## STUDENTS RISE TO THE AMERICAN HEART CHALLENGE

The American Heart Association has partnered with Kumpf Middle School this February for the American Heart Challenge. The purpose of the event is for the students to complete Finns Mission as they look to take on lifesaving skills.

As part of the American Heart Challenge, Physical Education and Health Teacher Brittany Casares set up an event where all Kumpf students will have the opportunity to learn about CPR/AED. All students will learn how to perform hands only CPR and use the AED during their Physical Education and Health class. The students began

learning these lifesaving skills on February 4th and will continue to learn these skills next week. With the help of certified CPR and AED instructor, Physical Education and Heath teacher Mr. Hartzler is helping with the event.

Students will be provided the knowledge and information on what to do step by step. "This is a great opportunity for students to learn lifesaving skills. We are happy to provide them with the knowledge of what to do and hope they will not have to use these skills", Ms. Casares stated. In a few years the students will have the chance to be CPR and AED certified as a Junior at ALJ.

This school year, Ms. Jenn Barbera's class at ALJ High School had a special visitor made possible through the New Jersey Education Association's HIPP grant. Licensed art therapist Samantha Commarato visited Ms. Barbera's class incorporating art into social-emotional learning (SEL).

Most recently, students assessed their levels of stress and learned how painting can help individuals destress. The students were taught that stress can be assessed through a number, almost like taking a temperature. The students rated their stress level from 1-10. If the student felt comfortable explaining and saying their number, they had the opportunity to share. The students then transitioned to a painting or drawing activity. There is a lot of choice

involved in our activities and students had the choice between painting and drawing with marker and colored pencil. Many of the students opted to paint. The students were instructed to think of something that makes them happy or calm and to illustrate that. The pictures varied from Mario Kart, to Fortnite, to a butterfly, to an ocean at night and numerous other drawings. At the end of the session, students shared why they drew what they drew.

"These past few months have been great having the chance to incorporate SEL through art. I think incorporating these topics into my lessons has helped my students understand better, while increasing my own knowledge of SEL. My students and I really look forward to these lessons and I enjoy seeing what they create," says Ms. Jenn Barbera.
