

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO ADVOCATE FOR CHILDREN IN FOSTER CARE

Five-year-old Jennifer is diagnosed with autism and almost completely nonverbal. Due to excessive violence in the family home, a concerned neighbor called for help and, after investigation, Jennifer was placed in foster care. The two phrases Jennifer can say graphically depict violence witnessed at home and confirm trauma she's endured. Since entering care and being enrolled in school, it's evident Jennifer has

also experienced educational neglect. At age three, she was entitled to an Individualized Education Plan from the Department of Education to provide such intervention services as in-home speech and behavioral therapies, both helpful for future enrollment in a half-day educational program. Unfortunately, Jennifer's parents neglected to utilize these services and she is now more than two years behind her peers.

Jennifer is just one of the more than 500 children removed from home in Passaic and Union counties each year due to abuse and neglect. These children are separated from all they've ever known: parents, siblings, friends, teachers, and their belongings. For Jennifer, the road ahead is long, and she needs a caring, consistent adult in her corner to protect her best interests while in foster care. That's where Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) volunteers come in.

A CASA volunteer is trained on the ins and outs of advocating for child-victims and fully supported by CASA staff for the duration of the case. No special background in child welfare is necessary; successful CASA volunteers are dedicated community members with varied life experiences who believe abuse and neglect are non-negotiable. CASA volunteers visit the children, make unbiased observations, interview others in the child's life, and make recommendations to the judge. They often are the

only consistent adult in the life of a child involved in the child welfare system, as caseworkers, professionals, and even placements can be ever-changing. A CASA volunteer provides continuity during a time of chaos and unknowns.

There are currently hundreds of Union County children in need of a CASA volunteer! Plans are underway for an advocate training class.

ABOUT CASA OF PASSAIC AND UNION COUNTIES:

The nonprofit is court-empowered to recruit, train and support volunteer advocates to speak up for the best interests of children in foster care. Assigned by a court order that grants access to the child and all those in their lives, the CASA volunteer gathers information and makes informed recommendations to the judge deciding the child's future. Often, the CASA volunteer is the only consistent person in the child's life. 

NJIO SPRING CONCERT – APRIL 21, 2024

New Jersey Intergenerational Orchestra (NJIO) will present its Spring Concert on Sunday, April 21st, 2024 at 3 pm at Crescent Avenue Presbyterian Church in Plainfield. This Concert celebrates NJIO's 30th Anniversary and is free and open to the public. Donations are gratefully accepted. The Concert will be followed by a ticketed Gala at the same location.

Dardis, a native of Laguna Niguel, California, received her Master of Music degree in Vocal Arts from The Juilliard School, where she studied with Darrell Babidge. Ms. Dardis completed her undergraduate degree from The Juilliard School as well. In 2023 Ms. Dardis was named a winner of the New York Regional District in the Metropolitan Opera National Council Auditions.

NJIO Symphony will also play the popular Overture to Die Fledermaus by Johann Strauss II.

NJIO's Intermezzo Orchestra, conducted by Oliver Hagen, will perform music by John Williams, a movement of Brahms' Symphony no. 3, and selections from Tchaikovsky's Sleeping Beauty. The Prelude Ensemble, NJIO's entry-level group, is conducted by Elizabeth
















EMPOWERING LINDEN MULTILINGUAL LEARNERS

Linden Public Schools

In recognizing the pivotal role informed parents play in advocating for their children, the Linden School District Department of Multilingual Learners is dedicated to fostering impactful family engagement initiatives, affirms Director Danie Orelien. Each spring, students from Kindergarten through 12th grade identified as multilingual learners undergo the nationwide English Language Assessment, known as Supervisor Tania Miguelez ACCESS. underscores, "This assessment comprehensively evaluates students' academic English language proficiency across listening, reading, speaking, and writing."

On January 30, 2024, the Department of Multilingual Learners hosted an informative

workshop on ACCESS for parents and guardians purposes: at Linden High School's Learning Commons. Translators Anna Pelesz and Florencia Skorput Lazure were on hand to assist, ensuring inclusivity. Workshop presenters, William Simonitis and Stephanie Ross, expressed satisfaction with the substantial turnout, deeming it a resounding success. Parents posed pertinent questions, such as the timing of the ACCESS test, receipt of scores, the impact on academic progress, and criteria for discontinuing language support.

Multilingual Learners' parents and guardians gained valuable insights into how the district utilizes ACCESS to monitor their child's academic English progress. Beyond this, ACCESS test results serve several essential

- Accountability: Providing a comprehensive view of student proficiency.
- Benchmarks: Establishing standards for educators to gauge future performance.
- Re-classification Decisions: Determining if a student can exit language support services.
- Placement and Instruction: Informing decisions on class placement and instructional planning.

The ACCESS assessment stands as a vital tool in our pursuit of educational excellence." Stated Director Danie Orelien.

The RRWA invites all volunteers to celebrate Earth Day 2024 with a clean-up of the Rahway River. The clean-up will take place on Saturday April 20th in Winfield Park and with the support of Union County Department of Parks and Recreation.

Volunteers will focus on areas upstream and downstream of the dam at Winfield Park. Please come by the parking area adjacent to the Bloodgood Dam at 8:45 to register, pick up bags, gloves, bottled water and snacks, and receive safety information. Teams will be encouraged to travel to any part of the river within the park where they would like to perform cleanup activities. We specifically ask all folks to register and to work in small groups for safety purposes. Everyone under 18 must have their parent's signature on individual waiver forms as well as have an adults supervision to participate.

Cleaning up a river and park area is a great way to celebrate Earth Day and if you haven't participated in an event like this before, you will find it invigorating and rewarding. It is also fun and educational, especially for scouts and young adults, as they always find something interesting. Over the 25 years this cleanup has

occurred thousands of folks have participated and pulled some amazing things from the riverbank, improving water quality and habitat for native animals.

The clean-up will take place between 9 am and 12 noon, but any amount of time or effort that folks can volunteer is appreciated. There is always a large volume of floatable debris to pick up. The team working registration will provide suggestions on areas to focus on

All participants should wear long pants, long-sleeved shirts, gloves and boots, waders are welcome for those who like to get a little wet. Each participant should bring a standard 5-gallon carry bucket with a handle. This makes it easy to carry single use water bottles and other collected debris for transfer to large garbage bags. A mulching rake or grabbers are also a great way to access items from the riverbank. After the event there is an inventory of all the items that are removed, and within approximately 24 hours Union County Parks and Recreation removes and disposes of all the trash.




