DONATION DRIVE MEETS EMERGENCY SQUAD NEEDED GOAL

The Chatham Emergency Squad (CES), a nonprofit, all-volunteer emergency medical services organization serving the Chatham community, is reaching out for support in its year-end donation drive to help close the \$115,000 funding gap needed to meet its 2024 operating budget.

CES relies primarily on the generosity of the local community to fund its annual budget, covering essential operating costs such as training, medical supplies, equipment, and ambulance maintenance, and ensuring that residents receive critical, high-quality emergency care at no personal expense. In addition, CES provides free CPR training for Chatham residents, standby coverage at local events and free medical transportation for those in need.

"Chatham is known for its strong community spirit and commitment to helping neighbors in times of need," said CES President Evan Skinner. "Our year-end drive is an opportunity for the community to continue that tradition by helping us keep our ambulances ready, our volunteers trained, and our services available to

every resident in an emergency."

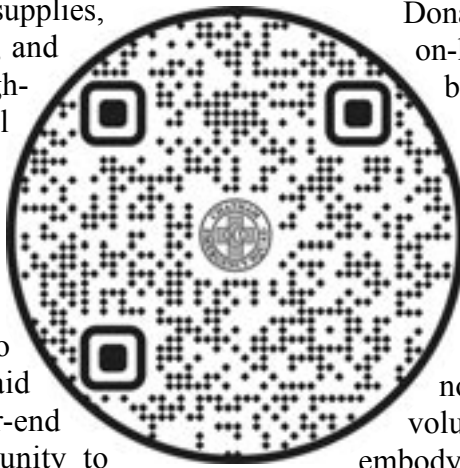

CHILDREN'S PEACE FESTIVAL EXPLORES AND EXPANDS QUAKER MEETING

Amid the election buzz and global conflicts, there was a place of calm, creativity and joy at the much-expanded second annual Children's Peace Festival on Saturday afternoon, November 2, at the Chatham Summit Quaker Meeting in Chatham, New Jersey.

In keeping with this year's theme of "Peace Begins with Me", there were activities for all, especially families with young children.

"The timing was perfect," said Anna Whitely, 16, about the bluebird sky for the mostly-outdoor event and the fact that folks were craving a moment of peace. Anna, who founded the Children's Peace Festival, is a junior at Summit High School and a member of the Quaker meeting. "Seeing young families so eager to learn

peace-building skills gives me hope. Thank you to everyone who pitched in to make it happen and to all the young families who came. Let's do it again!"

Collaborative games were a big hit, parents and grandparents joined in, including the hilarious Freeze Dance and A Big Wind Blows.

Peace-centered arts and crafts were a big attraction, giving eager hands a chance to express themselves. Children painted peace rocks (donated by Fusco Brothers of Chatham), to take with them or leave behind on the peace path. They also made colorful meditation jars with glitter, glue and more as simple tools to help keep calm when under stress.

When not working with their hands or playing games, children and their parents were given the opportunity to slip off their shoes, enter the calm of the Quaker meeting room and explore the basics of meditation.

The voices of both children and adults could be heard throughout the festival, starting with the Hummingbirds Chorus from Kent Place School (their second year performing at the festival) and followed by young singers from Elefante Music and School for the Performing Arts.

Adding stunning color to the music-- and the day--was the Peace Garden. Students of all ages from Cornerstone School, a Summit-based preschool, Summit High School and Drew University created flowers made with recycled materials. Each crafted flower was displayed in a path of bright yellow mums donated by The Farm at Green Village.

CELEBRATE WITH THE PIPES OF CHRISTMAS

The beloved Pipes of Christmas fundraising concert is delighted to be entering their second quarter century with a brand-new production.

The popular holiday event will be returning to the Madison Avenue Presbyterian Church in NYC on Decemehr 14, and Central Presbyterian Church in Summit, NJ on Decemehr 15.

The Pipes of Christmas brings together

musicians, soloists, and performers from across America and the UK to share the magic of the holiday season through the timeless sounds of Celtic music. The show features traditional favorites and newly commissioned works performed on pipes and drums, harp and fiddle, organ, brass, and more, as well as readings taken from the Celtic literature of Scotland, Ireland, and Wales.

Featured performers include guitarist and music director Steve Gibb from Inverness, Scotland, actor James Robinson of “A Merry Scottish Christmas,” “Braveheart,” and “Outlander,” fiddler Caitlin Warbelow from Broadway’s “Come from Away,” and US Harp Champion harpist Rachel Clemente.

In both locations, the company will include the Solid Brass ensemble and the St. Columcille United Pipe Band led by Pipe Major Cameron MacDougall.

Also making her Pipes of Christmas debut will be Madelyn Monaghan, an Irish American traditional (sean-nós) singer based in New York City. In September of this year, Madelyn was a leading performer at the Celtic World Forum in Dublin alongside the likes of Máiréad Nesbitt and Clannad’s Moya Brennan and appeared in the Celtic Music Festival in Rockport, MA. Her voice can be heard via TikTok, museums, film scores, and commercials, and her album éist is available on all streaming platforms.

The Pipes of Christmas is hosted by the Learned Kindred of Currie, a non-profit cultural and educational organization dedicated to preserving and promoting Scottish and Highland heritage and the arts. As its primary fundraiser, the concert enables the Kindred’s continued efforts to support the global Scottish community through initiatives such as:

- Producing Tartan Day on Ellis Island, perhaps the largest Tartan Day event in the world, which received 80,000 visitors in 2024 alone
- Providing scholarships to deserving students in the US, Canada, and Scotland
- Sponsoring competitions and festivals across the globe
- Commissioning of new musical and cultural works
- A global monuments initiative, which helps erect and preserve new and existing locations such as the Scottish Writers Museum and Bale nam Bàrd (the bard’s home) on the Island of South Uist
- Developing a cultural heritage center in Scotland (currently in preliminary stages)





The Presbyterian Church of Chatham Township (PCCT) announced that it installed The Rev. Thomas A. Brown as Pastor and Head of Staff at a service on Sunday, Oct. 20. Prior to his selection and installation, Rev. Brown had served as the church's Associate Pastor of Congregational Life for nearly 12 years. Taking part in the installation were members of the congregation, close friends in ministry, and representatives from the Presbytery of the Highlands, which provides support and resources to nearly 80 Presbyterian Church (USA) congregations in seven counties in Northwest New Jersey, including PCCT. The Presbytery elected Rev. Brown to serve as its Moderator for 2023.

"I feel incredibly fortunate to be able to continue serving PCCT, and by extension Chatham and the surrounding area," said Rev. Brown. "Moving into this new position brings a deep sense of gratitude and genuine excitement. I believe our congregation, and each of our local places of worship, have vital roles to play in building networks that can provide support and extend a sense of welcome to each member of our community."

Since becoming Associate Pastor in 2012, Rev. Brown has played active and visible roles in the church and community. He is a member of the Chatham Interfaith Council, and for more than a decade took part in a team of religious leaders who met with Chatham High School seniors to plan the annual Baccalaureate Service at graduation. Further, he has led eight summer mission trips involving area teens and adults focused on improving living conditions for underserved

communities in several states.

Two years ago, the PCCT congregation wholeheartedly supported Rev. Brown in his successful application for a prestigious national clergy renewal grant funded by the Lilly Endowment Inc., and administered by the Christian Theological Seminary in Indianapolis. This competitive program honors pastors for their extraordinary service, and enables them to engage in a period of rest and renewal with the goal of invigorating their leadership and bringing new vitality to their congregations.

Rev. Brown notes that his installation as Pastor of PCCT takes place almost exactly 25 years from the date he was ordained as a pastor following seminary. He holds dual Masters degrees in Divinity and Christian Education from Princeton Theological Seminary. Also, he recently completed a Certificate in Executive Leadership program at McCormick Theological Seminary in Chicago.

Rev. Brown and his wife, Alison Siener Brown, have two sons, Zachary and Nathan. Alison is Director of Music for All Saints' Episcopal Church in Millington, and took part in the installation service. Also participating was The Rev. Dr. Edward Halldorson, Pastor Emeritus of PCCT.

The Presbyterian Church of Chatham Township is a vibrant, multi-generational congregation that celebrates the glory of God through faith, fellowship and service. Drawing members from three counties and more than 20 communities, it welcomes all, whether you are a young family, a single adult, or a couple with grown children. The congregation reflects diverse perspectives, provides rich music and education programs for all ages, and through social outreach addresses hunger, homelessness and recovery from disasters or other crises.

OLD GUARD DECEMBER SPEAKERS PROGRAM

The Summit Area Old Guard is a social, educational, and recreational organization that serves men of retirement age. We meet most Tuesdays at the New Providence Presbyterian Church located at 1307 Springfield Ave. Our dues are minimal, and members manage all aspects of the operation. Our motto is "Come for the Programs. Stay for the Friends." The organization was founded in 1930.

In December, we will have two speakers:

On December 3rd, our speaker will be Ron Brachman, an internationally known expert in Artificial Intelligence. In 2023 he retired from his positions as the Director of the Jacobs Technion-Cornell Institute at Cornell Tech and Professor of Computer Science at Cornell University. He has also held research leadership positions at Yahoo, DARPA, AT&T Labs, and Bell Labs. Ron will discuss the amazing leaps forward in Artificial Intelligence over the past several years, and examine the unexpected, humanlike blunders the programs continue to make. Briefly, the algorithms, capable of constructing solutions to many complex problems, lack what is generally perceived as 'common sense'. In his talk, Ron Brachman will consider what common sense is about, what AI has tried to do about it, and what's

still missing.

On December 10th, James M. Kossler will discuss the FBI versus the Cosa Nostra. Jim spent 23 years as an FBI agent and was the Coordinating Supervisor for the New York office responsible for directing the Organized Crime unit. As an expert witness he testified in numerous mob trials in New York, New Jersey, and Philadelphia. Jim was featured in the Netflix documentary "Fear City: New York vs. the Mafia." Jim will provide a brief history of Cosa Nostra (Mafia) and how they went from controlling unions and industry in New York and New Jersey, to being turned into street gangs.

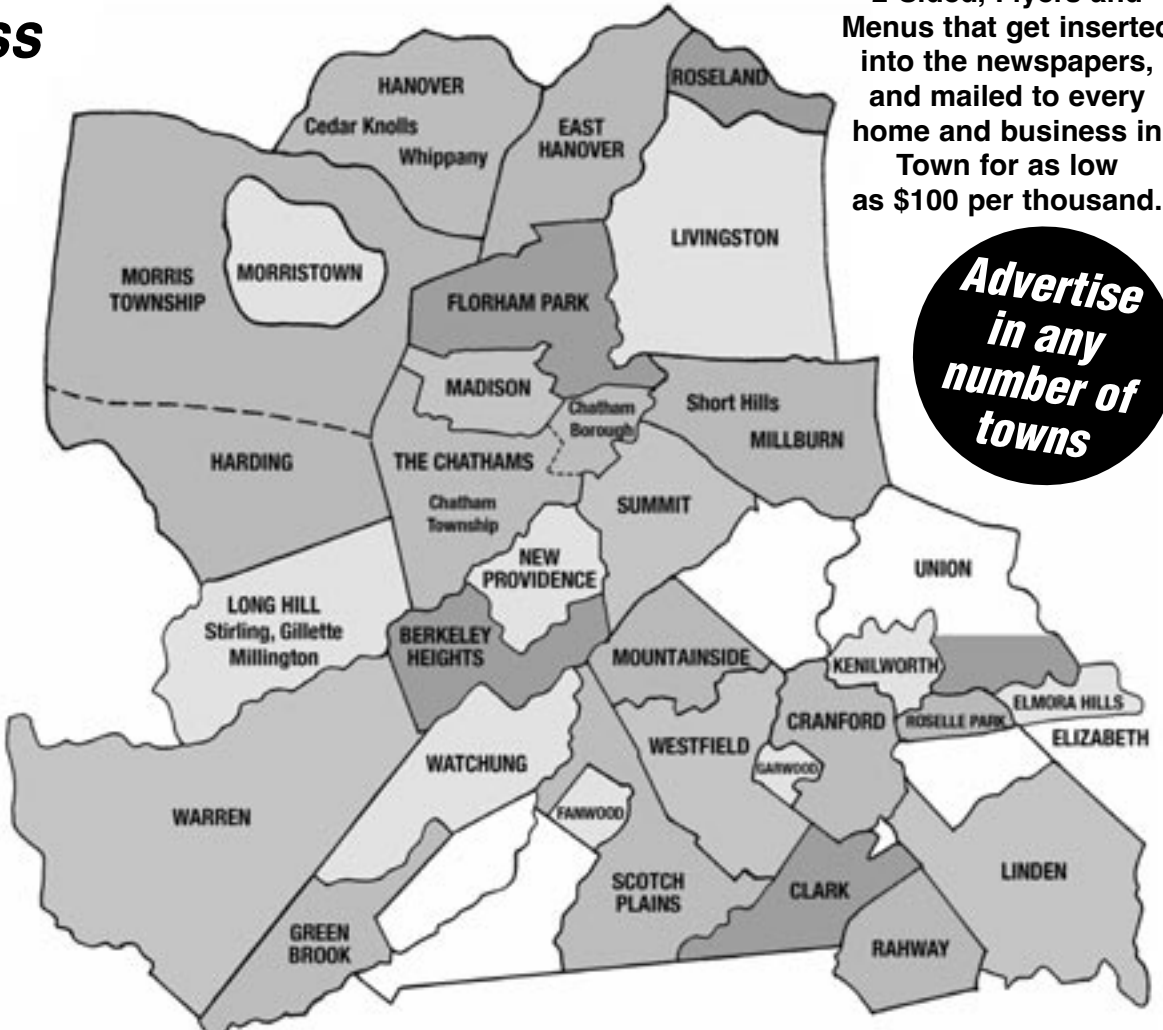
