall are Minahal Azhar (Rutgers University); Weston Fischer (Gettysburg College); Alisa Lamastra (Seton Hall University); Stephanie Muenzen (Rutgers University); Jessica Navarro (Yale University); Natasha Vega (Case Western University); Isabella Calamusa (University of Miami); Jordana Reisberg (University of Wisconsin); and Olivia Stahley (Scranton University).

The scholarships were part of a total \$60,000 in contributions by the Service League to Union County community organizations in 2023. That brings the Service League's giving to more than \$1.5 million during the 50 years that it has been in existence. Proceeds come from operation of the Thrift Shop at 1741 East Second Street - a staple in downtown Scotch Plains offering good quality, reasonably priced merchandise to customers. All goods sold at the store come strictly from very generous donors who provide the shop with new or gently used items that they

no longer need or want, giving these goods a second chance at a useful life.

Congratulations to all of the scholarship winners and to everyone in the community who donates and/or purchases merchandise at the Thrift Shop, thus allowing the Service League to serve its mission to "Help Us Help Others."

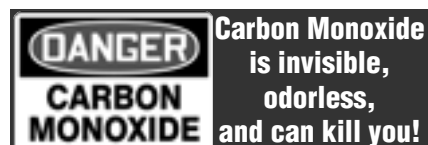

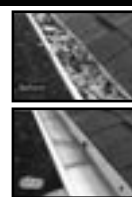

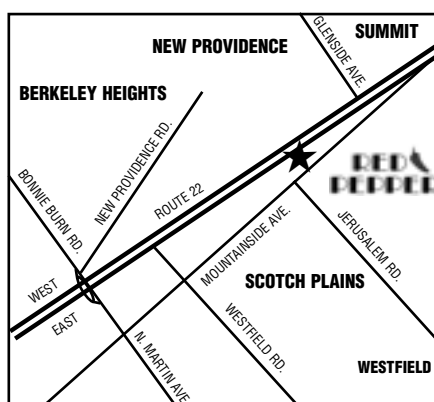

## MESSAGE TO ENTIRE FANWOOD COMMUNITY:

The Fanwood Police Department has seen an increase in cases involving criminal mischief, vandalism, and property damage at the Fanwood Nature Center, LaGrande Park, and Forest Road Park. Most of these incidents occur shortly after schools get out. The money that it takes to fix these damages comes from the tax dollars of Fanwood residents and should be spent elsewhere to better our community.

I want to make this next statement very clear. Our public spaces are for everyone to enjoy. By breaking a building window, adding graffiti to a wall, destroying a public bathroom, etc, you are making these cherished parts of town unusable. Our Public Works Department has done a fantastic job at fixing these damages, but the time and money that it takes is extensive.

This Department has zero-tolerance for these crimes, and anyone found to be participating in vandalism and property damage will be held fully accountable, both criminally and financially. We strongly urge parents to speak with their children about the possible repercussions of engaging in this behavior. We also urge anyone noticing criminal behavior happening at any location in the Borough to contact the Fanwood Police Department immediately. Police will be performing increased checks of all Borough-owned properties, and additional surveillance measures are being put into effect immediately.

I wish this letter wasn't necessary, but the goal is to ensure that Borough property remains a friendly and safe environment for everyone.

Meanwhile, the first steel was erected at the site of the new Fanwood Memorial Library currently under construction at North Avenue and Tillotson Road. The new, two-story library building is expected to be finished by the spring of 2024. Good weather and efficient work by the trade crafts have seen good progress at the construction site.

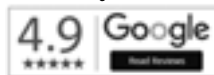
