BARRINGER'S GIFT TO THE USA

Barringer High School Alumni Association

Marie D'Amico, long-time resident of Florham Park and retired teacher who taught in Florham Park and Newark, has been serving as Vice President of Newark's Barringer High School Alumni Association for several years. As a founding member of the Association, Marie is proud and excited about the latest event in her high school's history.

Barringer High School, established in 1838 as Newark High School, is celebrating 185 years of continuous education in the city of Newark; Barringer is the first public high school in the city and state. Adding to its illustrious history, the Alumni Association is gifting to the United States of America, specifically the prestigious Library of Congress in Washington, D.C., 29 leather bound journals filled with original handwritten compositions and illustrations by the students during the Civil War period.

The journals were discovered in a locked safe about to be discarded. Marie, along with members of the association, (many of whom contributed to the restoration of the journals) will celebrate this magnificent mission and accomplishment at a brunch to be held at the Hanover Manor, East Hanover, March 10, 2024 - 11:00 a.m. Tickets are \$50 per person. All are welcome to join us and to view the historic journals before they embark on their train journey to Washington D.C. THE STORY OF THE JOURNALS

The journals were found by principal Pat Restaino, who graduated from Barringer in 1945. He discovered a locked safe slated to be destroyed, he had it opened and it was there that he found the 29 journals, handwritten accounts, and artwork of students from the Civil War era. Later, Pat, as president of the Alumni Association, made it his mission to preserve the journals, and most importantly, to have them placed in a public venue, and so began the process of preserving this historic collection. With the help of grants from Essex County and numerous donations from alumni and friends, along with the dedication of principal Pat Restaino, the journals were able to be preserved.




HIDDEN CHILDREN OF WORLD WAR II The Historical Society of Florham Park is

proudly hosting "Hidden Children of World War II". Scheduled for March 12, 7:00 p.m. at the Florham Park Library, it is the first of the four free and intriguing 2024 presentations available free for the public starting next month. The Holocaust is still a critical piece of

history 80 years later. Of the 1,600,000 Jewish children who lived in Europe before World War II, only 100,000 survived the Holocaust. Most were hidden children, shuttered away in attics, cellars, convents or in villages or farms. Survivor Maud Dahme, a New Jersey resident, New Jersey Hall of Fame Class of 2014, and former president of the NJ State Board of Education, was among those who were hidden and survived. Dahme was one of the estimated 3,000 to 8,000 Jewish children in the Netherlands who were hidden and saved from the Nazi death camps by courageous Christians. The Hidden Child, a one-hour high-definition documentary, is Dahme's own story of courage, hope and bravery in the face of evil and death.

Today, Dahme devotes her life to genocide education. Issues such as tolerance, mutual respect and understanding are discussed in depth in the presentation. All ages are welcome and encouraged to attend this important presentation.

The Historical Society of Florham Park was founded by a group of women in 1935 to save and preserve the Little Red Schoolhouse. Located on the corner of Columbia Turnpike and Ridgedale Avenue the former schoolhouse (built in 1866) was converted into a museum. It is the symbol of Florham Park. Virtually all the artifacts in the museum were donated to and are the responsibility of the Historical Society.














LIBRARY MINICOURSES

The Friends of the Madison Public Library are offering two new minicourses for the Spring 2024 Semester to begin on April 1 and 3 for a total of five weeks. The minicourses will cover topics relating to 'Constitutional Controversies' and 'Art in the U.S. from Reconstruction to WWII.' While the Madison Library is undergoing renovations, the classes will be held at the Florham Park Library.

"Constitutional Controversies" will be taught jointly by Dr Bruce Peabody, Professor of Government and Political Science and Dr Madelyn Ferrans, Professor of Political Science and Director of the Pre-law Program, Fairleigh Dickinson University. Classes will be held Monday afternoons on April 1, 8, 15, (skip 22), 29 and May 6. The schedule is as follows:


- Week 1: Dr Peabody: First Hour-Introduction; Dr Ferrans: Second Hour-topic TBA
- Week 2: Dr Ferrans: "Free Speech"
- Week 3: Dr Ferrans: "The establishment clause and free exercise of religion"
- Week 4: Dr Peabody: a) the Supreme Court confirmation process and who gets selected and how the Justices decide cases
- Week 5: Dr. Peabody: "The problem of amending the Constitution (and why it will never happen again), and b) the problem of the Supreme Court, the public, and legitimacy

"Art in the United States from Reconstruction to WWII" by Dr. Kimberly Rhodes, NEH Distinguished Teaching Professor in the Humanities and Professor of Art History, Drew University will be held Wednesday mornings from 10:00 am to 11:50 am on April 3, 10, 17, 24 and May 1.

This course will cover the development of the visual arts in the United States from reconstruction to the 1930s. Topics will include the discussion of exchange between European and American artists, the education of American artists in Europe and the United States, the relationship between political events and visual culture, and the rise of modernism.

The tuition for each course is \$95. No refunds or credits will be issued once the course begins. These minicourses are organized by the all-volunteer Friends of the Madison Public Library, a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization. All proceeds benefit the Madison Public Library.
