The Building (Construction) Department is located in Town Hall at 29 Park Avenue, 1st floor. Go through the main entrance and turn right; offices are on the right.


Residents are welcome to come talk to Joe about their specific construction projects, get permit information or inquire about any other needs they may have from his department. Joe is a 19-year employee of the Township, working in our town as an inspector in addition to his current role as Construction Official, and was also born and bred in Berkeley Heights. He loves this town, and his commitment to it shows in his diligence on the job. Please come by and meet him!

About the Construction Official & the Building Department

The Construction Official's job is to implement local building/construction codes that are in line with the state Uniform Construction Code (UCC) by granting or denying development permit applications in accordance with its provisions. The Construction Official is responsible for enforcement of all construction codes and issuance of construction permits, and provides oversight to the Building Department, which includes full- and part-time employees, as well as fire, plumbing, electrical, building and mechanical inspectors.


