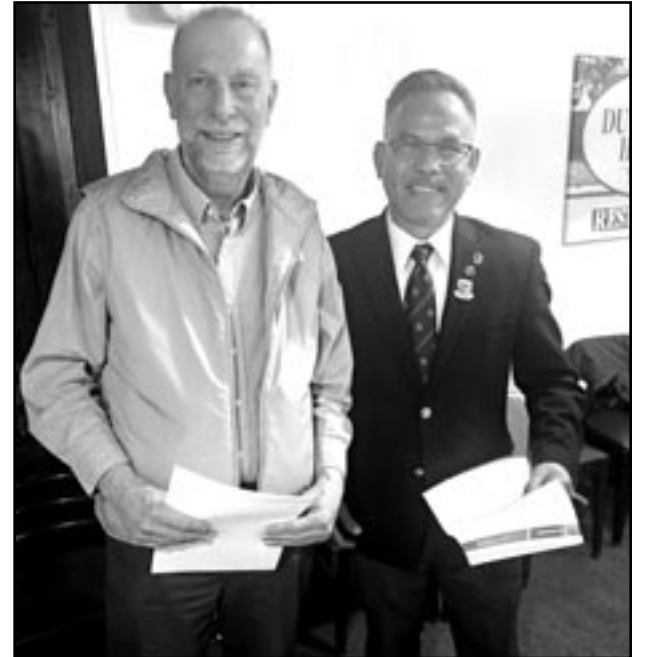

Watchung Hills Regional High School is honored to announce its newest members to their Hall of Fame. The Class of 2025 will include for the first time teams, clubs, or school-affiliated groups who have distinguished themselves during their high school years or within the community since graduation. We are proud to formally recognize and welcome the 1957-1958 Board of Education members, who helped orchestrate the opening of Watchung Hills Regional High School and the 1973 undefeated football team. In addition, the Hall of Fame will induct three deserving individuals.

Virginia Procino Hartmann, Class of 1968. Ms. Hartmann is a retired Lieutenant Colonel, who served in the United States Air Force Academy for 24 years. Among her duties, included being an air training officer who helped train one of the first group of women cadets to attend the United States Air Force Academy.

Dr. Nan Masterson, a former nurse at the high school, is the founder of Global Health Services, a non-profit charitable organization that provides children of orphanages access to facilities, supplies, and food to address malnutrition and the resources necessary for children to attend schools in such countries as Kenya and Haiti.

Mr. Michael Stanfield, Class of 1982, a former three-sport letterman at Watchung Hills, is currently the Vice President of Sales for the New

Orleans Saints and New Orleans Pelicans. Mr. Stanfield was with the Saints during the devastating Hurricane Katrina and was part of the relief, recovery, and resurrection of New Orleans that followed.

The ceremony honoring all the inductees will

occur on May 2nd at 6:00 pm in the high school performing arts center.

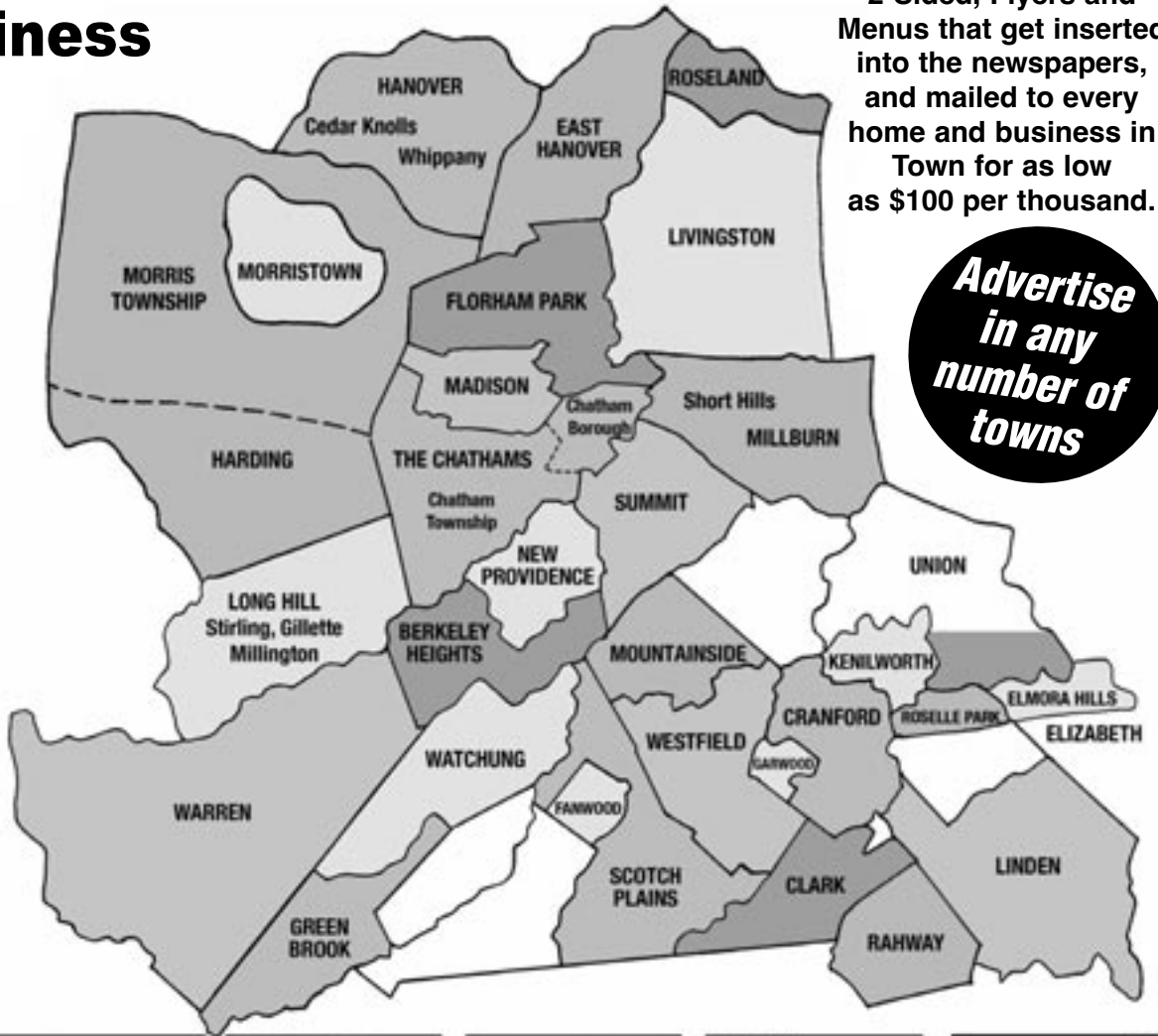
