COPING WITH LOSS DURING THE HOLIDAYS

There is so much pressure to be happy in our culture, especially at the holidays. We are supposed to have a Happy Thanksgiving, a “merry little Christmas” or a Happy Hanukkah. But grief doesn’t take a holiday.

Imagine, A Center for Coping with Loss would like to offer support to those navigating the challenges of grieving during the holiday season and offer some coping strategies as well. On Thursday December 14th from 6:30-8 pm, Imagine will offer a workshop on Coping with Loss During the Holidays. The free workshop will be held at their center at 244 Sheffield Street in Mountainside and is open to adults and children grades 3 and older.

Imagine’s Grief Educator, Connie Palmer, LCSW will present the workshop in English and Training and Education Director, Veronica Ortiz, LPC and Bilingual Program Manager, Sonia Nuñez will present the workshop at the same time in Spanish. Pizza dinner is available prior to the session beginning at 6:15 for those who sign up. Hot cocoa and cookies will be served as well.

If you are looking for support as you cope with a loss this holiday season, the staff at Imagine would like to help, and hope to see you at the workshop on the 14th.

Imagine is a 501c3 nonprofit that offers free year-round grief support groups for children ages 3-18 and young adults 19-30 who are coping with

a loss due to death. Concurrently, support groups are available for the parents and guardians of the children in the groups and offered in English and Spanish. He was a shoe-shine boy, learned English, and attended school. He eventually earned a PhD from Columbia and became Chief Economist at the New York Stock Exchange. He wrote several professional books and later, two children’s stories, including one about a cookie that played a central role in his life. We’ll hear the remarkable life story of one of our most

On December 12th, another distinguished Old Guard member, Mitch Erickson will review the science, biology, and environmental and social uses of water as a parable of the intersection of science, environment, policy, recreation, safety, climate change, and social justice that affects all 8 billion of us. HOME INSTEAD RECEIVES PROCLAMATION FROM GOVERNOR MURPHY

In celebration of Apprenticeship Month, on November 1, HOME INSTEAD hosted a statewide event, celebrating the accomplishments of 60 Certified Home Health Aides, who are now dually certified as Certified Dementia Practitioners. The event was attended by James Manning, CPM, Chief Contact Administrator, NJ Office of Apprenticeship, and Nicole Field, Apprenticeship and Training Representative, US Department of Labor. Mr. Manning presents Chris Capobianco, and Evelyn Baron, MSW, owner of the Essex and Union Counties Home Instead office, with a proclamation form Governor Murphy, proclaiming November as NJ Apprenticeship month. The guest speaker was Barbra London, MSW, LCSW, LNHA, President, Consultants in Geriatrics, LLC. Her program included TABLE TOPICS, Engaging With Your Client.

KNIT A BIT AND MAKE NEW FRIENDS

The Gates Avenue Knitters celebrated their 23-year anniversary in April. The group has been meeting at the Long Hill Township Library, located at 917 Valley Road, Gillette, every Monday from 1p.m. to 3 p.m. Everyone is welcome to join in.

In the month of April in the year 2000, Gates Avenue, Gillette resident Arlene Kaplan, started a knitting group along with 4 friends. Twenty-three years later the group, now called the Gates Avenue Knitters, are still knitting together, including 4 of the 5 original knitters who still live in town.

Eighteen to twenty ladies show up on any given meeting day. Their skills range from beginner to experienced knitters (and crocheters). They help each other get past problems with patterns, and they are excited and willing to teach beginners to knit.

They come from Long Hill Township and surrounding towns, including Warren, Watchung, Bridgewater, Springfield, Chatham, Madison, Summit, and Westfield. Many were introduced to the group thru friends.

Along with their own projects, the group knits for causes. They knit approximately 500 hats per year and distribute them to local charities. Beginning in November they have a display at the library and the hats are sold as a fundraiser thru the end of February for \$10 each. The group recently presented the library with \$1,300 from the proceeds of the last hat sale, which is the most funds ever raised.

The group welcomes donations of yarn and knitting and crocheting supplies.

Donations can be dropped off at the Long Hill Township Library any day during business hours.

LIBRARY DECLARED BOOK SANCTUARY

Millburn Public Library

On Monday, October 16, 2023, the Trustees of the Millburn Public Library unanimously passed a resolution designating the town's public library a "book sanctuary library." In doing so, Millburn joins the ranks of the Westfield Public Library and the city of Hoboken in offering a safe space for reading and uniting against book bans.

The Trustees stand firmly in their resolve that: "Individuals should be trusted to make their own decisions about what they read and believe" and that "people should not be making decisions for other people about what they read."

RESOLUTION 2023-1001

Resolution Against Censorship and Book Bans

WHEREAS, reading is a foundational skill, essential for critical thinking, future learning and exercising democratic freedom; and

WHEREAS, books and other materials are tools for understanding complex issues; and

WHEREAS, libraries provide access to books and other materials that offer lessons to readers of all ages and expand our understanding of people with different backgrounds, ideas, and beliefs; and

WHEREAS, limiting young people's access to books and other materials does not protect them from life's complex and challenging issues; and

WHEREAS, all people, including young people, deserve to see themselves reflected in a library's collection; and

WHEREAS, librarians are professionals trained to not impose their own thoughts and

opinions on which ideas are right, but to make knowledge and ideas available so that people have the freedom to choose what to read; and

WHEREAS, removing and banning books and other materials from public libraries represent a loss of liberty, a step toward government censorship, and the erosion of our state's and our nation's commitment to freedom of expression; and

WHEREAS, book bans, by virtue of their exclusionary nature, limit choices and thereby harm communities; then

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Trustees of the Millburn Free Public Library endorse the following statement:

Individuals should be trusted to make their own decisions about what they read and believe. Further, people should not be making decisions for other people about what they read.

We are united against book bans.

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we as Millburn Library Trustees will act to protect the rights of everyone to access a variety of books and other materials, in libraries, in bookstores, online, and in other venues; and

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Millburn Free Public Library hereby designates the Millburn Free Public Library as a book sanctuary.
