EMS RESPONDED TO 236 EMERGENCIES IN APRIL

Summit's EMS volunteers recognized National Volunteer Month by responding to 236 emergency calls in April.

Calls for the month included 140 medical emergencies; 35 falls; 20 motor vehicle accidents; 16 traumatic injuries; one allergic reaction; 14 cases of overdose or poisoning; three responses to a medical alarm; one pedestrian struck by a vehicle, and one response to fire scene. Squad Volunteers also provided two "lift assists" to patients who did not require transport to a hospital as well as two non-emergency ambulance transports of Summit residents.

Four emergency calls were answered by an off-duty "back-up crew" of volunteers responding from home or work when the on-duty crew was busy. Summit volunteers also provided mutual aid assistance 17 times to 3 neighboring towns. 15 patients transported to a hospital by Squad members also received advanced life support care from hospital-based paramedics who accompanied the Squad's ambulance. During April, Squad volunteers transported 167 patients to five different hospitals.

The Squad also hosted 2 public CPR classes at their building and provided EMS coverage at 2 community events.

The Squad answers calls for help 24 hours a day and at a variety of locations. April responses included 70 to a patient's home or apartment; 23 for accidents or medical emergencies on streets



or highways; six in a public park; four at Summit's City Hall and seven at other public buildings; 14 at a local business; five at a bar or restaurant, and 11 at a health care professional's office. There were also 34 medical incidents at Summit's train station and 5 at bus stops; 10 at a local behavioral health facility; three on the grounds of Overlook Medical Center; 18 to an assisted living facility, two in a house of worship; 15 on a sidewalk; four in a parking lot; two at a school; and one at a golf course.

The all-volunteer First Aid Squad, responds to emergency calls 24/7, is entirely funded through private donations and does not bill for service. The Squad is always looking for new volunteers to join its ranks. All needed training, uniforms and equipment is provided. SUMMIT AREA OLD GUARD – JUNE SPEAKERS

The Summit Area Old Guard is a social, educational, and recreational organization that serves men of retirement age. We meet most Tuesdays at the New Providence Presbyterian Church located at 1307 Springfield Ave. Our dues are minimal, and members manage all aspects of the operation. Our motto is “Come for the Programs. Stay for the Friends.” The organization was founded in 1930.

We will have four programs in June:

On June 4th, Assemblywoman Nancy Munoz will be our speaker. Ms. Munoz, a Republican, represents the 21st legislative district of New Jersey in the General Assembly. She was first elected in 2009. In 2017, she was appointed minority whip, and co-chair of the Republican party in 2020. Since 2022, she has served as Deputy Minority Leader of the Assembly, and

she is also the minority budget director. Representative Munoz will discuss what New Jersey is doing to keep retirees from migrating out of the State.

On June 11th, Robert E. Potok will be our speaker. Dr. Potok received his Doctor of Science from MIT in nuclear engineering. He is also a science fiction author. He will discuss how consciousness ties to overall human life experience. He feels the relationship is expressed in many of the "ship" words: friendship, stewardship, apprenticeship, authorship, brinkmanship, censorship, etc. All these words describe qualities of human experience and are meaningless without consciousness.

On June 18th, our topic will be “How the

Universe Came to be Smooth and Flat: the great challenge for gravity and cosmology”. Our speaker will be Paul J. Steinhardt, the Albert Einstein Professor of Physics at Princeton University. A snippet from his extensive Wikipedia page states, “Steinhardt is best known for his development of new theories of the origin, evolution and future of the universe.”

On June 25th, the monthly program chair, William Tittle, will attempt to bring the previous three speakers’ ideas together by building a theme that will converge their talks covering politics, human consciousness, and the universe in which we live, with the idea of a personal credo on what we each conclude about life – multiple 20th-century philosophers have had a go at this weighty topic – should be interesting.

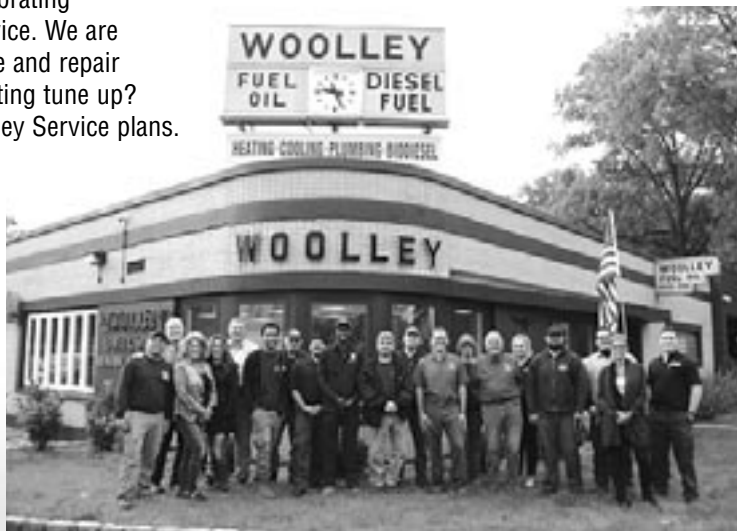

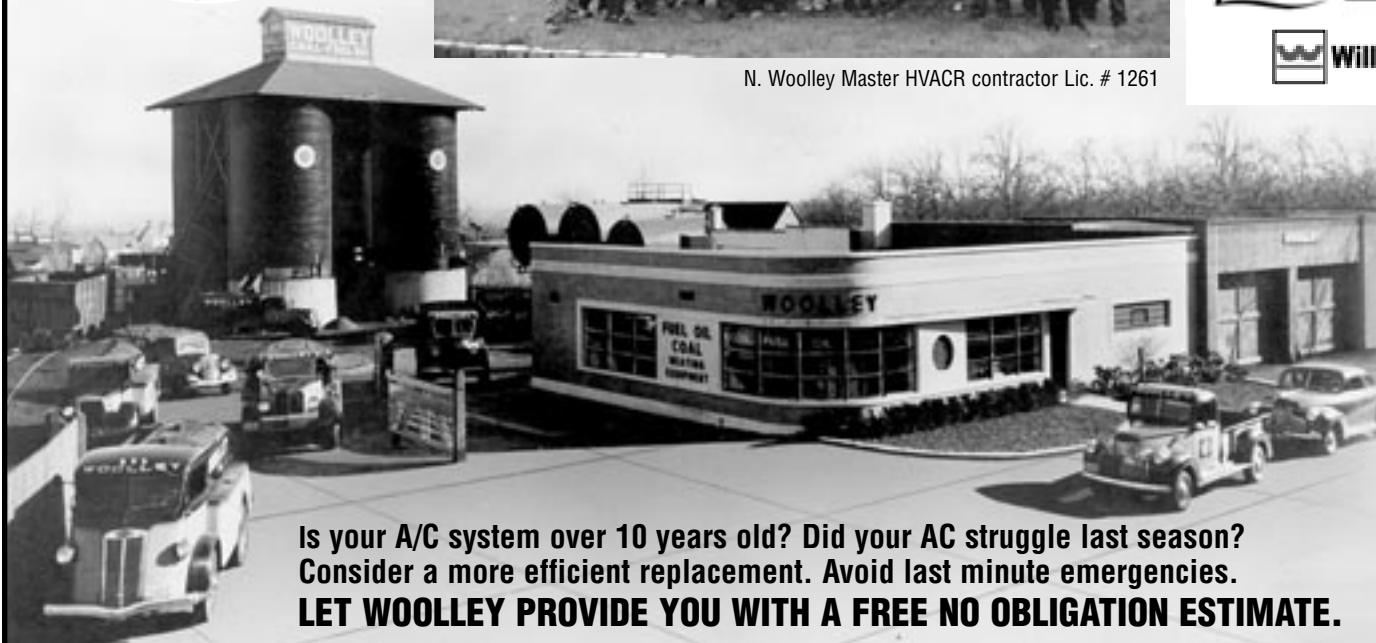

CHILDRENS' SPEECH-LANGUAGE-HEARING

Junior League of Summit

Since its founding by the Junior League of Summit in 1967, it has been the mission of Summit Speech School to empower children with hearing loss to become effective communicators using Listening and Spoken Language. Listening and Spoken Language is an evidenced-based approach to teach children utilizing hearing technologies to speak and listen.

We are reaching out to let the public know that May was National Speech-Language-Hearing Month. As leaders in the field, we thought it would be a great time to share some very important facts about hearing loss with you.

Today, infant hearing loss impacts between one and three of every 1,000 children born in the United States, and 90% of children with hearing loss are born to hearing parents. The universal newborn hearing screening can identify hearing loss in infants soon after birth. For babies identified with hearing loss, early intervention, like the services provided at Summit Speech School, has a beneficial effect. Infants may not speak – but they do listen and learn. With early detection, appropriate hearing technology and education at Listening and Spoken Language schools like Summit Speech School, children who are deaf or hard of hearing can have the same opportunities as their hearing peers.

Summit Speech School serves more than 365 children ages birth through high school in three

educational programs: Early Intervention (birth – 3 years of age), Preschool Program (three – five years of age), Itinerant Mainstream Support Program (preschool – high school in 67 NJ Public Schools). In addition, the school's state-of-the-art Audiology Center staffed with SSS's highly experienced audiologist, is a warm and child-friendly environment conducive to acquiring accurate results for young patients. Summit Speech School provides parent support and educational sessions for families to share experiences and seek the guidance of our highly trained staff.

As part of National Speech-Language-Hearing Month, our staff shares some of the following warning signs to watch for in young children:

Does not smile or interact with others (birth and older); Does not babble (4 - 6 months); Makes only a few sounds or gestures, like reaching (7 - 9 months); Does not understand what others say (10 months – 2 years); Says only a few words (19 months – 2 years); or Does not put words together to make sentences (19 months – 3 years).

If you suspect your child may have hearing loss, we recommend contacting your pediatrician or reach out to us for appropriate referrals for testing. NATIONAL FALLEN FIREFIGHTERS MEMORIAL WEEKEND

Eight members of the Summit Fire Department volunteered at the National Fallen Firefighters Memorial Weekend held May 3 through May 5, 2024, at the National Fire Academy in Emmitsburg, Maryland. The annual event honors the firefighters who died in the line of duty the previous year.

Thousands of fire department members from across the country were in attendance, including the following members of the Summit Fire Department: Fire Chief Eric Evers, Deputy Chief Paul Imbimbo, Battalion Chief Brian Harnois, Lieutenant Chris Esposito, Lieutenant Matthew Lemons, Retired Deputy Chief Rick DeGroot, Retired Battalion Chief Joe Wurtzbacher, and retired Firefighter Matt Klapper.

At home in Summit, the Summit Fire Department participated in two events held nationwide to honor the firefighters that lost their lives in 2023. The bell monument at fire headquarters was lit in red beginning on Wednesday, May 1, through Sunday, May 5, as part of the Light the Night for Fallen Firefighters event. Alongside local places of worship and other locations across the country, members of C Platoon rang the bell at 10 a.m. on Sunday, May 5, as part of the Bells Across America event, to mark the start of the memorial service at the event in Maryland.
