The Inspire Award is the highest distinction in the FIRST Tech Challenge (FTC) competitions, recognizing excellence in robot design, programming, performance, and community engagement. The team advanced to the State Championship.

Mr. Michael Maresca, GLHS Teacher of Technology, Engineering, and Design, shared, "I am extremely proud of the Highlander Robotics team. The team was highly focused on winning and knew the limitations of their initial robot. They took a huge risk designing, building, and programming a completely new robot just four

weeks before the league tournament. In the end the team's hard work and dedication paid off with their making it to the final round of competition and capturing the prestigious First Tech Challenge Inspire award. This younger team of freshmen, sophomores, and juniors did an amazing job. I am excited to see how far they will go at next month's state competition --The Garden State Rumble in Hillsborough."

GIRL SCOUTS EARN TOP HONORS AT ANNUAL KLONDIKE DERBY

BSA Troop 280

BSA Troop 280, based in Chatham, NJ, and draws members from surrounding towns, proudly earned top honors at the Patriots' Path Council, Fishawack District's annual Klondike Derby, held on February 1, 2025, at Mount Allamuchy Scout Reservation involving over 30 sleds of competitors.

The Klondike Derby is a unique winter competition where scouts participate in activities that challenge their outdoor skills and teamwork. This year's Klondike included events such as cooking, fire-building, first aid, shelter-building, pioneering, and other challenges. Scouts are required to navigate through the course with a sled containing essential gear, all while testing their abilities as a team in a variety of outdoor tasks.

Troop 280, a troop of girls founded in 2019 when girls were officially allowed to join BSA, took home first place in the Senior Sled category, demonstrating expert leadership, scouting skills, and problem-solving.

"The Klondike Derby is one of the most anticipated events of the scouting year for our troop, and we couldn't be prouder of the hard work, dedication, and sportsmanship shown by our scouts," said Amy Walker Wagner, Scoutmaster of Troop 280. "This victory is a testament to their commitment to learning, developing leadership skills, and working as a

team in challenging conditions. Our troop's success is especially meaningful as it highlights the incredible growth of girls in Scouting since Troop 280 was founded in 2019." The formation of Troop 280 was a significant milestone for Chatham's Scouting community, as it marked the expansion of opportunities for girls to experience all the benefits of Scouting. Since its founding, the troop has thrived, taking on challenges with

determination and leading by example. The first-place finish at the Klondike Derby is just one example of how these young women continue to break barriers and excel.

The victory also highlights the strength of the BSA's values, emphasizing leadership, citizenship, and outdoor skills, while encouraging young scouts to embrace challenges with confidence and perseverance.

Hunter Anderson, 3, of Berkeley Heights was accepted into the Little Dragons Program at Chu's Academy of Martial Arts on March 1st as the program's newest student. 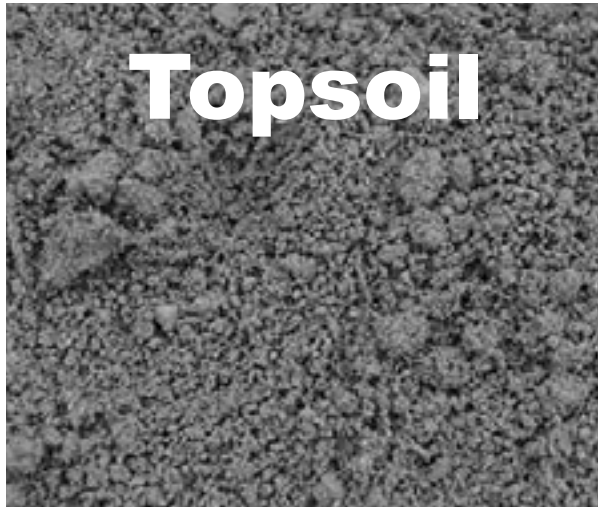

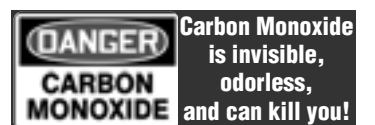

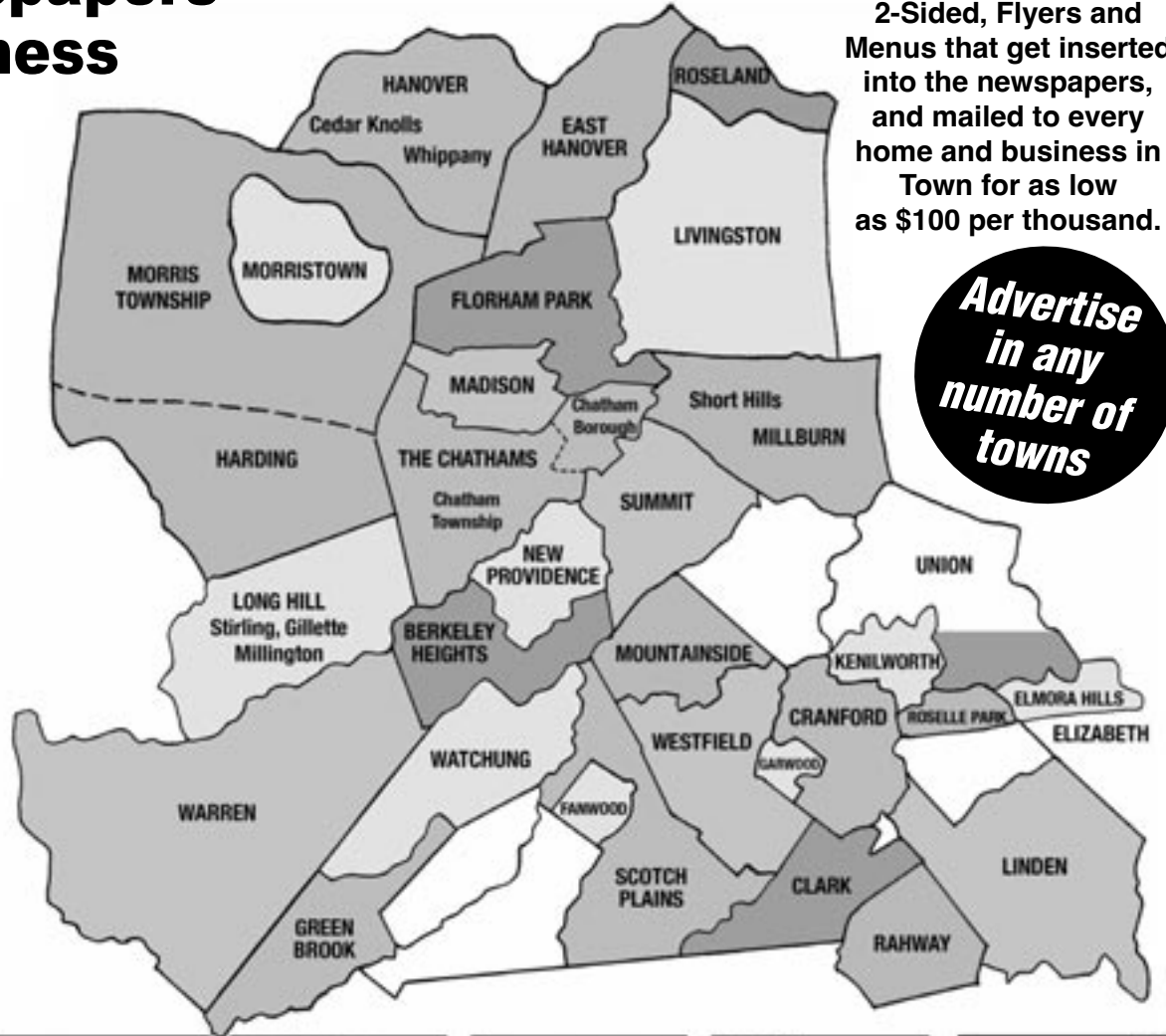
