said "These HS sophomores were such a big help and were able to stuff the over 500 goody bags very efficiently for us. We really appreciate their help."

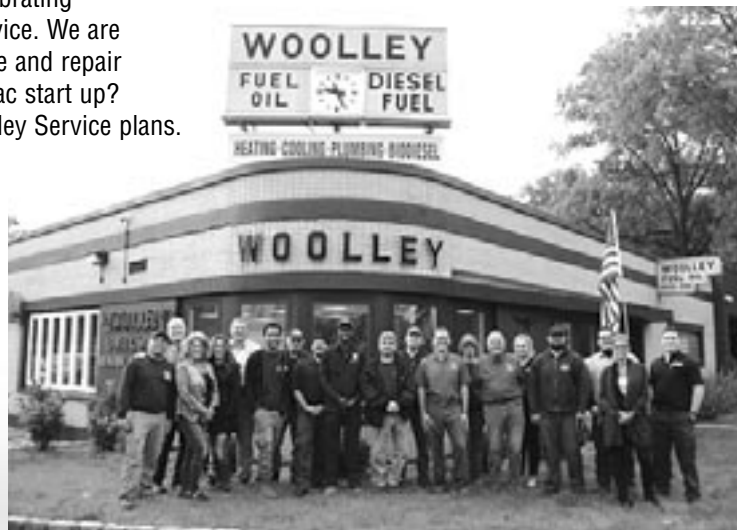

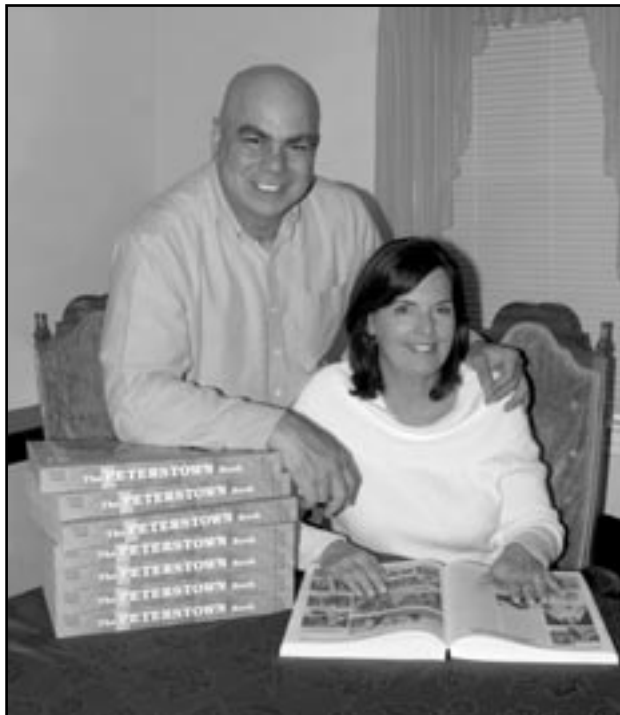
