## **NICHOLAS BREEN EARNS EAGLE SCOUT RANK**


Nicholas A Breen earned the rank of Eagle Scout on September 12, 2024, from Green Brook Boy Scout Troop 129. Nick started in Cub Scouts as a Tiger (1st Grade) and continued his path to Eagle Scout just after graduating from Watchung Hills Regional High School in June. Nick stated, "Having both of my parents involved with emergency services, myself in cub scouts, and boy scouts I have learned a lot about helping others and my community."

When it was time for Nick to decide on an Eagle Scout Project, he wanted to give back to his hometown of Green Brook. He decided to help renovate a trail called, "Cardinal Lane" which starts at the top of Washington Rock Park and goes down the hill to Cardinal Lane. Nick stated, "My project will help both people from the township and visitors who wish to enjoy Green Brook."

This trail originated in the 1800's as a road for stagecoaches as there were resorts up our mountain. Nick wanted to "clean and mark the trail for hiking and exercise," and once his project was complete more people would know the history and utilize the trail more frequently. Nick and his Troop cleared many large fallen trees, underbrush, and trash. He then installed 3 benches on the trail for people to rest on while hiking. On top of the trail, he also felt it would be helpful to install a guiderail as the trail is rather steep. This project was hard labor in the hottest week of summer, but Nick and his team got it completed.

Nick has decided to follow his parents into the emergency services. Nick is currently enrolled in an apprenticeship program taking classes and working on an ambulance to earn his Emergency Medical Technician certification. This will lead to a paid position which will allow him to take classes at Raritan Valley Community College while working in the field that he loves.

Nick has been a wonderful role model for both scouts and the Green Brook Roller Hockey League where he mentored younger children for many years. We continue to watch for what Nick will accomplish in the future, and the leaders from Troop 129 wish him the best. Congratulations Nicholas!

## **WOOL SPINNING AND DYEING EVENT**

The Green Brook Cultural, Heritage and Historic Preservation Committee/Green Brook Historical Society hosted a "Wool Spinning and Black Walnut Dyeing Event" on October 19, 2024, at the Dr. John Vermeule House.

It was presented by Kat Crippen, a former professor from Monmouth University who is a historian, writer, living history re-enactor, and professional fiber artist. She demonstrated the art of weaving and spinning and, along with husband, John, instructed visitors in the art of boiling walnut hulls to obtain a liquid used for dyeing cloth.

Those that attended were able to tour the 1799 house and property, along with its herb garden that house plants that would have been used by the doctor for early 19th century medicines.

Assisting at the event were student volunteers from Watchung Hills Regional High School Yeva Sakardina and Kateryna Borysenko. They previously assisted at our events and are enthusiastic volunteers who are eager to learn about our local history and share it with others. We welcome and appreciate them as partners.

Our monthly open houses are held on the 3rd Saturday of the month from 10 a.m. - 12 p.m. We are always looking for ideas on local or American history topics, to edify and engage our visitors. Is there something you would like to learn about in 2025? Please share your ideas with us.
