When was the last time you walked into a library and saw a room filled with fiber artists spinning roving into yarn? Well... if you visit the Kenilworth Public Library the last Tuesday of each month that's exactly what you will see.

Fiber enthusiasts gathered from around New Jersey to take part in the library's newest program "Spin A Yarn". Participants brought spinning wheels, roving, spindles and enjoyed time crafting wool into yarn.

There aren't many places to go to gather as a group to enjoy this hobby, so staff at the Kenilworth Public Library decided to try to bring people together. The inaugural session was held in June and was a big success.

The most important part of this group is the gathering of a community of crafters who enjoy the same unique hobby, to share their knowledge about the craft's techniques, and even the business end of it, with one another.

There are larger plans in store for this group. The future will hold a "fiber-tasting" session, where participants can learn about different types spinning fibers. We hope to offer hands-on technique workshops as well.

This program is free for adults. All are welcome. No registration is required. You don't need any experience to join us, we are happy to help show you how to spin fiber into yarn.

We meet the last Tuesday of each month, from 5 - 7:45 p.m.

The Kenilworth Public Library is a proud recipient of a Level-Up Your Library Grant in the amount of \$5,000. This generous mini-grant, supported by funds from LibraryLink NJ will allow us to continue and expand our “Paper Pals” paper crafting program.

Our program started off small, featuring card making projects that were created by coloring with pencils and markers. Now our program has grown to include the use of various die-cutting machines, stamps and dies. We plan to use these

funds to replace worn out equipment, dies and accessories; and increase the amount of machines, dies and tools available so we can offer an even greater hands-on experience.

This grant will help us expand our program to incorporate additional techniques into our program. Thanks to this generous mini-grant, beginning in July we will expand this program to include additional evening programming dates for our “Paper Pals” program. In addition to our regular projects, we will be creating cards and tags for residents currently living in assisted living facilities. This is a beautiful tie-in with the Library’s summer reading theme of “All Together Now.”

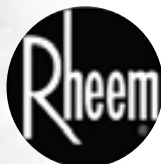

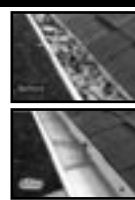

Kenilworth resident Seaman Recruit Andy Morales, David Brearley Class of 2020 is currently serving in the U.S. Navy. Growing up Andy attended Roselle Park High School before attending David Brearley High School after moving to Kenilworth with his family in 2018. Throughout his high school career, he played varsity at both schools. After graduation he attended Kean University where he continued to play soccer. In addition to attending Kean, he worked as a waiter at Caetano's Cucina alongside his family.

When asked why he enlisted he said, "I joined the Navy as an opportunity to start my life. It wasn't an easy choice. I knew what I was going to go through, but I wanted to prove to myself that I could be something. It's an honor to serve the country and I am proud to be a sailor. WHAT WHERE AND WHEN IN OLD KENILWORTH

The ponds that disappeared, Part 2

Of four ponds once in Kenilworth only Shallcross Pond off the end N. 14th St. in Black Brood Park remains. The three that vanished are Station Pond, Hiller's Pond, and Jackson Pond. Last month Part 1 of this 3-part series featured Station Pond. Part 2 features Hiller's Pond.

Hiller's Pond generally was bordered on the south by Washington Ave. and ran north to nearly Monroe Ave. It basically was situated between N. 21st St. to N. 22nd streets. It was catty-corner to today's Opacity Funeral Home parking lot. The pond had its share of beautiful water lilies and was a popular winter ice skating location.

The pond acquired its name from an early settler and builder, John Hiller, Jr. He and his family came from Honesdale, PA to Kenilworth when Kenilworth was part of New Orange. He was an early postmaster, councilman, school board president, and mayor. In 1969 his son, Fred Hiller, explained that the family arrived at New Orange in 1897 and first lived in an old, abandoned farmhouse. His father soon erected a store with living quarters above for his family on the southwest corner of Washington Ave. and N. 21st. With Hiller's Store in immediate proximity to the pond, locals dubbed the basin Hiller's Pond. Granddaughter Lee Hiller Kapner expressed in 2023 that the store was sold in the 1920s or 1930s and that the building was demolished in 1968. The site is now a funeral home parking lot.

The pond was significantly large enough to present an impediment to travel in the early days of Kenilworth. Upsala College was at the top of N. 21st St. well north of the pond. Upsala faculty and students heading up N. 21st St. from the Boulevard could go no farther than Washington Ave. They had to circumvent the pond by going over to N. 20 St., then up to Monroe Ave. and once there travel east to pick up N. 21st St. Travelers heading north to Kenilworth's Downtown or on to Springfield in their wagons or on horseback similarly got no farther than Washington Ave. They had to head west to pick up Cross St. to reach destinations.

Charles Vitale noted (1957) that among the

causes for the disappearance of Hiller's Pond was that the clay layer beneath the pond was broken in the 1920s due to dynamiting need to allow construction of sanitary sewers. The demise of Hiller's Pond was slow as its water seeped away transforming the pond to a swampy area. Old editions of the Cranford Chronicle report residents using the swamp to dump trash and garbage. According to Eugene Coppola (1920-2020) when the Kramer-Ring Building was erected in 1927 on the Boulevard at N. 21st St, dirt excavated to create the cellar was hauled by horse-drawn wagons and deposited into the ever-ebbing Hiller's Pond a block away. The Kramer-Ring building now houses Ava's Restaurant.

As late as the early 1950s what remained of the pond area was a small muddy area, although N. 21st St. between Washington and Monroe avenues had been cut thru and some homes were built on part of the site of the old pond. In the 1950s a small portion of St. Theresa's School was built just east of N. 22nd St on old pond land. In the 1960s two-family homes began to be erected on the north side of Washington Ave. between N. 21st and N. 22nd streets where the pond once stood.

Two ponds gone; one more to go. Watch for Part 3 about Jackson Pond next month.

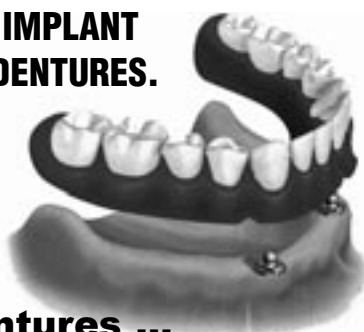

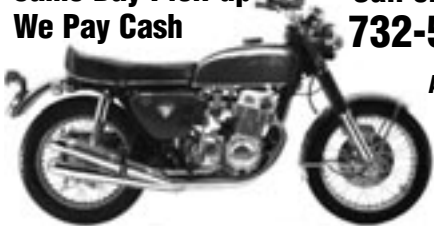
