PLANS FOR PHASE 2 OF LIBRARY RENOVATION

The Millburn Free Public Library

The Board of Trustees of the Millburn Free Public Library is excited to announce the upcoming Phase 2 of its building renovation project. This phase will focus on the modernization of the second-floor program rooms, community meeting spaces, hallways and restrooms. Renovations are anticipated to commence in early 2025.

Following the successful completion of Phase 1 in 2022, which revitalized the first floor and mezzanine areas enhancing the children's room and teen space—the library is now set to turn its attention to the upper level. The planned improvements aim to create a more accessible, functional and welcoming environment for all patrons.

"Modernizing our second floor will not only enhance our facilities but also better serve the diverse needs of our community," said Director Mike Banick. "We are committed to providing a space that fosters learning, collaboration and connection among our library users."

Key highlights of the renovation include:

Enhanced Auditorium with New Windows: Installation of windows along the second-floor auditorium will flood the space with natural light. New blackout shades, flexible seating arrangements with new chairs and tables and upgraded technology will accommodate a variety of events and activities.

Revitalized Community Meeting Spaces: More inviting environments designed to encourage community

engagement and collaboration. Upgraded technology and audio-visual equipment will improve presentations, meetings and connectivity.

Modernized Restrooms: Restrooms will be completely refreshed and reconfigured, featuring all new fixtures designed with sustainability in mind.

Upgraded Flooring, Ceilings and Lighting: The entire second floor will showcase all-new flooring, ceilings and energy-efficient lighting.

Focus on Sustainability: The renovation emphasizes efficiency; all new fixtures will adhere to stringent environmental standards.


The library will stay open throughout the renovation. While the second floor will be closed, the mezzanine—home to the non-fiction stacks and a quiet study area-will be accessible to patrons. The library staff is committed to minimizing disruptions, however brief closures may be necessary for safety reasons. Programming will continue during the renovation, utilizing virtual options or relocating events to the first floor or off-site as necessary.

The projected completion date is late summer 2025. Community members can expect a refreshed and inviting space that enhances their library experience.

NCJW, WEST MORRIS ZOOM SERIES: 'SOUNDS OF OCTOBER RAIN'

Temple Beth Shalom in Livingston will offer a free twopart series, titled "Sounds of October Rain," exploring Israeli popular song in the aftermath of the Oct. 7, 2023 terrorist attack in Israel. The series will take place Zoom on Thursdays, Feb. 6 and 13 at 1 p.m.

Cantor Fine's program is sponsored by National Council of Jewish Women (NCJW), West Morris Section's Our Jewish World program, under the leadership of Ilene Dorf Manahan and Melanie Levitan, both of Morristown.

Cantor Fine will examine a wide range of musical responses to the events of Oct. 7, reflecting a myriad of emotions--from sadness to anger to resolve, and the role of music in helping

Cantor Perry Fine to heal a nation. With the cantor's insightful Cantor Fine has given numerous concerts and guidance, participants will study the poetry of each song, which often is laced with biblical allusions, and how the music helps bring out the meaning of the text.

Session one will look at a variety of newly composed songs, including "October Rain," the Israeli song entry in the prestigious Eurovision Song Contest 2024. The cantor will delve into the lyrics' meaning and significance, and the controversy surrounding the song's inclusion in the song festival.

Session two will focus on how popular songs of the past, including those by Naomi Shemer and James Taylor, were reintroduced to the public in new arrangements, and how these classics, reimagined, took on new meaning to fit the times.

During 2024, Cantor Fine celebrated his 33rd year in the cantorate and his 13th at Temple Beth Shalom. A graduate of the University of Michigan and the Jewish Theological Seminary,

lectures, including many years as part of the NCJW, West Morris Section's Clergy lecture series.

Cantor Fine is the co-founder and principal conductor of Voices in Harmony, an interfaith choral ensemble that has served the greater Essex County community for the past 27 years. He has been awarded the Conservative Movement's Nathan H. Winter Award for Professional Excellence, and in April 2024, he was honored by both the South Orange/Maplewood Interfaith Holocaust Remembrance Service and the Seton Hall Sister Rose Thering Jewish/Christian Studies Program for lifetime achievement.

For the past 28 years, Cantor Fine has served on the faculty of the Jewish Theological Seminary, teaching biblical cantillation to a generation of budding cantorial students.



REGENERON SCIENCE TALENT SEARCH SCHOLARS

Milburn Public Schools

Seniors Neel Ahuja and Benjamin Li, both Plants." members of the Millburn High School Senior Research Program, were recently named as Regeneron Science Talent Search (STS) Top 300 Scholars. This is our country's oldest and most prestigious science competition. Thirteen alumni of the STS have gone on to win the Nobel Prize, and two have won the Fields Medal. Entrants conduct original research and submit a research paper documenting their findings.

Neel's research project is "Reducing Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) Water Contamination With Mycorrhizal Hydroponics

Benjamin's research project is "Multimodal, Depth-Aware Brain Tumor Segmentation in Sub-Saharan Populations."

Each top 300 scholar receives a \$2,000 award from Regeneron, with an additional \$2,000 going to their school to support STEM-related activities. The competition awards \$3.1 million to provide the opportunities and resources students need to become the next generation of inventors, entrepreneurs, and STEM leaders. The 40 finalists each receive \$25,000 and the chance to compete for the \$250,000 first-place prize in a week-long competition in March.
