HISTORICAL SOCIETY INVITES ALL TO VISIT MUSEUM

The Roselle Park Museum is located in the borough at 9 W Grant Avenue. The museum is a wonderful place to discover the borough's March 21, 1901, incorporation and its developing history through the years. Visitors are helped by volunteers from the Roselle Park Historical Society. The museum is open on Wednesday 1-5 p.m., and on Saturdays 10 a.m. -2 p.m.

Inside the museum one will find several display cases showing many aspects of the borough's government, services, businesses, transportation, education, school yearbooks, sports and other prominent residents.

Recently, one display case shows the many railroads that were so essential to the borough's early growth and prosperity. We were fortunate to have a young fifth grader, Brendan Munoz, from Sherman School volunteer to create much of what is in the display case.

Brendan's interest began at an early age when he began watching the Thomas And Friends television show. He says he loves the sounds of trains and their different paint schemes, especially the Lehigh Valley Black Diamond.

Brendan came to the museum because of his interest in trains. He constantly picked the brains of the society's volunteers of what we knew about the trains of our borough, and often he educated us with his own vast knowledge.

Brendan enjoyed creating our train display case. He has quite a collection of model trains at home ranging from N scale to O scale.

SEPTEMBER 11TH REMEMBRANCE SERVICE


