

### **GLHS ANNOUNCES AP CAPSTONE STUDENT SUCCESS**

The Berkeley Heights Public School District is proud to announce that following the Spring 2024 exam cycle, 11 Governor Livingston High School students have earned the AP Capstone Diploma<sup>TM</sup>. Additionally, 4 students have earned the AP Seminar and Research Certificate<sup>TM</sup> during the 2023-24 school year. The AP Capstone Diploma program helps students develop critical thinking, research, collaboration, and presentation skills that are essential to academic success. The AP Capstone Diploma program is a project based learning experience valued by colleges and universities across the U.S. and around the world offered at approximately 2,500 schools. In partnership with the higher education community, College Board developed AP Capstone courses to help students build and master skills essential for success in college and career.

"We proudly recognize the achievements of our students who participated in the AP Capstone Diploma program," said Ms. Jackie Bartlett, Interim Principal at GLHS. "With the help of dedicated AP Capstone teachers Ms. Lindsey Gismonde and Ms. Sharon Leahy, our AP Capstone students explored their passions through scholarly research as part of an impactful, multi-year program. This meaningful college readiness program will serve our students well after high school."

To receive the AP Capstone Diploma, students must earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar, AP Research, and on four additional AP® Exams of their choice. To receive the AP Seminar and Research Certificate, students must earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar and AP Research (AP Capstone is a two-year program consisting of AP Seminar and AP Research). Student participation in the AP Capstone program has been steadily increasing, with over 100,000 students in over 2,500 schools worldwide taking part during the 2023-24 academic year.

Unlike traditional AP subject exams with a single end-ofyear assessment, AP Seminar and AP Research assessments are project based and evaluate skills mastery through group projects, presentations, and individual essays completed throughout the year. Instead of focusing on one specific academic discipline, AP Seminar and AP Research are interdisciplinary: Students are encouraged to create research projects based on topics of personal interest. Students are assessed on the critical thinking, research, collaboration, time management, and presentation skills needed to complete their

Ms. Lindsey Gismonde shared, "Like many AP courses,

AP Capstone courses foster critical thinking skills. However, AP Seminar and AP Research are unique in that they allow students to develop strong research and analytical skills while deeply exploring an area of interest through meaningful independent inquiry. It's because of this that alumni of the program tell us that it has prepared them for college and beyond."

According to current AP Capstone student, Senior Victoria Stambaugh, "The AP Capstone program has been the most rewarding academic experience I have had at GL. In AP Seminar I learned so many skills that are going to be important to me in college and beyond that. We learned how to work well in groups, manage our own time, and most importantly, how to enhance our writing and presentation skills. Last year going into AP Seminar, I thought my writing was pretty good, but it has improved so much already. In Seminar I was able to refine my vocabulary and overall communicate my ideas more effectively and analyze data and information a lot better. Now that I am in Research, I am excited to begin using all of the skills I have learned and expand upon them, especially since research is something I am interested in doing in college. I know that AP Capstone is perfect for that and will help prepare me well."

Ms. Laurie Scott, Supervisor of English, Music, FCS, Media Centers, TV Production, & Drama, commented, "It can be argued that no program better prepares students for college research than AP Capstone. The research and writing in which students engage is so beneficial, and truly sets them up for a successful college experience. Students who complete both courses will undoubtedly find themselves ahead of their college peers."

College Board's Advanced Placement® Program (AP®) gives students the opportunity to take challenging collegelevel courses while still in high school. Earning a score of 3 or higher on an AP Exam has multiple benefits for students, including earning college credit, advanced placement in college courses, or both, saving them time and money. Research shows AP students are better prepared for and more likely to enroll and remain in college, do well in classes, and earn their degrees on time. Each exam is developed by a committee of college and university faculty and AP teachers, ensuring that AP Exams align with their high standards.

In addition, GLHS proudly recognized 48 AP Scholars, 80 AP Scholars with Distinction, 27 AP Scholars with Honors, and one student earned an International Diploma during this exam cycle.

### **LONG-TIME PUPPY RAISERS HONORED**

The Seeing Eye

The Seeing Eye recently honored five longtime puppy raisers with induction to "The Seeing Eye 21 Club", a special honor for volunteers who have raised at least 21 Seeing Eye® puppies. The non-profit also honored the Seeing Eye puppy raising club volunteers with two awards, the Outstanding Leader Award and the 20-year Leader Award. Finally, 34 exceptional collegebound puppy raisers were awarded college scholarships totaling \$64,000.

"Each year, The Seeing Eye's Family Day is a celebration of all the hard work and dedication of our volunteer puppy raising families," said Seeing Eye director of canine development Peggy Gibbon. "An army of volunteers provides each Seeing Eye puppy with a loving home environment, socialization, and basic training that prepares them to become Seeing Eye dogs for people who are blind."

"We're actively recruiting puppy raisers and puppy sitters for our upcoming litters that are planned for the coming months. If you're interested in joining our community of dog lovers, now is a great time to reach out to us and learn what puppy raising is all about," said Gibbon. "We need homes and families of all shapes and sizes for our puppies because fully trained Seeing Eye dogs are placed in similarly diverse families and living situations with people who are blind."

A puppy raiser family is responsible for providing a loving and nurturing home environment for approximately one year. During that time, the raiser is responsible for teaching

basic obedience, house manners, bringing the puppy to Seeing Eye puppy club meetings and socialization trips in their area. The Seeing Eye puppy could be a German shepherd, Labrador retriever, golden retriever, or a Labrador/golden retriever cross.

Puppy raisers must live within New Jersey, eastern Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware or New York (Rockland or Orange Counties) so they can attend regular puppy club meetings where they will receive help and coaching with their puppies. All veterinary expenses are covered by The Seeing Eye and a stipend is provided to help cover the cost of dog food. If a Seeing Eye puppy does not graduate from the program, the family who raised the puppy is offered the first option to adopt the puppy they raised. For more

Established in 1929, The Seeing Eye provides specially bred and trained dogs to guide people who are blind. Seeing Eye dog handlers experience greatly enhanced mobility and independence, allowing them to retain their active lifestyles. The Seeing Eye is a 501(c)3 non-profit supported by contributions from individuals, corporations and foundations, bequests, and other planned gifts.






