NICK DEPHILLIPS AND HIS SERVICE DOG, CUBBY

When Nick Dephillips, a resident of Florham Park, NJ, entered Kessler Rehabilitation Center for the first time, he was expecting to see a team of staff dedicated to his care. What he didn't expect to see was Irvin, an energetic, fun-loving facility dog working with patients in their sessions. After learning that Irvin was from Canine Companions, an organization that provides highly trained service dogs to veterans and individuals with disabilities, Nick decided to apply for a dog of his own.

Nick sustained an injury five years ago that affected his mobility and various aspects of his life. "Getting around can be difficult. It's hard to open doors and certain tasks that involve my hands can be difficult," explained Nick. After completing the application process, Nick had the opportunity to attend Team Training, a two-week training experience in which individuals are matched with their service dog and could form a bond with their new partner.

This is when Nick met Cubby, a 2-year-old Labrador and Golden Retriever mix. "It was exciting to get Cubby. He was the perfect size." mentioned Nick. Nick and Cubby were a perfect match even before they met, as Nick loves sports and Cubby was named after the Chicago Cubs.

As a Canine Companions service dog, Cubby learned over 40 commands, including how to pick up objects, open and close doors, and turn lights on and off. These skills have been incredibly helpful as Nick and Cubby have started attending college classes together. "He opens doors for me and picks up my pencils and books." explained Nick. "He is really intuitive. If I drop my phone under the table, he'll think 'How can I get it if this chairs in the way?' ... Anything you teach him he can pick it up pretty quick. I taught him to get his leash for the car and that took only half a day to teach."

Since becoming a team in February, Nick and Cubby have experienced so much together already. "I recently just took him to the US Open. We go to a lot of sporting events and he helps me a lot. I've taken him golfing with me and that's really helpful when he picks up the club or the ball." stated Nick. As any sports fan knows, those who work hard, play hard, and Cubby loves to play. "He will randomly bring me toys, it doesn't matter the time of day, he always wants to play." explained Nick. Cubby also loves to go for joy rides in Nick's truck, where they head to the beach. Together, Nick and Cubby can make any curveball a home run.

Since receiving Cubby from Canine Companions, Nick's life has changed tremendously. Not only is he an exceptional service dog, he is also a wonderful companion as well. "I've had him for 7 months, but it feels like years," said Nick. "He's very loving, and I know he loves me."




HALLOWEEN DOG PARADE – RAIN DATE NOV. 4



AAUW MADISON AREA BRANCH TO HOST "HOW DID I GET HERE?" PROGRAM - NOV 6

On Monday, November 6, 2023, at 7 p.m. nonprofit AAUW (American Association of University Women) Madison Area Branch will host a program entitled, "How Did I Get Here?" The speaker is AAUW Madison Area Branch President, Ann Huber from Madison. The event will be held at Florham Park Library, Akhoury Meeting Room, 107 Ridgedale Avenue, Florham Park. The program is free and open to the public and advance reservations are not needed.

Ann will discuss her memoir, Lost and Found, Surviving Displacement, Finding Love, Uncovering Secrets. She will talk about her journey from one country to another, learning new languages and adapting to different cultures, while struggling to figure out where she fits in. The book can be purchased online and copies are available thru the MAIN Library system. Reading the book is suggested but not required to attend and enjoy the program.

Born in war-torn Romania shortly after WWII, the author fled to Israel along with her family, and then they abruptly moved to Canada. She moved to the US at 19, another uprooting in her young life. When she meets the love of her life at a young age, she learns that his family's history of displacement and survival during the Holocaust parallels her own. As she matures, has children, and her ambitions grow, the author finds an inner strength. Even a shocking family secret learned late in life that might have shattered another person's worldview, only strengthens her resolve to remain true to herself. Her extraordinary life of dealing with losses and secrets, and finding love, is the subject of this moving memoir.

Ann & her husband are residents of Madison, having moved here 18 years ago after raising 3 daughters and 5 dogs in Randolph Township. Ann is a retired Deputy Attorney General, following her trial work of Termination of Parental Rights trials and appeals. She is a graduate of Rutgers University (New Brunswick) and Rutgers Law School (Newark). Never happy to sit still, she has always been

involved in volunteer work and politics, starting with the Red Cross and Leaders' Corps in High School, Pres. of Morristown Jewish Center Sisterhood, Pres. Randolph Chamber of Commerce and member of Rotary, then held elected office as Councilwoman and Mayor in Randolph. Ann has been president of the AAUW Madison Area Branch since June 2022. She thinks she fits in here pretty well.



RENEE REILLY CELEBRATES ANNIVERSARY OF LIFE SAVING TRANSPLANT

Renee Reilly, a resident of Madison, NJ, is celebrating an incredible milestone as she marks the 10-year anniversary of her life-saving liver transplant. Renee, 52, has not only cherished every moment of her life since her successful transplant but is also passionate about advocating for NJ Sharing Network, the nonprofit organization responsible for the recovery and placement of donated organs and tissue for transplant in the Garden State. She actively shares her story with others to encourage more people to register as organ and tissue donors.

"I continue to feel overwhelmed, humble, and grateful," said Renee. "Giving someone a second chance as an organ and tissue donor is such a special and amazing gift of love."

Renee's journey began when she was 16 years old and was diagnosed with Polycystic Kidney Disease (PKD). Her father, who also battled PKD, had received a life-saving kidney transplant that gave him an additional 35 years of life. Renee later developed Polycystic Liver Disease (PLD) after giving birth to her two boys. She was added to the liver transplant list in 2009.

"Waiting for the liver transplant phone call, I felt hopeless at times, tired, anxious, and I didn't think I would ever get 'the call,'" said Renee.

The pivotal moment in Renee's journey arrived unexpectedly on a day filled with emotional turmoil. Her father had been in the hospital for weeks due to complications from a previous surgery. Renee had just visited him when she received 'The Call' from the transplant center.

"I began to cry because I was filled with

emotions, from joy and excitement to worry about my family and guilt about receiving such a precious gift. But my husband, John, and my sons, Ian and Brendan, served as a source of strength and kept me focused because they were excited to know that I was going to get a liver transplant," said Renee.

On August 6, 2013, Renee's liver transplant surgery was a success, giving her a new lease on life. In 2017, Renee's kidneys started to fail. Fortunately, she received a kidney transplant in 2018, sparing her from the hardships of dialysis treatments.

The transformation in Renee's life posttransplants has been remarkable. She now enjoys all of her favorite hobbies, including gardening, knitting/crocheting, sewing, and spending time with her family.

"Thanks to my organ donors and the miracle of transplantation, I have been there for unforgettable moments like my boys' graduations. I am now able to give hugs again without any pain due to my enlarged liver," said Renee. "Now, I am focused on sharing my story to give hope for those waiting for the gift of life and inspire everyone to register as organ and tissue donors."

According to United Network for Organ Sharing (UNOS), there are over 100,000 Americans – nearly 4,000 of whom live in New Jersey – waiting for a life-saving transplant. One organ and tissue donor can save eight lives and enhance the lives of over 75 others.
