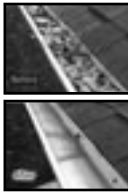

Kenilworth resident Seaman Recruit Andy Morales, David Brearley Class of 2020 is currently serving in the U.S. Navy. Growing up Andy attended Roselle Park High School before attending David Brearley High School after moving to Kenilworth with his family in 2018. Throughout his high school career, he played varsity at both schools. After graduation he attended Kean University where he continued to play soccer. In addition to attending Kean, he worked as a waiter at Caetano's Cucina alongside his family.

When asked why he enlisted he said,

"I joined the Navy as an opportunity to start my life. It wasn't an easy choice. I knew what I was going to go through, but I wanted to prove to myself that I could be something. 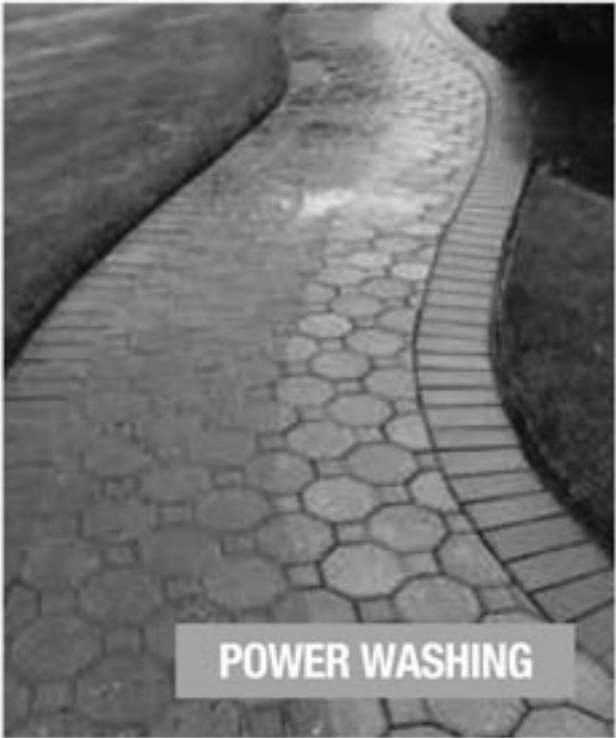

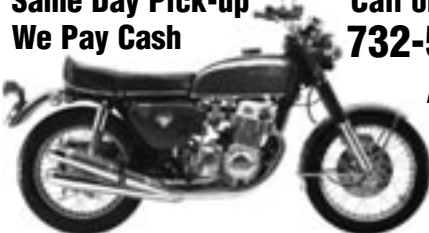

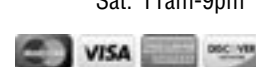
