Bridges Outreach

Bridges Outreach hosted its 5th Annual Bridges Streets-to-Homes 5K Walk & Run in Summit, NJ on Saturday, September 30th. Despite the rain, over 100 participants crossed the finish line. Other events of the day included a Kids Fun Run, a rejuvenating Burn & Flow class led by The Goodburn, and stations to meet event sponsors and pack lunches for distribution during Bridges' streets-based case management. Thanks to event sponsorships as well as individual and team fundraising efforts, the event raised over \$36,000 to end chronic homelessness in Union and Essex Counties - NJ.

"The Bridges 5K was such a wonderful event! I want to thank all of our sponsors for their generous support – we couldn't do it without you!" reflected Jessica Mills – Bridges Board Member and Fundraising Chair.

Bridges Outreach is at the forefront of tackling chronic homelessness. Founded in 1988 by Geoff and Ginger Worden of Summit NJ, Bridges provides resources and case management to those experiencing homelessness and facing imminent homelessness. Project Connect, launched in 2014, connects people experiencing homelessness in Newark with trained case managers to ultimately achieve permanent housing. "This past year, Bridges has helped to create a 27.7% reduction in unsheltered homelessness, in New Jersey. Bridges is about meeting people where they are, literally and figuratively. We believe that housing is a human right." Shares Richard Uniacke, President of Bridges

Outreach.

HONORING THOSE CURRENTLY SERVING: LANCE CORPORAL JACK T. BALWIERCZAK

Kenilworth resident Lance Corporal Jack T. Balwierczak, David Brearley Class of 2021 is currently serving in Company, 2nd Battalion, 8th Marine Regiment, U.S. Marine Corps. Growing up Jack attended Harding Elementary School and David Brearley Middle / High School. While attending David Brearley he played defensive line and full back for the football team. Three of the four

years he played were on the varsity team. In addition to this he threw javelin, and jumped hurdles for track varsity his junior and senior year.

Jack enlisted in the U.S. Marine in February 2021. When asked why he stated, "I wanted to join the Marine Corps my entire life. Another thing that inspired me to join was Marine Lance Corporal William Wold who stated in an interview that while engaging with insurgents in Fallujha that, 'I'd rather kill them in their backyard then have them come to our backyard.' That quote reminded me people want what our

families work hard to have. I love my family and friends and be damned if someone wasn't there to protect them.

Another thing that inspired me to join was pictures of marines taking care of the locals they were surrounded by in foreign countries. People forget just as much as we are trained to kill the enemy, we are trained to protect the women and children we come across. The final reason I joined was to meet people from all walks of life. In my platoon I have brothers from the northern states, the southern states, Nigeria, Brazil, Portugal, Italy, Albania, Puerto Rico, Mexico, and a few other countries. They grew up in good neighborhoods and bad neighborhoods. It doesn't matter where you are from, a marine is a marine no matter where you come from.

I left for boot camp in October, 2021, a few months after graduating. I attended boot camp at Parris Island, South Carolina for three months. There we weren't allowed to have a phone until our graduation. My only contact home was by letter the entire time I was there. Upon graduation I went to infantry school for a four-month course. There we learned how to survive and defend ourselves against the enemies we have today. We learned how to survive in the water, make shelters in the woods, become experts on our weapon systems such as rifles, machine guns, rocket launchers, mortars and so much more. Upon completion I was sent to Camp LeJeune, North Carolina with the 2nd Battalion, 8th Marines."

So far Jack has been stationed on the border of the U.S. and Mexico where he conducted training operations in the deserts of New Mexico for a month. From there he received Arctic Training in the mountains of California where they learned how to survive constant negative degree temperatures for two months. From there he was sent to the desert once again where he received additional training.

Currently, Balwierczak is a fire team leader/assistant patrol leader and occasionally fills in as squad leader. After his discharge from the U.S. Marine Corps, he hopes to become a firefighter or police officer following in the footsteps of his father Joe Balwierczak who is a member of the Kenilworth Police Department. In closing he commented,

"We (Marines) share stories and make memories together only we will tell each other about. We workout together, go on field operations together, freeze together, sweat together, go to church together, and when we have our off time, we go to the bar together. It is like we have known each other our entire lives. After a while it seems like we only understand each other and only get each other. The family I have made in the Marines is something I will miss when it is time to put down my rifle and hang up my body armor."

WHAT, WHERE, AND WHEN IN OLD KENILWORTH

MILITARY COUPLES WHO SERVED OUR NATION, PART 1

To honor all veterans, VFW Post Commander of Lee and Undyne C. Wentz. From 1944 to 1946 Robert E. Jeans, Sr. has invited the public to attend Veterans Day ceremonies at the VFW Center, S. 21st St., 11:00 a.m., November 11. If inclement weather the program will be held indoors. Complimentary refreshments will be served after the ceremony.

To recognize some of the many Kenilworth veterans who have served during times of war and peace this special two-part series is presented about unique combinations of relatives who served. This two-part series features husband and wife or brother and sister combinations who served at the same time. All were honorably discharged. If you know of others, please contact this author. Residences indicated are still standing.

KORECKY AND STALLINGS (wife/husband): Karen Korecky, one of four children of Edward and Lorraine Korecky, grew up at 424 Lee Ter. Karen's father served in the Army in WWII and participated in the Battle of the Bulge. Frank's father was a 22-year Army veteran who served two tours in Vietnam. Karen is a 1969 graduate of David Brearley Regional H.S. She entered the military in 1975 and concluded service in 1977.

In 1974 while visiting friends at Ft. Monmouth, Karen met Pvt. Frank Stallings, one of three children of Eugene and Lottie Stallings of TX. In March 1975 they were married in a military ceremony at St. Theresa's Church. Later that same month she entered basic training in Alabama while Frank was completing Advanced Microwave Radio Training in NJ. Once completed, they were assigned to Korea. Karen left Korea after serving11 months to give birth to their first child, Michael. They later were assigned to Ft. Hood, TX, adjacent to Frank's hometown, Kileen. Their second child, Edward, was born in 1981. Frank served until 1978.

Frank and Lorraine, Vietnam Era veterans, attained the ranks of sergeant. They returned

to her hometown of Kenilworth and joined VFW Post 2230. In the 1980s they operated Big Bertha's Banana Boat Ice Cream Shop in town. Here over 35 years, they live on the Boulevard.

THE LOHMANS (husband/wife): Herman C. Lohman was one of four children of Christian and Helen Lohmann. The family moved to Kenilworth from Elizabeth in the 1920s, first living on Union Ave. in a home his parents physically built, and later lived at 239 N. 21st St. His brother, Charles, was a longtime Kenilworth police lieutenant. Under age 18 and working at a gas station in 1939, Herman needed his father's permission to join the Marines, which his father granted. Herman's long military career ended in 1969 with the rank master sergeant. He served in the Pacific Theater during WWII and later in Korea. During WWII he was seriously wounded at the Battle of Guadalcanal necessitating months in the hospital. After military service he was employed as a Kenilworth post office letter carrier until 1983.

In 1945 Herman married Undyne Vernice Wentz, born in CA. She was one of three children she served in the Women Accepted for Volunteer Services, aka the WAVES, of the US Naval reserves, finishing as seaman first class. She was forced to resign when she became married, which greatly troubled her. In 1970 Herman married again. It was to Della Zavitsky of 54 S. 21st St., also a local letter carrier.

At the time of his death in 1994 at age 72, Herman lived in the family home on N. 21st which he then owned. He is buried in Graceland Memorial Park, Kenilworth. Undyne died in 2002 at age 77 and is buried in the National Memorial Cemetery in Phoenix, AZ. She and Herman had a daughter, Yvette (Lass).
