Bridges Outreach hosted its 5th Annual Bridges Streets-to-Homes 5K Walk & Run in Summit, NJ on Saturday, September 30th. Despite the rain, over 100 participants crossed the finish line. Other events of the day included a Kids Fun Run, a rejuvenating Burn & Flow class led by The Goodburn, and stations to meet event sponsors and pack lunches for distribution during Bridges' streets-based case management. Thanks to event sponsorships as well as individual and team fundraising efforts, the event raised over \$36,000 to end chronic homelessness in Union and Essex Counties - NJ.

"The Bridges 5K was such a wonderful event! I want to thank all of our sponsors for their generous support – we couldn't do it without you!" reflected Jessica Mills – Bridges Board Member and Fundraising Chair.

Bridges Outreach is at the forefront of tackling chronic homelessness. Founded in 1988 by Geoff and Ginger Worden of Summit NJ, Bridges provides resources and case management to those experiencing homelessness and facing imminent homelessness. Project Connect, launched in 2014, connects people experiencing homelessness in Newark with trained case managers to ultimately achieve permanent housing. "This past year, Bridges has helped to create a 27.7% reduction in unsheltered homelessness, in New Jersey. Bridges is about meeting people where they are, literally and figuratively. We believe that housing is a human right." Shares Richard Uniacke, President of Bridges Outreach.



Greg has been a 32-year resident of the airport, having based all four of his personal aircraft there since 1991. He has a commercial license and an instrument rating. He will discuss how each of his successive aircraft has moved up in performance and capability, and he will cover the physical characteristics of Morristown Airport and how they have changed over the years, as well as how the types of operations at the airport and traffic have evolved.

November 21st, Jeffrey Gitterman, CEO,

Gittermen Asset Management. Jeffrey will discuss how the physical changes in climate from 1850 through 2020, a period of 170 years, have consistently occurred, and how the current warming of the planet has affected our lives. 



# **ALL ROADS LEAD TO ROME FOR MIDDLE SCHOOLERS!**

The Millburn Middle school boys had a pretty historical season participating in various competitions held by the International Academic Competitions (IAC). International Academic Competitions is a buzzer-based competition program founded by 19-day Jeopardy champion David Madden in 2010, as a place for students to compete in single subject disciplines such as history, geography, and science. International Academic Competitions offer regional, national, and international competitions for students K-12 with our National History Bee and Bowl, National Geography Bee, National Science Bee, US History Bee, and the US Geography Championships. IAC is a network of over a dozen separate academic competitions. IAC's staff administers and oversees competitions in over 50 countries, committed to the growth and development of academic teams both in the USA and abroad.

The Millburn Middle school boys, Aaditya Reddy, Alex Choong, Ben Qin, Raghav Sampath and Shaayan Tiwari, performed tremendously without any formal coaching. They were truly hardworking, motivated, self-driven, and did it all on their own. Kudos to their hard work!

It all started with the students participating in the International Academic Competitions' Northern New Jersey History Bee and Bowl competition in November 2022. They were declared History Bowl champions at the competition. Due to their superlative performance, they simultaneously qualified for the New Jersey State competition and the National History Bowl & Bee in Virginia in June. Despite being eighth graders, they also took part in the JV competitions. At the Regional JV competition, they were pitted against 9 and 10 graders and performed commendably to reach the semi-finals. At the JV Nationals, they reached the quarterfinals!

Separately, middle schoolers Aaditya Reddy, Ben Qin, Raghav Sampath and Shaayan Tiwari competed individually winning various medals and qualifying for the individual events at the Nationals and the International History Olympiad in Rome. Aaditya Reddy and Shaayan Tiwari also qualified for the International Environmental Science Olympiad, however it was cancelled and will be rescheduled to another year.

At the Middle School National Competition, they won several plaques. Raghav Sampath won 3 plaques for International Geography bee, US History bee and National History bee. Aaditya Reddy and Shayaan Tiwari made Millburn proud



by winning plaques for the History Bee.

In July Aaditya Reddy, Ben Qin, Raghav Sampath and Shaayan Tiwari packed their bags for Rome! To quote the IAC "The 5th International History Olympiad took place in Rome, Italy from July 23-30 with 258 students in attendance, representing 30 US states, 20 other countries, and 4 territories. St. Stephen's School was the host site for most of the competitions, though several finals were held in historic venues throughout the area, including inside the Colosseum (Roman History Bee), at St. Peter's Square (Catholic History Bee), and in the Circus Maximus (Sports History Bee and Running Combined). Students had a chance to sightsee around Rome, including visits to the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, St. Peter's Basilica the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel, Ostia Antica, the UN Food and Agriculture Organization Headquarters, the Baths of Caracalla."

The Millburn boys had a fantastic experience. Raghav Sampath was a finalist in the Sports Bee and Recent History Bee. He describes the

experience of competing at the Circus Maximus as surreal. Aaditya loved the opportunity to compete against and interact with people from other countries and cultures. Benjamin Qin placed 6th in the Running Combined competition at the Circus Maximus, and placed joint-third in the Running Combined initial test. He loved the chance to go to historical locations and compete with other exceptionally talented students from around the world. Shaayan's favourite part of the IAC experience was the trips - "... from Washington D.C. to Rome, Italy, I enjoyed every moment and understood the location's history and geography. Overall, the memories and information gathered travelling for the competitions were the best part of the experience.

At the Closing Ceremonies of the Olympiad, it was announced that the 2025 Olympiad will likely take place in Vienna, Austria. Students will be able to qualify during either the 2023-24 or 2024-25 academic years.

The speaker is AAUW Madison Area Branch President, Ann Huber from Madison. The event will be held at Florham Park Library, Akhoury Meeting Room, 107 Ridgedale Avenue, Florham Park. Ann will discuss her memoir, Lost and Found, Surviving Displacement, Finding Love, Uncovering Secrets. She will talk about her journey from one country to another, learning new languages and adapting to different cultures, while struggling to figure out where she fits in. The book can be purchased online and copies are available thru the MAIN Library system. Reading the book is suggested but not required to attend and enjoy the program.

Born in war-torn Romania shortly after WWII, the author fled to Israel along with her family, and then they abruptly moved to Canada. She moved to the US at 19, another uprooting in her young life. When she meets the love of her life at a young age, she learns that his family's history of displacement and survival during the Holocaust parallels her own. As she matures, has STEM, topical monthly programs, and member children, and her ambitions grow, the author finds an inner strength. Even a shocking family secret learned late in life that might have shattered another person's worldview, only strengthens her resolve to remain true to herself. Her extraordinary life of dealing with losses and secrets, and finding love, is the subject of this moving memoir.

Ann & her husband are residents of Madison, having moved here 18 years ago after raising 3 daughters and 5 dogs in Randolph Township. Ann is a retired Deputy Attorney General, following her trial work of Termination of Parental Rights trials and appeals. She is a graduate of Rutgers University (New Brunswick) and Rutgers Law School (Newark).


