DAFFODIL PROJECT OF THE TOWNSHIP'S PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Eighth-grade students and staff from Kawameeh Middle School came together on November 15, 2024, to participate in their first planting for The Daffodil Project. This global initiative honors the 1.5 million children lost during the Holocaust by planting daffodils, a flower symbolizing remembrance and resilience.

During the school day, students dug into the soil in front of the school, planting over 250 bulbs sent by the project. As part of their Holocaust Unit, students explored the essential question: How do we remember the past? The planting, led by teachers Nikki Dowling, Nicole Osborne, Deana Buchanan, Kamuela Tillman, and Nikki Kelly, is the first of many hoped-for annual events.

Following the planting, students reflected on their experiences by writing original poetry, blending their hands-on work with creative expression. Kawameeh Middle School aims to make this a lasting tradition, inspiring remembrance and hope for generations to come.





CELEBRATE WITH THE PIPES OF CHRISTMAS

The beloved Pipes of Christmas fundraising concert is delighted to be entering their second quarter century with a brand-new production.

The popular holiday event will be returning to theMadison Avenue Presbyterian Church in NYC on December 14, and Central Presbyterian Church in Summit, NJ on December 15.

The Pipes of Christmas brings together musicians, soloists, and performers from across America and the UK to share the magic of the holiday season through the timeless sounds of Celtic music. The show features traditional favorites and newly commissioned works performed on pipes and drums, harp and fiddle, organ, brass, and more, as well as readings taken from the Celtic literature of Scotland, Ireland, and Wales.

Featured performers include guitarist and music director Steve Gibb from Inverness, Scotland, actor James Robinson of "A Merry Scottish Christmas," "Braveheart," and "Outlander," fiddler Caitlin Warbelow from Broadway's "Come from Away," and US Harp Champion harpist Rachel Clemente.

Audiences will thrill to the Commonwealth Pipes and Drums under the leadership of Pipe Major Adam Holdaway and the B-Line Brass Quintet led by CJ Waldrop.

In both locations, the company will include the Solid Brass ensemble and the St. Columcille United Pipe Band led by Pipe Major Cameron MacDougall.

Also making her Pipes of Christmas debut will be Madelyn Monaghan, an Irish American traditional (sean-nós) singer based in New York City. In September of this year, Madelyn was a leading performer at the Celtic World Forum in Dublin alongside the likes of Máiréad Nesbitt and Clannad's Moya Brennan and appeared in the Celtic Music Festival in Rockport, MA. Her voice can be heard via TikTok, museums, film scores, and commercials, and her album éist is available on all streaming platforms.

The Pipes of Christmas is hosted by the Learned Kindred of Currie, a non-profit cultural

and educational organization dedicated to preserving and promoting Scottish and Highland heritage and the arts. As its primary fundraiser, the concert enables the Kindred's continued efforts to support the global Scottish community through initiatives such as:

- Producing Tartan Day on Ellis Island, perhaps the largest Tartan Day event in the world, which received 80,000 visitors in 2024 alone
- Providing scholarships to deserving students in the US, Canada, and Scotland
- Sponsoring competitions and festivals across the globe
- Commissioning of new musical and cultural works
- A global monuments initiative, which helps erect and preserve new and existing locations such as the Scottish Writers Museum and Bale nam Bàrd (the bard's home) on the Island of South Uist
- Developing a cultural heritage center in Scotland (currently in preliminary stages)

THE INSPIRING JOURNEY OF NANCY "ZOEH" ARAN

NJ Sharing Network

According to the U.S. Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) and the Organ Procurement and Transplant Network (OPTN), over 22,000 Hispanic individuals are currently on the national organ transplant waiting list. In 2023, Hispanic Americans made up about 15% of all organ donors in the U.S. This number is steadily growing, though it still falls short compared to the need among Hispanic transplant patients.

As the nation celebrated Hispanic Heritage Month (September 15 to October 15), NJ Sharing Network proudly honored the vital contributions of Hispanic Americans, not only in enriching our communities but in supporting the lifesaving mission of organ and tissue donation. NJ Sharing Network is proud to share the remarkable story of Nancy "Zoeh" Arana of Roselle, NJ, whose life shows the power of organ donation and transplantation.

EMBRACING LIFE AND GIVING BACK

Born in El Salvador, Zoeh and her family immigrated to the United States, where she enjoyed a healthy and happy childhood. However, her life took a dramatic turn when she was diagnosed with kidney failure. Despite undergoing rigorous dialysis treatments and maintaining a hopeful outlook, the reality of her condition made it clear that a kidney transplant was her only chance for survival.

"I remember writing down my thoughts, memories, and important life lessons in a notebook for my daughter, Nancy, because I did not think I was going to live much longer. I was clinging to every bit of hope I could find," said Zoeh.

Zoeh's prayers were answered when a friend of her husband Carlos connected them with the family of a young man who suffered a fatal accident. The young man's mother, who was made aware of Zoeh's need for a kidney, was moved to make a directed donation and donated her son's kidney to Zoeh. This provided Zoeh with the lifesaving transplant she so desperately needed.

"I am forever grateful to my donor and his

mother. Their incredible generosity not only saved my life but also inspires me every day. I am committed to honoring their gift and my donor's legacy," said Zoeh.

Since her transplant, Zoeh has dedicated her life to giving back by actively supporting her church and her personal mission work in El Salvador and Colombia. Zoeh and Carlos have also served as foster parents, providing care and support to children in need.

Zoeh's path to NJ Sharing Network began while she was working at a nonprofit focused on mental health. Though she loved her job, she sought a new role where she could expand her reach and touch more lives. Now, as part of the NJ Sharing Network team, Zoeh uses her experience to connect with diverse communities, educate others about organ and tissue donation, and inspire hope in those waiting for transplants.

"Being a part of the NJ Sharing Network team feels like another perfect match, just like my kidney," said Zoeh. "Every day, I'm grateful to be part of an organization that saves and enhances lives. To think that 18 years ago, I was sick and struggling, and now I'm helping others learn about the power of organ and tissue donation -

it's truly the perfect circle."

Zoeh's connection to organ donation doesn't stop with her own story. Her sister also received a kidney transplant after battling a rare kidney disorder, and their mother, touched by the gift of life her daughters received, altruistically donated her kidney to a stranger.

"We are a family that is all-in when it comes to organ donation," Zoeh shared. "My mom's decision to donate to a stranger truly symbolizes what organ donation is about - giving life, even to those we may never meet."

According to United Network for Organ Sharing (UNOS), nearly 4,000 New Jersey residents are waiting for a lifesaving transplant. One organ and tissue donor can save eight lives and enhance the lives of over 75 people. However, the opportunity to give the gift of life is extremely rare - not everyone who registers as a donor is able to donate after they pass away. In fact, less than 1% of all deaths meet the specific medical criteria to be an organ donor. This underscores the pressing need for more registered donors – especially in our diverse communities.

"Unfortunately, there are some common myths and misinformation that has contributed to a lower registration rate within our Hispanic communities, such as believing that doctors will not work as hard to save the lives of registered organ and tissue donors or that organ and tissue donation is against religious beliefs," said Zoeh. "By sharing my story, I hope that we can help break down these barriers and ensure that more lives are saved."




