The luminary kits cost \$1 per kit in all quantities and include paper bags, candles and sand. Customers are encouraged to bring buckets, boxes or plastic bags to transport the sand. Payments can be made by cash, check or Venmo.

Luminaries are traditionally used to illuminate the streets on Christmas Eve. A candle is nestled in sand at the bottom of a paper bag and placed

along sidewalks to create a beautiful walkway. The candles are then lit at dusk on Christmas Eve. Some neighborhoods in the area get together and buy hundreds of kits to create an amazing display.

All proceeds from the sale will be used to fund the various charitable and humanitarian projects that Rotary supports, both locally and internationally.


Matthew is the son of Peter and Ruth Lee-Mui of Scotch Plains.

Matthew said he has completed his Eagle board of review.







EMILY LITZ RECEIVES A 2024-25 NEW JERSEY MILKEN EDUCATOR AWARD

At a surprise assembly held on November 14th, Milken Educator Awards Senior Vice President Dr. Jane Foley presented fifth grade teacher Emily Litz with the honor of a 2024-25 New Jersey Milken Educator Award and an unrestricted \$25,000 cash prize. New Jersey Acting Commissioner of Education Kevin Dehmer joined the celebration to honor Emily as an outstanding educator in front of students, colleagues, dignitaries.

Emily is the first-ever Milken Award recipient in Scotch Plains-Fanwood Public Schools history and joins the national Milken Educator Network on the path to the announcement of the 3,000th Milken Educator this Award season.

The Milken Family Foundation was founded by Michael and Lowell Milken in 1982, the Milken Family Foundation strives to discover
