VOLUNTEERS AT SENIOR WELLNESS CENTERS HONORED

Somerset County

Fifty volunteers were recently recognized for their dedication, hard work, and service at the Volunteer Recognition Ceremony at the Somerset County Senior Wellness Center at Bridgewater where almost 100 clients are served daily. In total, 140 volunteers were honored for their 780 hours of service during Volunteer Recognition Month in separate ceremonies at the additional five county-operated senior wellness centers.

“Thanks to the many volunteers who have dedicated their time and effort toward the successful operations of the senior wellness centers,” said Commissioner Paul M. Drake, liaison to the Office on Aging & Disability Services. “The senior wellness centers would not be able to function as successfully as they do without your contributions.”

“All of you giving your valuable time must know that you are helping to improve the lives of our clients by connecting them to a community, being a friend, and keeping them active both mentally, physically, and socially, which helps our clients age in place,” he said.

What Volunteers Do at the Senior Wellness Centers

Many volunteers are peers who perform multiple functions, such as packing meals for the Home-Delivered Meals program, helping with lunch service, clerical duties, teaching exercise, and educational programs, providing instruction for arts and crafts, and forming social events. In addition, volunteers helped create a ukulele band, a dance troupe, and a chorus.

VOLUNTEERS GET FULFILLMENT

“Volunteering at the Senior Center is rewarding in many ways,” said Senior Wellness Center at Bridgewater Volunteer Kathleen Kastner. “It gives us the opportunity to meet and socialize with seniors from the community.”

“It’s such a positive experience volunteering,” said Volunteer Rita Davis. “Knowing the senior wellness center provides so many services to the community, like providing meals to the homebound is great. Being a part of something like this is very gratifying.”

HOME-DELIVERED MEALS SERVE THOUSANDS OF HOMEBOUND RESIDENTS

In operation for 49 years, this program would not be possible without the help of the Somerset County Transportation Department and volunteers who help pack the meals.

In 2023, the program delivered 94,630 meals. This year, as of the end of March, approximately 21,391 meals were

delivered. Not only does the program provide thousands of daily meals to the homebound, but the program offers emergency preparedness meals, and is also a way to conduct wellness checks.

Since 1995, residents of CenterBridge II Senior Housing have been volunteering to deliver meals almost 4,000 meals to their peers.

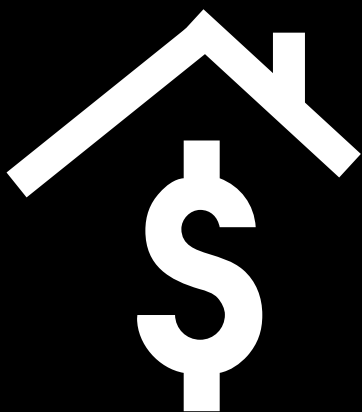

ELKS ASSEMBLE 200 BACKPACKS FOR HOMELESS VETS

Elks members from across NJ recently gathered at the NJ Elks Veterans Annex in Stirling to assemble 200 backpacks which will be distributed to homeless veterans at Stand Down events in Newark, Atlantic City, and other locations throughout the state. These backpacks help to provide comfort to homeless veterans, offering them a sense of support and care during challenging times.

The backpacks contain clothing, food, personal hygiene, and other care items, including many of the 4,000 pairs of socks and undergarments that were collected and donated to the Elks through the Middlesex Borough Police sock drive for New Jersey veterans.

The NJ Elks Veterans Annex also serves as a warehouse for Welcome Home kits consisting of furniture and other household items that a formerly homeless veteran would need when

moving into their new housing. It is featured in the Youtube video "Givers of Hope".

Elks pledge "So long as there are veterans, the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks will never forget them." Every night, as many as 40,000 veterans sleep on the streets. In partnership with the Department of Veterans Affairs, the Elks National Veterans Service

JAYA DAVE RECEIVES GOVERNOR’S AWARD

Jaya Dave, a senior at Watchung Hills Regional High School, was recently awarded the Governor’s Award for Exceptional Artistry & Community Leadership in Dance. She has been dancing since the age of 4 at the Washington Rock Dance (WRD) school in Warren. During her time at WRD, she has trained pre-professionally in ballet and modern dance as well in contemporary, jazz, hip-hop and tap. She also has many years of training in Bollywood and Classical Indian dance. Jaya has furthered her dance technique at the Ailey School Professional Division Summer Intensive as well as the American Dance Festival Pre-Professional Intensive.

Through the years, Jaya has had many prominent roles in the WRD’s Nutcracker Ballet production as well as had opportunities to perform alongside professional in various venues throughout New Jersey and New York City. Most recently, she was invited to dance at a reception at the Governor’s Mansion during a Women’s History Month event.

In addition to advancing her artform through her own training, Jaya has spent many hours over the last 7 years teaching dance as an assistant teacher at WRD, where her passion for dance education and leadership began. Jaya strongly believes that all students should have access to learning various dance forms, regardless of socioeconomic background, and thus led the initiative to reintroduce the dance program into the Watchung Hills Regional High School curriculum. She presented research to the board on the benefits of arts education and attained student signatures to further her cause. Her interest in education and community service has led her to be a co-instructor for the Dance for Parkinson’s program. She has also participated in many local school and community outreach events to promote the Arts.

Next year, she plans to go to college to study dance, while taking courses in business and education. Jaya aspires to dance, choreograph, teach and, maybe one day, own her own dance company and studio.

MONUMENT RECEIVES SOME TLC FROM THE DAR

With America's 250th birthday on the horizon, a member of Elizabeth Snyder-Continental Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) went to new heights to help preserve a local landmark. After receiving approval, Erin Fountain spent an afternoon cleaning the DAR chapter's plaque on the monument at Washington Rock State Park in Green Brook.

"It is important to me to help preserve history for future generations," said Fountain who heads the chapter's historic headstone cleaning project. "It also helps me to connect with my ancestors who served in the Revolutionary War."

George Washington spent more than 40 percent of the war in and around the Watchung Mountains. According to local tradition, the outcrop at Washington Rock was used as an observation point by the Commander in Chief in 1777, while his Army was camped at Middlebrook.

Although it became a popular attraction, the site was threatened by encroaching trap rock quarries in 1909. That prompted the husband of Mary McCutchen, a charter member of Continental Chapter DAR, to purchase 20 acres of land that included Washington Rock and to deed the property to the State of New Jersey.

The DAR then led efforts to construct a monument at the site, a cairn of local stone forming the base of a large flagpole. The plaque placed on the monument reads: "From this rock, General George Washington watched the movements of the British forces during the anxious months of May and June 1777. Erected by The Continental Chapter DAR, and the People of Plainfield and North Plainfield. 1912. Lest We Forget."

"Visitors to the park were asking me about the history of Washington Rock and if it was real," said Fountain. "That is why we need to care for these monuments that tell the story of our past."

The DAR is a service organization that promotes education, historic preservation, and patriotism. Membership is open to women descended from a patriot of the American
