## LONG-TIME PUPPY RAISERS HONORED

### The Seeing Eye

The Seeing Eye recently honored five long-time puppy raisers with induction to “The Seeing Eye 21 Club”, a special honor for volunteers who have raised at least 21 Seeing Eye® puppies. The non-profit also honored the Seeing Eye puppy raising club volunteers with two awards, the Outstanding Leader Award and the 20-year Leader Award. Finally, 34 exceptional college-bound puppy raisers were awarded college scholarships totaling \$64,000.

“Each year, The Seeing Eye’s Family Day is a celebration of all the hard work and dedication of our volunteer puppy raising families,” said Seeing Eye director of canine development Peggy Gibbon. “An army of volunteers provides each Seeing Eye puppy with a loving home environment, socialization, and basic training that prepares them to become Seeing Eye dogs for people who are blind.”

“We’re actively recruiting puppy raisers and puppy sitters for our upcoming litters that are planned for the coming months. If you’re interested in joining our community of dog lovers, now is a great time to reach out to us and learn what puppy raising is all about,” said Gibbon. “We need homes and families of all shapes and sizes for our puppies because fully

trained Seeing Eye dogs are placed in similarly diverse families and living situations with people who are blind.”

A puppy raiser family is responsible for providing a loving and nurturing home environment for approximately one year. During that time, the raiser is responsible for teaching basic obedience, house manners, bringing the puppy to Seeing Eye puppy club meetings and socialization trips in their area. The Seeing Eye puppy could be a German shepherd, Labrador retriever, golden retriever, or a Labrador/golden retriever cross.

Puppy raisers must live within New Jersey, eastern Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware or New York (Rockland or Orange Counties) so they can attend regular puppy club meetings where they will receive help and coaching with their puppies. All veterinary expenses are covered by The Seeing Eye and a stipend is provided to

help cover the cost of dog food. If a Seeing Eye puppy does not graduate from the program, the family who raised the puppy is offered the first option to adopt the puppy they raised. For more information visit [seeingeye.org/raise](http://seeingeye.org/raise).

Established in 1929, The Seeing Eye provides specially bred and trained dogs to guide people who are blind. Seeing Eye dog handlers experience greatly enhanced mobility and independence, allowing them to retain their active lifestyles. The Seeing Eye is a 501(c)3 non-profit supported by contributions from individuals, corporations and foundations, bequests, and other planned gifts.



# NJIO KICKS OFF SEASON WITH FREE CONCERT ON NOVEMBER 10TH

New Jersey Intergenerational Orchestra (NJIO) will present its first concert of its 31st Season on November 10th at 3 pm at Crescent Avenue Presbyterian Church in Plainfield. Three of NJIO's ensembles will perform at this Fall Concert.

The concert is free and open to the public, with a relaxed concert atmosphere. Donations are gratefully accepted.

The Symphony Orchestra, conducted by Artistic Director Warren Cohen, will perform with two winners of our annual Young Artist Concerto Competition. 15-year-old violinist Elizabeth Poppy Song of Haworth, NJ will perform the first movement of the Tchaikovsky Violin Concerto. ## THE NOVEMBER SPEAKERS PROGRAM FOR THE SUMMIT AREA OLD GUARD

The Summit Area Old Guard is a social, educational, and recreational organization that serves men of retirement age. **November 5th**, our speaker will be Joel Kampf, an Executive Coach specializing in Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI). His process centers on helping his clients become more aware of the limitations of working in silos, siloed linear thinking, and to better recognize the opportunities gained by focusing on organizational connections. He will discuss DEI and its impact on business and the military. Joel is also an avid bicyclist and at the age of sixty, pedaled across the United States, solo and unsupported.

**November 12th**, Will Dodge, a Chatham resident, will tell us about the trials and tribulations of starting a brewery, from scratch, in Summit, during COVID. After seven years in finance, Will wanted a different path. He enjoyed the art of brewing and decided to pursue

## DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH

### County of Morris

The Morris County Board of County Commissioners declared October 2024 "Domestic Violence Awareness Month" and presented a framed proclamation to JBWS President and CEO Diane Williams during tonight's work session in Morristown.

JBWS, established in 1976, has grown into a full-service nonprofit that provides safety, support, and solutions for survivors of abuse. In 2023, JBWS handled approximately 4,685 helpline calls, offered legal advocacy to 1,143 people, and conducted 940 Crisis Response

Team interventions at local police stations and hospitals.

In partnership with Morris County agencies, JBWS founded the Morris Family Justice Center in 2016. Located at the county's Administration and Records Building, the center offers a centralized hub where survivors can access counseling, legal and immigration assistance, child services, and more. The center is one of only two in New Jersey and is recognized as a best practice by the U.S. Department of Justice.

In 2023, 599 adults and children received comprehensive services from multiple agencies

within the Morris Family Justice Center, a statistic that increased significantly from 470 in 2022.
