RETIRED WHRHS NURSE WORKS TO HELP HAITIAN ORPHANS

Global Health Share

Global Health Share is a non-profit which since 2019 has been dedicated to supporting an orphanage as well as education programs and marketable skills training for children and families in Haiti. The 501c3 charity recently held its second annual Caribbean fundraiser at the Country Lakes firehouse in Browns Mills, NJ. One of its founders is Nan Masterson, who was formally the head school nurse at Watchung Hills Regional High School from 2000 through 2015

Global Health Share provides funding for food, free elementary and secondary education programs, daily after school help, basic healthcare when funds are available, and marketing skills training to poor families in the communities that they serve. The country of Haiti does not provide free education to children, so if parents are unable to pay for tuition, uniforms, and supplies (which cost about \$400 to \$500 per student per year), the children cannot attend school.

"Since Haiti became an independent country in 1804, they have endured major political and environmental challenges. Two years ago, the President of Haiti was murdered, and gangs took over Port au Prince, the capital city of Haiti. Recent news reports refer to Port au Prince as the most dangerous city in the world. The children and programs that Global Health Share supports are located far enough away from Port au Prince to be out of harm's way, and the education programs can continue most days. The biggest issue now is access to food and clean water due to the fact that the gangs have closed ports that receive imports of food, and food is scarce. The cost of food has escalated, and Global Health Share, with generous donations has been addressing these needs" said the organization's founder, and President, Nan Masterson.

While working at WHRHS, Nan Masterson addressed the healthcare needs of students, and states that she loved every minute of it. In 2016 she retired from Watchung Hills. After "retirement" she volunteered on Chamberlain University clinical immersion trips

for nursing students to Kenya. After the second trip she was asked to join their global health education program faculty. Over the next few years, she took students to India, Brazil, and Haiti. She began the non-profit in Haiti after a trip to the country in 2018 while training nursing students in community health.

"There was devastation in every country that I did clinical immersions in with students, however, nothing affected me so deeply as the conditions that the children were living in at an orphanage where we did health assessments in Haiti. It changed my heart forever, and knew I had to do something," she said.

Since Masterson and her students' initial purchase of one month's supply of food for the children at the orphanage, Global Health Share has grown to support two school programs in Leogane and Gressier providing funds for food, uniforms, teacher salaries, structural building repairs, and much-needed supplies, as well as weekend skills-based training workshops. Baking, sewing, computer literacy, and English language instruction have been taught to help the families develop marketable skills for earning a living.

The Caribbean Fundraiser featured regional food, live steel drum music, hula hoop fun, a Caribbean trivia contest, drum circle conga line, basket auction, and 50/50 drawing. During the event Masterson recognized planning committee members Mark and Elisabeth McCartney for their support. For more information, or to make a donation visit globalhealthsharecharity.org.


St. Vincent de Paul sponsors a food pantry serving the local community. It depends on donations from the parishioners to stock the food pantry. We serve 60 or more needy families us a month. As the Director of Social Outreach, I, Sr. Anita Marie Gramer, C.S.JB. oversee the food pantry, buy food as needed, and work with the people preparing the food for distribution.

Every year on the feast of Corpus Christi, the Bishop of the Diocese requires that every parish to collect designated food for the Diocesan food banks. This year, we filled one truckload of food and delivered it to St. Simone the Apostle food bank.

As an Advent project, we placed 600 angel donate 450 toys for poor children. Plus 150 socks and sweatshirts for the homeless. St. Agnes Spanish Church received 150 toys. George W. Washington Elementary School received 300 toys. All donations were distributed before Christmas.



JAZZ PIANIST CHARU SURI TO PERFORM AT FREE CONCERT – OCTOBER 26

On October 26 at 7:00 p.m., the First Presbyterian Church of Stirling welcomes jazz pianist and composer Charu Suri and her trio.

Charu Suri treads fearlessly between genres. pulling global influences that range from the mood-anchoring Indian ragas, Sufi music, to the trio. Her ground-breaking albums, "The Book of Ragas", and its sequel, "The Book of Ragas vol. 2" have often elicited the response, "I've never heard this type of sound before."

One of the few female composers from India to perform work at Carnegie Hall, Charu has lived on four continents and writes music that reflects her journey as both a traveler and her training as a classical music piano prodigy. She has been playing the piano since the age of five, and performing since the age of nine, and one of her best memories is winning an international

piano competition at the age of 15.

What started purely as an experiment with her "Book of Ragas" has turned into a niche that she is now increasingly becoming known for. Her latest album is RAGAS & WALTZES, a first collaboration between her and Preservation Hall's jazz drummer, Joe Lastie. More recently she recorded her 2023 album, RAGS & RAGAS, with bassist John Patitucci, drummer Joe Lastie, drummer Steve Gadd, and pianist Kobi Arad.

This will be the first concert in the Church's concert series for the 2024 - 2025 season. Admission, as always, is free. A short reception will follow the concert at which attendees may meet the performer. Refreshments will be served.





LONG-TIME PUPPY RAISERS HONORED

The Seeing Eye

The Seeing Eye recently honored five long-time puppy raisers with induction to "The Seeing Eye 21 Club", a special honor for volunteers who have raised at least 21 Seeing Eye® puppies. The non-profit also honored the Seeing Eye puppy raising club volunteers with two awards, the Outstanding Leader Award and the 20-year Leader Award. Finally, 34 exceptional college-bound puppy raisers were awarded college scholarships totaling \$64,000.

"Each year, The Seeing Eye's Family Day is a celebration of all the hard work and dedication of our volunteer puppy raising families," said Seeing Eye director of canine development Peggy Gibbon. "An army of volunteers provides each Seeing Eye puppy with a loving home environment, socialization, and basic training that prepares them to become Seeing Eye dogs for people who are blind."

"We're actively recruiting puppy raisers and puppy sitters for our upcoming litters that are planned for the coming months. If you're interested in joining our community of dog lovers, now is a great time to reach out to us and learn what puppy raising is all about," said Gibbon. "We need homes and families of all shapes and sizes for our puppies because fully trained Seeing Eye dogs are placed in similarly diverse families and living situations with people who are blind."

A puppy raiser family is responsible for providing a loving and nurturing home environment for approximately one year. During

that time, the raiser is responsible for teaching basic obedience, house manners, bringing the puppy to Seeing Eye puppy club meetings and socialization trips in their area. The Seeing Eye puppy could be a German shepherd, Labrador retriever, golden retriever, or a Labrador/golden retriever cross.

Puppy raisers must live within New Jersey, eastern Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware or New York (Rockland or Orange Counties) so they can attend regular puppy club meetings where they will receive help and coaching with their puppies. All veterinary expenses are covered by The Seeing Eye and a stipend is provided to help cover the cost of dog food. If a Seeing Eye puppy does not graduate from the program, the family who raised the puppy is offered the first option to adopt the puppy they raised. For more information visit seeingeye.org/raise.

Established in 1929, The Seeing Eye provides specially bred and trained dogs to guide people who are blind. Seeing Eye dog handlers experience greatly enhanced mobility and independence, allowing them to retain their active lifestyles. The Seeing Eye is a 501(c)3 non-profit supported by contributions from individuals, corporations and foundations, bequests, and other planned gifts.


