





The winners will be selected by the CAP Scholarship Committee, who will be taking the following areas into consideration when reviewing the applications: The applications must have all sections completed; Academics (transcript/SAT/ACT scores); Financial Need; Essay (AI generated prohibited); Science/Math Teacher Recommendation Letter(s). scholarship is open to candidates who will be pursuing a college, university, career, or vocational school education in the Industrial, Process Technology, Computer Science or Engineering, i.e., Chemical, Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, or Environmental fields.
